Of Note: The Rainiers failed to hold onto an early lead and dropped their series opener with Fresno 7-2 on Friday night. **Alex Liddi** gave the Rainiers an early 1-0 lead in the bottom of the 1st after driving in Greg Halman with a single to left field. The RBI marked Liddi's 100th of the season and places the infielder alongside Craig Kusick (1973) as the only 2 players in Tacoma baseball history to score 100 runs and collect 100 RBI in a single season.

CAMPOS AND BLASH NAMED TO NORTHWEST LEAGUE POST-SEASON ALL-STAR TEAM

RHP **Jose Campos** and OF **Jabari Blash** were named to the Northwest League Post-Season All-Star Team.

Jose Campos is 5-5 with a 2.32 ERA (21 ER, 81.1 IP) in 14 starts for Everett this season. He has limited opponents to a .214 average (66x309) with 13 walks and 85 strikeouts. He leads the Northwest League in ERA (2.12) strikeouts (85), while ranking T1st in WHIP (0.97), 2nd in fewest baserunners/9.0 (8.96), opponent average (.210), highest strikeouts/9.0 innings (9.41), lowest walks/9.0 (1.44), innings pitched (76.1) and T7th in wins (5).

Jabari Blash is batting .290 (56x193) with 26 runs scored, 16 doubles, 3 triple, 11 home runs and 43 RBI in 56 game with Everett. He currently leads the Northwest League in slugging percentage (.575), while ranking T3rd in home runs (11). He began the season with Clinton batting .218 (27x124) in 42 games.

TOTH NAMED SOUTHERN LEAGUE TRAINER OF THE YEAR

Matt Toth of the Jackson Generals has been selected by his peers as the 2011 Southern League Trainer of the Year. Matt now becomes one of 17 league winners to be considered for Minor League Athletic Trainer of the Year, which will be announced and awarded at the Winter Meetings.

Toth, 34 resides in Albany, OR with wife Annie and son Alex. This is Matt's sixth season as a trainer in the Mariners organization.
