GREEN EXPO: As part of International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer, the A's will host their second Green Expo from 5 to 8 p.m. in the Plaza Club Entrance Lobby adjacent to Championship Plaza. Local greening and sustainability organizations, including Sustainable Oakland, East Bay Parks & Recreation District, and Waves Not Plastic, will set up booths to tell their stories and engage with fans.

MEXICAN HERITAGE NIGHT: Fans with a special event ticket will receive an exclusive Mexican Heritage Night T-shirt designed by local Mexican artist Jesse Hernández of Urbanaztec.

ROBERTO CLEMENTE AWARD PRESENTATION: A's pitcher Liam Hendriks will be recognized pregame as the A's 2019 nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award, the most prestigious individual award for Major League players. The Roberto Clemente Award is the annual recognition of a Major League player who best represents the game of baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy, and positive contributions, both on and off the field.

DAVE STEWART COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD: A's pitcher Liam Hendriks will also be recognized as the recipient of the 2019 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player in recognition of charitable contributions throughout Northern California and across the nation. Stewart will present Hendriks with the award before the game in a special on-field ceremony.

PLAY BALL: The team will host A's PLAY BALL presented by Bank of America at Frank Ogawa Plaza (14th and Broadway) in downtown Oakland from 10 a.m. to noon. Fans, families, and kids of all ages and skill levels are invited to join family-friendly baseball and softball activities, including pick-up style games and skill stations.

ATHLETICS HALL OF FAME INDUCTION: Baseball Hall of Famer Tony La Russa; Cy Young and MVP award winner Vida Blue; six-time All-Star Bert "Campy" Campaneris; Athletics all-time home run leader Mark McGwire; and former A's owner Walter A. Haas, Jr. will be inducted into the Athletics Hall of Fame as members of the 2019 class. The group will be honored during a pregame ceremony.

JERSEYS OFF THEIR BACKS: Fans will have the chance to win a game-worn, autographed jersey "off the back" of an A's player or coach following the game. Fans can buy scratcher cards (one for \$5 or five for \$20) from designated sellers throughout the ballpark or behind Section 218 from Sept. 16 to the seventh inning on Sept. 21. Fans also have the chance to win autographed items, A's swag, a suite for a 2020 exhibition game, tickets to the Oakland A's Community Fund Gala and Game Night, and discounts on food trucks and merchandise. All proceeds benefit the Oakland A's Community Fund.

EVOLUTION OF POP FIREWORKS: Fans are invited onto the outfield grass following the game to enjoy Evolution of Pop Fireworks, presented by Lagunitas.
