- ◆ The Jays own a record of **63-56** & sit **4th** in the **AL East**, **10.0 GB** of the **1st** place **Yankees (73-46)** & **Rays (73-46)**...Are **4.5 GB** of the **3rd** place **Red Sox (68-52)** & **21.5 GA** of the **5th** place **Orioles (42-78)**.
- ◆ The Jays are **2nd** in the **AL** with a **.633 (19-11)** winning % post **All-Star break (MIN leads the AL at .742)**...The Jays have won **six** of their last **10** games & **13** of their last **20** overall.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN:

- ◆ Today, the Blue Jays continue their **10-day, 9-game** road trip with the **finale** of a **3-game** series vs. the **A's**...Are **3-2** on the current trip (2-1 vs. LAA & 1-1 vs. OAK) after dropping last night's contest by a score of 6-2...Following today's game, the Club will enjoy an off-day tomorrow before concluding the trip in BOS vs. the **Red Sox** in a **3-game** weekend set.

ROAD WARRIORS:

- ◆ Own a record of **32-32** away from **Rogers Centre**...The Jays are **11-7** on the road since the **All-Star break**...Are looking to win **three** straight series on the road for the **1st** time since **Apr. 10-26, 2009 (CLE, MIN & CWS)**.
- ◆ The Blue Jays are **2nd** in the **Majors** with **80-HR** hit on the road this season (**BOS leads with 91**)...**Jose Bautista** leads the Club & ranks **T-3rd** in the **AL** with **14-HR** hit on the road this season.
- ◆ The Jays **lead the AL** with **20** saves on the road & have recorded the most strikeouts at **449**.

START ME UP:

- ◆ Over the last **three** games, Toronto starters have allowed just **four** earned runs over **20.0** innings of work (**1.80 ERA**)...Among the AL, Toronto starters have allowed the **3rd** fewest **hits (682)** & rank **3rd** in **strikeouts (583)**.

BLUE JAYS vs. ATHLETICS:

- ◆ **2010:** Play the A's **seven** times this season, **four** at **Rogers Centre** & **three** at **Alameda County Coliseum**.
- ◆ Are **4-2** vs. **OAK (3-1** at home & **1-1** on the road)...Have won **eight** of their last **11** dating back to '09...Are **18-10** dating back to the end of '07...Coming into this year, have won **three** straight season series in OAK going **11-6** (including **2010**).
- ◆ **LAST SEASON:** Posted an overall record of **6-3 (2-1** at home & **4-2** on the road).
- ◆ **ALL-TIME:** Overall are **167-192, 79-99** at home & **88-93** on the road...With Monday night's victory have now won **three** straight season series vs. OAK & are **16-9** over that span.

- ◆ **Jose Bautista** currently **leads the Majors** with **37 HR** this season (**six** more than **A. Dunn** & **A. Pujols** who are tied for **2nd**)...**Jose** also **leads the Majors** with **13-HR** since the **All-Star break** & **leads the AL** in **August** with **6-HR**...Has now homered **11** times over his last **21** games.
- ◆ Dating back to **Sept. 1, 2009**, **Bautista leads the Majors** with **47-HR**, **10** more than **Albert Pujols** with **37** who ranks **2nd** over that time.

ON FIRE:

- ◆ Since the **All-Star break**, **Jose Bautista leads the Majors** in **HR (13)**, **RBI (34)**, **SLG (.728)**, **XBH (22)** & **TB (83)**...Is batting **.307 (35-114)** with a **1.126 OPS** in **30** games since the break.
- ◆ Over his last **13** games, **Adam Lind** is batting **.375 (18-48)** with **4-2B, 1-3B, 3-HR & 7-RBI**.

LEADING THE WAY:

- ◆ The Blue Jays **lead the Majors** with **183-HR** this season, **20** more than **BOS** who rank **2nd** with **163**...Also **lead the Majors** with **47-HR** hit **after the break**.
- ◆ The Jays **lead the AL** in slugging % (**.468**) in the month of **August**.

RIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF:

- ◆ In his first game of a rehab assignment with **New Hampshire (AA)**, **C John Buck** hit **home runs in his first two at bats** and helped lead the Fisher Cats to a 15-5 win over Binghamton...Buck knocked in **six** runs in the contest.
- ◆ In that game, **Kyle Drabek** picked up his **Eastern League-leading 13th** win, working the first five innings...In his first start in ten days, Drabek allowed five runs on nine hits...He walked six & struck out four...**David Cooper** also had a big game offensively, going **3-for-5** that included his **17th** HR of the season.

QUITE THE HONOUR:

- ◆ Yesterday, it was announced that **OF Brad Glenn** of the **Lansing Lugnuts (A)** was named the *Midwest League Player of the Week*...Glenn hit **.360** with **2-2B, 1-3B, 3-HR** & posted a **.407 OBP** & a **.880 SLG** over the week...The Tuscan, AZ native was a **23rd** round selection by Toronto in the **2009 June Draft**.

IN THE SWING OF THINGS:

- ◆ Since being acquired by the Blue Jays in a trade from the **Atlanta Braves** on **July 14**, **Yunel Escobar** is batting **.311 (33-106)** with **4-2B, 3-HR, 10-RBI** & has posted a **.365 OBP** in **26** games...Had been hitting just **.238 (62-261)** in **75** games with the Braves prior to the trade.
- ◆ Is batting **.387 (12-31)** with a **.500 OBP** over his last **nine** contests.

CLIMBING THE HILL

- ◆ **Aaron Hill** currently ranks **2nd** in the **AL** among **2nd** basemen with **18-HR** this season (**R.
