A's Reinstate Liam Hendriks from DL; Recall Josh Phegley from Nashville

Daniel Gossett placed on 10-day disabled list; Josh Lucas optioned to Nashville

OAKLAND, Calif. – The Oakland Athletics announced today that they have reinstated RHP Liam Hendriks from the 10-day disabled list and have recalled C Josh Phegley from Triple-A Nashville. The team also placed RHP Daniel Gossett on the 10-day disabled list, retroactive to June 4, with a right elbow strain and has optioned RHP Josh Lucas to Triple-A Nashville.

Hendriks returns to the A's roster after missing 46 games due to a strained right groin. Hendriks appeared in six games for Oakland before going on the DL on April 14. In those six outings, he had a 9.00 ERA with seven hits, three earned runs, one home run, three walks, and one strikeout in 3.0 innings of work.

Phegley returns to the A's for his second stint with the club. Spent four days with Oakland while the team was in Toronto, playing in two games and going 1-for-4 with a double and an RBI. In 36 games this year with Nashville, Phegley is hitting .235 with three home runs, 18 RBI, 15 walks, and 31 strikeouts in 119 at-bats.

Gossett left Sunday's game after five innings, having thrown just 63 pitches. He is being placed on the 10-day disabled list retroactive to June 4 with a right elbow strain. In five outings with the A's, Gossett is 0-3 with a 5.18 ERA in 24.1 innings of work, including 12 strikeouts, eight walks, and five home runs allowed.

Lucas returns to Nashville for his third stint with the club this season. He has a 2.89 ERA in four appearances with Oakland this season, including 10 strikeouts and six walks. With Nashville, Lucas has a 2.13 ERA in 12.2 innings of work, including 10 strikeouts, five walks, and no home runs allowed.
