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Oakland A's to Give Away Mark Canha Hometown Hero T-shirt on Wednesday, Sept. 18

NBC Sports California to air 12:37 p.m. game versus the Kansas City Royals

OAKLAND, Calif. – The Oakland A's will celebrate outfielder Mark Canha on Wednesday, Sept. 18 with a Hometown Hero T-shirt giveaway for early arriving fans. The bat-flipping San Jose native has career highs in runs (65) and home runs (23) this season, and is hitting .309 with 11 home runs and 29 RBI in 47 games since the All-Star Break. Canha extended his career-high reaching base streak to 20 games during yesterday's win over the Los Angeles Angels.
