TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will conclude a 3-game set with the Oakland Athletics tonight at 12:37PM ET in Oakland... Series is part of a 6-game trip to Oakland and LA Angels... **Are 1-1 on the trip...** Just finished a perfect 6-0 homestand sweeping both the Detroit Tigers and Kansas City Royals... Recently finished a 6-game trip to Kansas City and Minnesota at 2-4... Earlier concluded a 3-game series/homestand by sweeping the Baltimore Orioles... Indians are **13-2** on the year at home and **7-7** on the road... **Indians have won 13 straight home games, equaling their longest home winning streak since winning 13-straight in April/May 1996...** The Indians won 8 straight from April 3-11 marking their longest winning streak since 2008 (10 straight 8/17-27)... Have already surpassed their season long win streak from 2010 (7G, 9/24-10/1).

HISTORICAL START: The Indians **20-9** on the year which is tied for the **2nd best start in the club history through 29G...** Is the **9th time ('99, '96, '95, '66, '55, '48, '41, '16) they have started 20-9...** Only the **1920 club (21-8) had a better start after 29 games...** Have been in first place or shared first place for each of the last 28 days since April 7 ... Indians were season-high 12 games over .500 on May 3 for first time since the end of 2007... **Indians set a new franchise record for wins in April with 18 surpassing the old mark of 16 set in 1999, 1996 & 1988...** Indians current **13-game home winning streak is T5th longest in club history...** Tribe has not started **13-2** at home since 1941 (Elias).

MLB BEST: Indians are currently tied with the Philadelphia Phillies for the best record in MLB... **On Tuesday, May 3 became the 1st MLB team to 20 wins...** Marks the **6th time that Indians have been outright (no tied) first MLB team to 20 victories...** Also did it in 1916, 1920, 1952, 1954 & 1999 (Elias).

THIS & THAT: After completing a sweep of Detroit on Sunday, the Indians now have **5 series (all 3G) sweeps this season...** Had just **four sweeps all of last year...** Indians won **4 straight games in their last at-bat of the game from April 29-May 3, which equaled a club-record (also in 1962 & 1943)...** Indians hold the largest run differential **+48 (151RS/103RA)** of any team in MLB... The St. Louis Cardinals are **2nd** at +37 (168RS/131RA).

LOOKIN FOR A BAY SERIES WIN: Today, the Indians will look for their first outright series win in Oakland since July 29-31 of 2002... Tribe has lost 9 of their last 10 series (split 2G series in 2006) in Oakland... Since 2003 Indians are **9-24** against the A's in Oakland... **Today will also look for their 6th series win of the season.**

SUCCESSFUL STARTERS: Over the last 27 games Indians starting pitchers are **14-4 w/a 2.81 ERA (173.0IP, 143H, 54ER) with 22 quality starts...** Allowed 17ER in 9.2IP over the first two games... On the year starters own a 3.50 ERA, which is **3rd best in the AL...** Starters have pitched at least 6.0IP in 23 of 29G and at least 7.0IP in 14 of 29G... **22 quality starts are tied with Philadelphia for most in MLB.**

POTENT OFFENSE: The Indians are currently 3rd in the AL in runs scored with 151... **Are 2nd in AL in runs/game at 5.20 trailing NYY 5.21...** Tribe also leads the AL average (.272) and on-base % (.344), are 3rd in slugging % (.433), 3rd in HR (34) & 6th in walks (104)... Last year thru 29 games had scored 106 runs (3.66RS/G) & were hitting .244 (234-960)... **Have scored 5 or more runs in 14 of 29 games... Are 16-2 when scoring at least 4 runs.**

SLICK D: The Indians currently are 3rd in the AL in fielding % at .987 and have made the 4th fewest errors in the league at 14... Last year thru 29 games Tribe made 18E... Have not made an error in 17 of 29G... As a result of their defense, **Tribe has allowed just 5 unearned runs, T2nd fewest in the AL.**

GOOD RELIEF: Tribe bullpen currently sports the **4th lowest ERA in the AL** at 3.03... Pen has limited hitters to a .216 (64-296) average against which is the **3rd lowest relief average against in the AL...** **Pen has allowed just 1R/ER in their last 13.1IP & just 3R/ER in their last 18.2IP (7G).**

DID YOU KNOW?

Indians are tied with Philadelphia Phillies for the best record in MLB at 20-9...

Indians AAA affiliate Columbus Clippers have won 13 straight games... Own the best record in MiLB at 21-5.

JOSH TOMLIN has allowed 7HR (T3rd most in AL)... 8 of the 11 runs he has allowed this year have come via HR.

Indians have drawn at least 1 walk in all 29 games this season.

Tribe is 13-2 when they score 1st and 16-2 when they outhit their opponents.

Indians are hitting .315 (73-232) w/RISP... Hit .248 w/ RISP last year... Last 17G with RISP are 47-139 (.338).

Dating back to last year, RAFAEL PEREZ has not allowed an earned run in his last 22 app. (18.1IP, 14H, 1R, 9BB, 11K).

MATT LaPORTA is batting .333 (17-51) w/ 2HR & 10RBI in last 14G... Has hit in 5 straight (3 MHG):.400 (8-20) w/a HR & 5RBI

JOSH TOMLIN has pitched at least 5.0 innings in each of his first 18 career appearances in 2010-2011 as he is the **ONLY** pitcher in club history to accomplish the feat... Currently ranks T4th in the AL in wins (4), 9th in ERA (2.43) & 5th in avg. against (.188).

MR CLUTCH: Indians **2B ORLANDO CABRERA**, signed as a free agent Feb. 16 currently is 2nd on the team with 18RBI... On the year he is batting .299 (32-107) w/ 17RS, 3 2B, 2HR & 18RBI... **8 of his 18RBI have either tied or give the Indians the lead (5 give lead)...** Has hit in each of last 7 games batting .440 (11-25) w/ 6RBI.

MASTERFUL MASTERSON: Despite not getting a decision on Sunday, RHP JUSTIN MASTERSON remains 5-0 w/a 2.25 ERA in 6 starts... He is T2nd in the AL in wins (5) & 6th in ERA (2.25)... **He is only the 4th Indians pitcher in team history to win 5 games in April in one season...** Has won 7 of his last 8 decisions since last year... Last year did not win his 5th game until Aug. 26th in his 26th start.

LAST GAME: The Indians were defeated by the Oakland A's 3-1... JOSH TOMLIN (7.2IP, 3H, 3R/2ER, 0BB, 5K) suffered his 1st loss of the year despite a great pitching performance... He allowed a pair of solo HR's to DAVID DeJESUS in the 1st & 4th innings... Offensively the Indians plated just 1 run, in the 3rd inning on a RBI single by TRAVIS HAFNER who was 2-4 in the game... Indians were just 1-8 with RISP and stranded 10 men.

RHP JEANMAR GOMEZ (0-1, 6.23 ERA)

JEANMAR GOMEZ...Is making his 3rd Major League start/4th appearance of the 2011 season today against the Oakland Athletics in Oakland... It is his 1st start vs. Oakland this year/career... It is his 2nd start/3rd appearance in the road this year... 14th career ML start.

⇒ Signed by the Indians on April 4, 2005 out of Venezuela...Is 23 years old.

⇒ In 2009 combined was 12-6 w/a 3.30 ERA in 26 starts for A Kinston and AA Akron (147.1IP, 134H, 54ER, 45BB, 124K)...Made final 22 starts of the year at AA Akron after his April 27 promotion from Kinston and **was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Year going 10-4 w/a 3.43 ERA in 22 starts (123.1IP, 117H, 47ER, 109K)**...He finished 3rd in the EL in ERA, T5th in K, T6th in wins and 3rd in WHIP (1.27)...Among organizational pitchers he was 9th in ERA, 5th in strikeouts and 2nd in wins...Named to the Eastern League mid-season and post-season all-star teams... **Season highlight came in his 4th Double A start on May 21 at Trenton, tossing a 9.0 inning, perfect game (87P, 9.0IP, 0H, 8K)**...It was the first perfect game and individual no-hitter in Aeros franchise history and the first perfect game in MiLB since July 15, 2007 (Guillermo Moscoso, Oneonta)...Was 7th 9.0IP perfect game in the Eastern League's 87-year history...

⇒ **2008** Spent the year at A Kinston where he was 4th in Carolina League in starts (27)...Over his last 9 starts his ERA was 2.03 (48.2IP, 45H, 11ER)...**2007** Ranked 5th in the South Atlantic League in starts (27) and 3rd in CG (1) at A Lake County...Finished T4th in the Indians farm system in wins (11) and innings (140.2IP)...**2006** Ranked 3rd in the GCL in innings (54.1) and 9th in ERA (2.48) for the GCL Indians.

LAST YEAR... Spent the majority of the season at AAA Columbus going 8-8 with a 5.20 ERA (116.0IP, 129H, 74R/67ER, 42BB, 78K) in 20 starts... **Also made 11 starts for the Indians in 2011, going 4-5 with a 4.68 ERA (57.2IP, 73H, 36R/30ER, 22BB, 34K) as he ended the season in the Tribe rotation**... Recalled from Columbus for the first time on July 18 to make a spot start and his Major League debut vs. the Tigers (7.0IP, 2R/0ER) as he earned his 1st career big league win... Optioned back to Columbus the following day... Was again recalled to Cleveland on August 1 where he spent the remainder of the season in the Indians rotation... Won his 2nd career start August 1 vs. Toronto... The following Tribe pitchers have won their first 2 career Major League games (as a starter) since 1922: Jeanmar Gomez 2010, Scott Lewis 2008, Roy Smith 1984, Luis Tiant 1964, and Dewey Metivier 1922... Was 3-0 after his first 4 starts, becoming just the 4th Indians pitcher since 1920 to win 3 of his first 4 ML starts **joining Scott Lewis (2008), Wynn Hawkins (1960), and Mudcat Grant (1958)**...His 1.54ERA was the lowest among any Indians starting pitcher through their first 4 games, all being starts (23.1IP, 20H, 6R/4ER, 5BB, 12K) since 1920 (baseball-reference.com)..... Went 0-5 with a 7.67 ERA from August 17-September 20... Earned the victory in his final start of the season on September 2 vs. KC... **Finished T7th in the AL among rookies in wins (4) and 7th in starts (11).**

THIS YEAR ... This spring went 0-1 w/a 5.50 ERA (18.0IP, 17H, 11R/ER, 7BB, 14K) in 6 games/2 starts in ML camp as he competed for the final spot in the Indians rotation... Batters hit .258 (17-66) off him this spring... Was optioned to AAA Columbus on March 25.

⇒ Earned his 1st win of the season in his first start at AAA Columbus on April 8, a 3-2 road victory over the Indianapolis Indians... 5.2IP, 7H, 2R/ER, 2BB, 4K, 90 pitches/58 strikes.

⇒ **Improved to 2-0 on the year as he tossed a complete game 8-hit shutout over Toledo on April 14th... Was a 1-0 victory for the Clippers at Toledo... 7.0IP, 8H, 0R, BB, 7K... Threw 96 pitches, 65 strikes.**

⇒ In 2 starts at AAA Columbus, was 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA (12.2IP, 15H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 11K)... AAA batters hit .319 (15-47) off him with 0HR allowed... LHH hit .333 (5-15) and RHH batted .313 (10-32)... Batters hit .217 (5-23) off him with runners on and .200 (3-15) with RISP... 1SB/0CS allowed.

⇒ Recalled on April 19 to make 2011 debut at Kansas City that night to take Mitch Talbot's spot in the rotation (L#1, 4.1IP, 9H, 5R/ER)... Appeared in relief of injured Carlos Carrasco on April 24 at MIN (ND, 3.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER)...Did not receive a decision in his 2nd start on April 29 vs. the Tigers, a 9-5 Indians win... 5.2IP, 10H, 3R/ER, 0BB, 4K... **On year is 0-1 w/a 6.23 ERA (13.0IP, 22H, 9R/ER, 3BB, 8K) in 3G/2GS.**

⇒ So far thru 3 appearances MLB hitters are batting .361 (22-61) off him w/1HR allowed...LHH are batting .379 (11-29) off him and RHH are batting .333 (11-32) w/a HR...Batters hitting .290 (9-41) w/a HR with runners on and .273 (6-22) with RISP...5SB/1CS...0GIDP.

LAST GAME...Did not receive a decision in his last start of Friday, April 29 vs. the Detroit Tigers in Progressive Field... Was a 9-5 win over the Tigers... 5.2IP, 10H, 3R/ER, 0BB, 4K, HR to M. Cabrera... Threw 97 pitches/58 strikes.

ON THE ROAD ...Today is Jeanmar's 2nd start/3rd appearance on the road this year... **THIS YEAR:** Is 0-1 w/a 7.36 ERA (7.1IP, 12H, 6R/ER, 3BB, 4K) in 2 games/1 starts... **CAREER**...He was 1-5 w/a 6.82ERA in 7 games/6 starts (33.0IP, 51H, 28R/25ER, 13BB, 18K, 6HR)... Career at home is 3-1 w/a 3.35 ERA.
