## Texas Rangers (67-52) at Oakland A's (53-65)

**WINS AND LOSSES:** The Rangers have won 4 of 5 and 6 of their last 8 games...club is 6-4 in August and 11-11 since the 12-game win streak...team is 16-11 since the All-Star break, 23-11 last 34 games and 31-18 in the last 49...Texas has gone 44-29 (.603) beginning May 22...club is 58-51 beg. April 12 after a 9-1 start.

-At 67-52 (.563), the Rangers have the 3rd-best record in the A.L., 6th-best in majors...this marks the **5th time that Texas has been a season best 15 games over .500** (others after wins 7/19 at LAA, 7/23 vs. TOR, 7/25 vs. MIN, and 8/9 vs. SEA), but team is 0-4 when trying to reach 16 games over .500.

--Current 67-52 mark tied 2009 and 2010 for 3rd best in club history after 119 games.

-Rangers' **12-game win streak July 4-19** was 2nd-longest in club history, longest in majors since Boston, 12 straight June 16-29, 2006...since '02, only win streak longer than Rangers' 12 G: Oakland's 20 G Aug. 13-Sept. 4, 2002.

**ON TOP IN WEST:** Texas has had a 2.0 game advantage in the A.L. West for the last 2 days, the club's biggest advantage since August 1 (2.0 GA)...club's last advantage of more than 2.0 games was a 3.0 lead on July 26...the Rangers have led the division by at least 1.0 game for 38 straight days beginning July 6...Texas has had sole possession of first place in the A.L. West for 74 of the last 77 days beginning May 16, including 38 straight days beginning July 6, as Texas has not been out of first since May 15 (-0.5 GB)...team has had at least a share of the division lead for 121 of 135 days in 2011, club's 4th-most days in first place ever in a single season...Texas has been in 1st in West for 239 of 253 days beginning June 8, 2010.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Rangers have won consecutive road games for the 1st time since 5 victories in a row, July 14-19...club has dropped 6 of its last 9 road games beginning July 20 but is 12-8 (.600) away from home since June 17 is 3rd best in the A.L....overall road winning percentage of .491 (28-29) ranks 8th in the A.L....club was last at the .500 mark on the road on July 30 (26-26).

**VERSUS THE A.L. WEST:** The Rangers are 21-12 (.636) vs. A.L. West opponents this season, winning 15 of the last 19 games beginning May 15...Texas has the 4th best winning percentage against its own division of any major league club in 2011...Texas is 8-7 in A.L. West parks this season, winning 6 of the last 8...the Rangers have a 2.88 ERA (93 ER/291.0 IP) vs. the 3 A.L. West opponents this season while holding those foes to a .223 (241-1082) batting average.

**VERSUS OAKLAND:** The Rangers are 7-4 against the A's in 2011, winning the last 6 games since a loss on May 9 at Rangers Ballpark...that includes a 4-game sweep, July 7-10, the Rangers' 1st vs. the A's since June 19-22 at old Arlington Stadium...this is Texas' longest winning streak vs. Oakland since 6 wins in a row, July 7, 1999-May 6, 2000...the Rangers last longer win streak against the A's was 9 victories in a row, June 19-Sept. 30, 1986...Texas has won 10 of the last 14 meetings with Oakland beginning Sept. 24, 2010 with a 57-49 edge beginning 2006...Rangers' all-time advantage is 301-290, the most lifetime wins ersus any club.

**In Oakland:** Texas is 2-3 at the Coliseum this season and has won 5 of 8 beginning last Sept. 24...club is 11-14 in this park since the start of 2009...all-time, the A's have a 155-140 edge here.

**DAY GAMES:** The Rangers are 18-16 in day games this season, winning 4 of the last 6 beginning July 10...club is 10-11 in road day games, winning 4 of the last 7 beginning June 18.

**STREAKING:** Rangers boast 2 of the 6 longest current hitting streaks in the American League...Michael Young has hit safely in 11 straight games, matching the 2nd longest current span while Yorvit Torrealba's 10-gamer ties for the 4th longest:

**TOPS IN RBI:** Nelson Cruz drove in his 75th run of the season on Friday, giving Texax 3 players with at least 75 RBI (Michael Young-78; Adrian Beltre-76)...only other ML teams with 3 players at 75+ RBI are the Red Sox (Adrian Gonzalez-92; David Ortiz-79; Kevin Youkilis-76) and the Yankees (Curtis Granderson-93; Mark Teixeira-86; Robinson Cano-81)...the 3 teams have 9 of the 11 A.L. players with at least 75 RBI, the others being the White Sox' Paul Konerko (80) and the Blue Jays Jose Bautista (76)...the only N.L. squad with as many as 2 players with 75 RBI is the Brewers (Prince Fielder-89; Ryan Braun-76)...Texas had 4 players with 75+ RBI in 2010.

**STINGY ON THE ROAD:** Despite a 28-29 record, the Rangers have the lowest road earned run average in the major leagues at 3.11...the current mark would be the lowest in the majors for a season since Montreal's 2.69 mark in 1992...Texas' current mark would be the 2nd-lowest such figure in the A.L. for a single season over the past 39 seasons from 1973-2011 or since the advent of the designated hitter, and best in team history for any season, surpassing a 3.15 mark in 1977...would be the A.L.'s lowest mark in a full season in that span...the 3.11 figure would be the 8th lowest overall mark in both leagues since 1973.

--Friday was 16th time the club has issued one or fewer runs in a road game...the Rangers have 2nd lowest opponents BA on road in ML at .233 (BOS-.227).

**MORE PITCHING:** Friday was the 27th time this season that the Rangers have allowed one or fewer runs in a game...that occurred 26 times in all of 2010...staff has posted a 3.10 ERA (104 ER/302.0 IP) in the last 34 games since July 4 to drop from 4.01 to 3.75, 6th in A.L.

**WINNING WAYS:** Today's A's starter Trevor Cahill has won 8 games against Texas since the start of 2008, matching the most of any pitcher in that span:

**ONE MORE WIN:** Round Rock defeated Oakland's AAA club Sacramento, 7-3 on Friday, giving Express manager Bobby Jones 1499 career minor league managerial wins...all of those have come in the Texas organization with Charlotte (1988-90); Tulsa (1991-92; 1995-2000); Oklahoma City (1993-94; 2002-10); and Round Rock (2011)...the 1499 wins are 7th most among active minor league skippers with Lakeland's Dave Huppert the leader at 1664.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** Saturday's game will be a FOX national telecast going to 16% of the U.S. with Glen Kuiper and Tom Grieve on the call...Texas is 2-3 in 5 previous FOX Saturday Baseball appearances this season...Texas has one more scheduled FOX telecast, Sept. 3 at Boston...Rangers' 6-run 2nd inning on Friday marked 3rd time with 6+ runs in an inning on road this season...overall high is 7 in the 2nd inning on June 10 at Minnesota...the Rangers lead the majors with 132 double plays...with Alexi Ogando and C.J. Wilson, the Rangers are one of 5 A.L. clubs with at least 2 11-game winners: 3--Detroit; 2--Boston, Los Angeles, New York, Texas...Texas had just 4 defensive assists on Friday, matching the season low (April 9-2 at BAL).

## TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

# #48 Colby Lewis, RHP (10-8, 4.12 ERA)

**TODAY:** The 32-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 24th start and appearance today in Oakland, the 90th start and 128th appearance of his career...will be working on extra 5 days' rest after taking a no decision in Rangers' 5-3 come-from-behind win on Sun. vs. Cleveland...is 0-1, 5.50 (11 ER/18.0 IP) last 3 starts to rise from 3.93 to 4.12, but is still 5-1, 3.11 (23 ER/66.2 IP) last 10 starts beginning June 27 to drop from 4.97...opponents have batted .211 (53-251) during that same 10-start stretch to lower season average from .268 to .242...has factored into the decision in 18 of 23 starts, but has taken 2 straight no decisions for the first time since rejoining the Rangers in 2010...has allowed A.L.-high 28 HR, 2nd-most in majors...opposing RH batters have just .195 (51-261) avg., 4th-lowest in A.L...is 6-3, 3.88 (30 ER/69.2 IP) in 11 starts on 5+ days rest...Texas is 12-11 in his 23 starts.

**10 WINS AGAIN:** This is his 3rd career 10-win season, all with the Rangers (also 2003 and 2010)...since 2000, the only other Rangers with 3-or-more 10-win seasons are Kenny Rogers (4) and Kevin Millwood (3)...now has 10 wins in 2 straight seasons, joining just 4 other Rangers to do that since 2000: Rick Helling (2000-01), Kenny Rogers (2004-05), Kevin Millwood (2006-07), and C.J. Wilson (2010-11).

**REVERSAL OF FORTUNE:** Has received an avg. of 8.88 runs of support in his 10 wins, getting one-or-zero runs of support in 7 of 8 losses...his 5.84 run support avg. through 23 starts in 2011 is over a run higher (1.27) than 4.57 figure from last season, when he received 2 runs of support or less in 16 of 32 outings, including one-or-zero runs 11 times...has 15 combined losses/no decisions (8 L, 7 ND) in quality starts since beg. of 2010.

**COMPLETE:** Posted complete games in consecutive road starts, May 5 at Seattle and May 16 at Chicago-AL, with one home outing in between...was first Texas starter to record a complete game in back-to-back road starts since Kenny Rogers, May 18-24, 1994...joins Holland (4) and Wilson (2) as Rangers with multiple CG in '11.

**THE LONG BALL:** His A.L.-high 28 HR allowed are 2nd-most in majors behind only Reds' Bronson Arroyo (33)...of the 28 home runs, 20 have been solo, five 2-run, and three 3-run...lefties have accounted for 16 of the 28...has allowed at least one home run in 17 of 23 outings this season, including 15 over his last 12 starts since a season-high 4 HR's June 6 vs. DET...has not posted back-to-back starts without a HR this season...streak of 7 straight w/ a HR allowed to start the season for Lewis was longest in Texas history to begin a season (Opening Day rotation members only) and longest overall single-season streak by a Texas pitcher since Vicente Padilla served up HR's in 9 straight in '08 to match a club record, done twice by Charlie Hough in 1984 and 1987.

**LAST START:** Took no decision in Rangers 5-3 come-from-behind win on Sun. vs. Cleveland (7.1 IP, 5 H, 3 R-ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 108 pitches/70 strikes)...opposing starter Josh Tomlin blanked Rangers for 7.0 inn., but each of first 6 Texas batters in 8th inn. reached safely as the club scored all 5 runs in that frame for a last at-bat victory...Lewis departed after allowing a solo HR to his last batter faced, Michael Brantley, in the 8th, trailing 3-0...retired 17 of 19 batters faced prior to the HR, including 9 in a row to begin that stretch.

**VS. OAKLAND:** The Bakersfield (CA) native and resident is 5-3 with a 3.25 ERA (30 ER/83.0 IP) in 15 games/13 starts against A's, including 5-3, 3.40 (30 ER/79.1 IP) in the 13 starts...will be facing A's for 10th time in as many series between the clubs since the start of 2010, going 3-3, 3.20 (21 ER/59.0 IP) in the 9 starts in that span - despite quality starts in 7 of those 9 outings...has won all 3 decisions last 4 starts dating to 2010: 3-0, 2.63 (8 ER/27.1 IP)...is 4-1, 2.53 (12 ER/42.2 IP) in 7 career starts at the Coliseum, 5.0+ innings and 3-runs-or-less in all 7 starts...earned 11-2 win 4/30 in Oakland (8.0 IP, 2 R-ER), besting Brett Anderson, solo HR to Suzuki and Willingham...also beat Anderson 5/10 in Arlington (7.1 IP, 1 R-ER), solo HR to Pennington...took ND in matchup with McCarthy on 7/9 in Arlington (6.0 IP, 5 R-4 ER), which Texas won on Hamilton's walk-off 2-out, 2-run HR in 9th.

**2011:** Club's no. 2 starter to open season...Texas is 12-11 in his 23 starts, losing 11 of 13 games in which Lewis did not record a win...has held RH batters to a .195 (51-261) avg., 4th-lowest in A.L., 88 points lower than LH batters (.283)...has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 20 of 23 games...has 14 quality starts, including career-best 5 straight from April 30-May 21...club has been shut out 5 times in 2011, 2 of those coming in Lewis starts...threw at least 7.0 innings in 4 straight starts from April 30-May 16, longest such streak of his career...has logged at least 6.0 innings in 16 of his last 19 starts, including 8.0-or-more innings 5 times...Torrealba has caught 20 of 23, with Napoli behind the plate in the other 3...has given up a HR in 17 of 23 starts (see separate note)...has posted a quality start in each of his 10 victories, recording a 1.70 ERA (14 ER/74.0 IP), while sporting a 8.66 ERA (38 ER/42.0 IP) in his 8 losses...had 2.43 ERA in May and 3.09 ERA in July, but 5-plus figures in both April (5.70) and June (5.18)...was the first player placed on MLB's new Paternity Leave List from April 15-17 following the birth of his daughter in Bakersfield, Calif. on April 13...his spot in the rotation was essentially skipped while he was out.

**ON THE ROAD:** Scheduled for his 12th road start of the year, going 6-4 with a 3.08 ERA (25 ER/73.0 IP) in 11 previous outings; 13th-lowest road ERA in the A.L...his road ERA (3.08) is over 2 runs lower than home ERA (5.15).

**10-K MAN:** Has pair of 10-strikeout games in '11...his 7 games of 10+ strikeouts since the start of the last season rank T5th-most in the A.L. in that span...only A.L. pitchers with more such games in that span are James Shields (9), Justin Verlander (9), Felix Hernandez (9), and Jon Lester (8).

**OTHER STARTS:** Started and won team's 2nd game 4/2 vs. BOS, besting John Lackey in 12-5 victory...took loss 4/9 at BAL-G1, a 5-0 defeat in which opposing starter Zach Britton tossed 7.2 SHO IP...suffered 3rd straight loss 4/25 vs. TOR, allowing 6 runs - all on 3 HR's that came in span of 4 batters...beat Brett Anderson 4/30 at OAK in 11-2 win...took CG loss 5/5 at SEA, posting career-high 11 K's in a 3-1 loss, his 2nd career CG...on 5/10 vs. OAK, survived 59-min. rain delay, retiring 5 of the 6 batters he faced following his return in 7-2 victory...tossed first career CG SHO 5/16 at CWS (see note below)...took loss in matchup with Cliff Lee 4/21 at PHI, a 2-0 defeat...took ND in Rangers' in 14-inn. loss 5/27 vs. K.C., allowing 6 runs in the first 2 innings, but exiting with 7-6 lead after 6 innings...combined with Feliz on 5-hit SHO 6/1 at TB (8.0 IP, 0 R-ER), besting David Price...gave up 9 runs and matched career high with 4 HR in 13-7 loss on 6/6 vs. DET...surrendered 5 runs in 1st inning, allowing 7 of 10 batters he faced to reach, lasting just 1.1 innings 6/11 at MIN...allowed only solo HR's to McCann and Freeman in a 6-2 win on 6/17 at ATL...took ND despite exiting with 2-0 lead thru 7 in 5-3 loss 6/22 vs. HOU...secured Lone Star Series win for Texas 6/29 at HOU, holding Astros scoreless through 6...won 3rd consec. decision 7/9 vs. OAK, as Texas offense backed Lewis with 10 XBH's...tallied 9 K's and exited with game tied 5-5 on 7/9 vs OAK in a 7-6 walk-off win...came within one out of a CG SHO 7/15 at SEA, a 4-0 win (8.2 IP, 4 H, 0 R-ER)...was his first career victory in 7 tries at Safeco Field...set down 13 straight before a one-out single in 9th by Ackley...threw a career-high 121 pitches...matched career high with 5th straight win 7/22 vs. TOR (12-2 win) and had no-hitter broken up to lead off 6th...took 7-2 loss 7/27 vs. MIN (6.2 IP, 4 R-ER), as Mauer/Cuddyer had pair of solo HR's in 4th and pair of RBI-singles in 5th...took ND on 32nd birthday 8/2 at DET, a 6-5 Texas loss (4.0 IP, 5 R-4 ER)...snapped stretch of 8 straight starts of 6.0+ innings.
