Marcus Semien Will Have Surgery on his Right Wrist

OAKLAND, Calif. – Oakland A's shortstop Marcus Semien will have surgery on his right wrist tomorrow, the club announced today.

Semien was seen today by Dr. Steve Shin of the Kerlan-Jobe Clinic in Los Angeles for a review of his MRI and CT scans of his right wrist. The CT scan demonstrates a fracture to the scaphoid bone of Semien's right wrist and Dr. Shin recommends doing surgery. Dr. Shin would place a screw into the fractured area of the scaphoid bone to help promote healing of the bone to the fracture site. The surgery is scheduled to take place tomorrow. Semien will have another CT scan done in six weeks at which time Dr. Shin will reevaluate the scaphoid bone. There will be no other timetable for his return until he is seen by Dr. Shin at the end of May.
