**ANGELS BRIEFING:** The 2010 MLB All Star Game is three days away...Tonight the Halos play the sixth game (1-4) of a seven-game road trip to Chicago (0-4) and Oakland (1-0) leading up to the All-Star break...Last night, Angels snapped five-game road losing streak with 6-5 extra-inning victory, their fourth victory in extra time this season (4-3)...Halos are 11-5-1 over last 16 series played... Angels are off to a 3-6 start in July after posting an 18-9 record in June... **Angels' are 26-16 since May 25<sup>th</sup>**...2010 marks the Angels' 50<sup>th</sup> season.

**LUMBER WAKES FROM SLUMBER:** The Halos offense posted six runs on three extra-base hits last night after collecting five runs on two extra-base hits in their previous four games combined...The two runs the Angels put across on **Bobby Abreu's** first inning home run matched the total from their previous 23 innings...Abreu's long ball was the Angels' first since extra-base hit since Monday and the club's first home run since July 4<sup>th</sup>, ending a 37-inning homerless drought.

**FAST FACT:** The Angels tallied more home runs last night (3) than extra-base hits in their entire four-game series at Chicago (2).

**SHINING STAR:** Since receiving his fourth career All Star selection on July 4, **Torii Hunter** has gone 10-for-21 (.476), reaching base in 15 of 25 plate appearances...**Torii has reached base safely in 29 of his last 48 plate appearances (.604 on-base pct.) and leads the Halos with a .383 mark**...His eighth inning home run last night was the 250<sup>th</sup> of his career.

**@ OAKLAND:** Halos are visiting Oakland for second time this season...**Club has posted a 11-3 record at the Coliseum since start of 2009**...Angels are 11-4 in last 15 games vs. A's and 7-4 this season...**Angels have not lost a season series to the A's since 2003 (8-12)**...In the Angels seven victories over Oakland this season, they have outscored the A's 41-14...Conversely, in their four losses, they have been outscored 10-35.

**HOWIE ABOUT THAT:** **Howie Kendrick** has hit safely in 10 of last 11 road games, batting .413 (19/46) with 3 HR and 11 RBI...His 52 RBI rank second in the Majors by a second baseman to **Robinson Cano** (55)...**Kendrick** has 32 RBI his last 41 games.

**DYNAMIC DUO:** In four games at Chicago, **Torii Hunter** and **Howie Kendrick** posted a combined .481 batting average (13/27), accounting for 13 of the Angels' 22 hits in the series.

**TOP OF THE CHARTS:** Tomorrow's starter **Jered Weaver** leads the A.L. with 130 strikeouts (2<sup>nd</sup> in Majors behind Lincecum, 131) and a 10.2 SO/9 IP ratio...**He has 34 K's and four walks over his last four outings**...Weaver is on pace to become just the second Angel hurler since 2000 with 200+ K's (E. Santana in 2008)...**The last Angel pitcher to lead the Majors in strikeouts was Nolan Ryan in 1977 (341)**.

**READ ALL ABOUT IT:** In this week's issue of *ESPN The Magazine*, the "2010 Ultimate Standings" reveal **Mike Scioscia** as the "Ultimate Skipper" in all of sports and the Angels' as the top overall franchise in MLB... On the cover of *Baseball America* is the Angels' 2009 First Round Draft pick **Mike Trout (OF)** who has quickly ascended as one of the top prospects in all of minor league baseball.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** Angels are 17-10 in last 27 road games, outscoring opponents 113-89 in the span...Halos tied Phillies for MLB-lead with 48 road wins in 2009...**Since 2004, Angels have the best road record in baseball at 298-233 (.561) while the Phillies rank second in the span (284-243; .539)**.

**NOW YOU KNOW:** Angels have outscored opponents 55-33 in the first inning this season (+22).

**GOING DEEP:** Halos' starting pitchers lead the Majors in innings pitched (555).

**JULY GUYS:** Five Angels celebrate birthdays in July: **Rivera** (7/3), **Kendrick** (7/12), **Hunter** (7/18), **Shields** (7/22) & **Jepsen** (7/26).

**HOT HALOS:** **Joel Piñeiro** has won six straight decisions, posting a 2.32 ERA (50.1 IP – 13 ER) while the Halos have won in each of his last seven starts...**Kevin Jepsen** has held opponents scoreless in 10 of last 11 outings, posting a 1-0 record with seven holds and a 1.80 ERA (10 IP – 2 ER) ...**Erick Aybar** connected for his third home run last night and is batting .364 (43/118) since May 30<sup>th</sup>.

**QUICK HITS:** Angels are 25-14 in games played from Friday-Sunday compared to 22-28 from Monday-Thursday...Angels are 15-10 in one-run games...Halos are 24-15 since losing **Kendry Morales** to injury...In the Halos' 46 victories, the club has hit .321 (136/424) with RISP...In the 41 losses, Angels are 55 for 298 (.185).

**GETTING STARTED:** Since inflating to a 5.23 ERA on May 6th, **Angels' starting pitchers have fashioned a 3.88 ERA (370.2 IP – 160 ER) ERA over the last 60 games**...Starters have allowed three earned runs or less in 47 of last 69 contests.

**JEKYLL AND HYDE:**

- In Angels' 47 wins, starters have a **2.13 ERA** (320.1 IP – 76 ER) with 89 walks, 251 strikeouts, a .214 avg. against (252/1176) and 22 HRs allowed.
- In Angels' 42 losses, starters have a **7.08 ERA** (235 IP – 185 ER) with 95 walks, 169 strikeouts, a .315 average against (307/973) and 42 HRs allowed.

**THIS N' THAT:** 18 times in the last 36 games an Angel starter has held the opponent to two earned runs or less...Angels have connected for four grand slams this year (were only team in MLB without a slam in 2009)...**Halos' average home attendance of 39,534 is second in A.L. to Yankees (45,600)**...Angels are 36-13 when they score first...Halos lead A.L. with six walk-off wins...**Angels have held a lead at some point in 18 of 42 losses**...Angels have used 69 different lineups in 89 games...Halos pitchers have walked 314 batters, 3rd most in A.L...**Angels will fly the most air miles in 2010 (50,509), while the Chicago White Sox will fly the fewest (22,832)**...Angel relievers rank 11th in A.L. with a 4.67 ERA...From 2000-2009, the bullpen had the best ERA in the A.L. (3.71) and 2nd best in MLB in the decade (LAD - 3.63).
