## Oakland A's to Host Virtual Media Event on Wednesday, Oct. 28

### Ahead of Coliseum Accessible Voting Location Opening

*A's President Dave Kaval, California Secretary of State Alex Padilla, City of Oakland Mayor Libby Schaaf, and Alameda County Supervisor Nate Miley to Participate in Video Press Conference*

**OAKLAND, Calif.** — The Oakland A's will host a virtual press conference on Wednesday, Oct. 28 at 1 p.m. to provide details and answer questions about the Coliseum Accessible Voting Location, which will be open to all Alameda County residents on Saturday, Oct. 31 through Election Day on Tuesday, Nov. 3. The Coliseum Accessible Voting Location will include in-person voting in the Oakland Arena, curbside voting from the car, and ballot drop boxes for individuals to deposit their completed mail-in ballots.

**WHO:** Oakland A's President Dave Kaval, California Secretary of State Alex Padilla, City of Oakland Mayor Libby Schaaf, and Alameda County Supervisor Nate Miley

**WHAT:** The Oakland A's, California Secretary of State, Alameda County, and the Coliseum Authority (JPA) have teamed up to ensure Alameda County residents have a safe and easily accessible location to vote in the 2020 General Election.

The Coliseum Accessible Voting Location will open to all Alameda County residents from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Oct. 31 through Nov. 2, and from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day on Tuesday, Nov. 3.

The virtual press conference will provide more details and answer any questions on the Coliseum Accessible Voting Location.
