#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost the past two games to snap their nine-game winning streak...are 76-59 (.563) for the season, which is tied with New York and Baltimore for the second best record in the American League...are in second place in the AL West and trail Texas by four games...are tied with New York/Baltimore for the first Wild Card slot, 1½ games ahead of third place Tampa Bay...had their five-series winning streak snapped, their longest since May 28-June 14, 2007 when they also won five in a row...are 3-2 on this six-game homestand against Boston (3-0) and Los Angeles (0-2).
- The A's have hit at least one home run in each of the last 11 games (23 home runs total)...have a **Major League leading** 75 home runs since the All-Star Break.
- Jarrold Parker** is 4-5 with a 2.48 ERA (24 er in 87.0 ip) in 13 starts at home compared to 5-3 with a 5.37 ERA (36 er in 60.1 ip) in 11 starts on the road...is 0-2 with a 3.05 ERA (7 er in 20.2 ip) in three starts against Los Angeles.
- Josh Donaldson** (1 for 4) is 25 for 75 (.333) with seven doubles, five home runs and 15 RBI in 20 games since he was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento August 14.
- Brandon Moss** (1 for 4) is 11 for 29 (.379) with eight runs, two doubles, four home runs and 10 RBI over his last eight games.
- Seth Smith** (1 for 3) is 12 for 37 (.324) with 10 runs, four doubles, two home runs and five RBI in 11 games since he was reinstated from the disabled list August 21.

#### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels have won seven of the last eight games and 11 of the last 14...are now a season-high tying 10 games over .500...are 4-1 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (2-0).
- Zack Greinke** is 3-0 with a 1.66 ERA (4 er in 21.2 ip) over his past three starts...has allowed a home run in a career-high seven straight starts (previous: 6, May 20-June 16, 2005)...is 6-1 with a 3.12 ERA (26 er in 75.0 ip) in 15 career appearances, 11 starts, against the A's...that includes 3-0 with a 2.70 ERA (12 er in 40.0 ip) in nine games, six starts, in Oakland.
- Erick Aybar** (1 for 3) is batting .349 (37 for 106) with 21 runs and 11 RBI over his last 27 games...is a .340 (54 for 159) career hitter in Oakland, which is tied for third highest in Coliseum history (min. 150 PA).
- Kendrys Morales** (3 for 5) had three hits, his 10<sup>th</sup> game of three or more hits this year...his season-high is four hits (April 7 vs. Kansas City).
- Albert Pujols** (2 for 5) is on a 13-game hitting streak and is batting .377 (20 for 53) with seven doubles, three home runs and 10 RBI over that span.
- Mike Trout** (2 for 5) has 48 multiple hit games this season, which is second most by a rookie in Angels history (Wally Joyner, 52).
