A's Reinstate Pinder from the Disabled List; Option Barreto to Nashville

OAKLAND, Calif. – The Oakland A's reinstated infielder/outfielder Chad Pinder from the 10-day disabled list and optioned infielder Franklin Barreto to Triple-A Nashville, the club announced today.

Pinder was on the A's Opening Day roster and went 4-for-13 (.308) with a home run and RBI in four games before he was placed on the 10-day disabled list April 7 retroactive to April 6 with a hyperextended left knee. He began a two-game rehab assignment at Single-A Stockton on Saturday and was 2-for-7 (.286) with a home run and RBI in starts at second base and in right field.

Barreto was called up from Nashville on April 7 when Pinder went on the DL and appeared in just one game without an at bat. He played in just one game with the Sounds, going 2-for-4 with a double, home run and three RBI.
