OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics had their three-game winning streak snapped... lost when leading after eight innings for the first time this season (68-1)... have 144 stolen bases this season, their most since they had 151 steals in 1991... have a 42-51 record against opponents that were at or above .500 when playing them and are 34-24 against teams that were below .500... are 2-1 on this seven-game homestand against Chicago (2-1) and Texas (four games).
- Brett Anderson** has a 1.61 ERA (5 er in 28.0 ip) in his last four starts... is 4-5 with a 2.90 ERA (22 er in 68.1 ip) in 11 starts since returning from the disabled list July 30... is 7-1 with 1.87 ERA (12 er in 57.2 ip) in nine career starts in September... has walked two batters or fewer in 16 of his 17 starts this season and has walked one or fewer 11 times.
- Chris Carter** (1 for 3) homered in the third inning, the first of his Major League career... has four hits in his last seven at-bats (.571) to snap his career-opening 0 for 33 streak, which set an Oakland record for consecutive hitless at-bats to start a career.
- Rajai Davis** (0 for 4) had his seven-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .344 (11 for 32) in his last eight games.
- Jeff Larish** (1 for 3) snapped his 0 for 16 streak with a seventh-inning double... the hitless streak was the longest of his career... is now 2 for 30 (.067) over his last 12 games.

CHICAGO NOTES

- The Chicago White Sox snapped their season-high eight-game losing streak, which was their longest since they also lost eight in a row from August 19 to 28, 1991... the eight-game losing streak was their longest in September since losing nine in a row from September 14 to 23, 1976... are 8-5 in their last 13 road games... are 1-2 on this six-game road trip through Oakland (1-2) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Edwin Jackson** is 1-3 with a 4.98 ERA (19 er in 34.1 ip) in his last five starts after going 2-0 with a 0.96 ERA (3 er in 28.0 ip) in his first four starts with Chicago... is 4-7 with a 4.42 ERA (44 er in 89.2 ip) in 14 starts since throwing his no-hitter on June 25... is 2-2 with a 3.08 ERA (9 er in 26.1 ip) in four career starts against the A's.
- White Sox starting pitchers are 0-10 with a 6.78 ERA (69 er in 91.2 ip) in their last 17 games... the 17 games without a victory by a starter is an ongoing franchise record (previous: 15, June 15-July 1, 1985)
- Juan Pierre** (2 for 3) stole home in the eighth inning... it was his 60th stolen base of the season, which moves him past Scott Podsednik (2005) for sole possession of second place on the White Sox single-season list... the steal also moves him ahead of Patsy Donovan for 30th place on the all-time list... is hitting .310 (72 for 232) over his last 53 games.
