A's Agree to Terms with Hendriks, Phegley, Semien and Treinen on One-Year Contracts

OAKLAND, Calif. – The Oakland A's agreed to terms with right-handed pitchers Liam Hendriks and Blake Treinen, catcher Josh Phegley and shortstop Marcus Semien on one-year contracts for the 2018 season, the club announced today. That leaves right-handed pitcher Kendall Graveman as the only arbitration eligible player remaining on the roster.

Hendriks was 4-2 with a save and a 4.22 ERA in a career-high 70 games last year. He also struck out a career-high 78 batters in 64.0 innings and held the opposition to a career-low .229 batting average.

Treinen was acquired from Washington in the Sean Doolittle/Ryan Madson trade on July 16 and ended up saving 13 games for the A's. He went 3-4 with a 2.13 ERA in 35 appearances with Oakland and combined for a 3-6 record, a career-high 16 saves and a 3.93 ERA in 72 games overall with the A's and Nationals.

Semien batted .249 with 10 home runs and 40 RBI in 85 games in a season shortened by a stint on the disabled list from April 15 to July 5 with a fractured scaphoid bone. He stole a career-high 12 bases and also had the best on-base percentage of his career with a mark of .325.

Phegley had his season interrupted by two stints on the disabled list for the second consecutive season and batted a career-low .201 with three home runs and 10 RBI in 57 games. He was out from May 4-11 with a concussion and July 25-Aug. 31 with a strained left oblique.
