OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their first "walk-off" win...last year, had a Major League leading 14 regular season "walk-off" wins...the A's 9-2 record is the best in the AL, second best in the majors (Atlanta, 9-1) and tied for the second best mark in Oakland history after 11 games...the only other times in Oakland history the A's started the year at least 9-2 were in 1981 (11-0) and 1990 (9-2).
- The A's nine-game winning streak is the 13th of nine or more games in Oakland history...it is the second longest in Oakland history among streaks that took place entirely in the month of April...the longest April winning streak in Oakland history is 11 in 1981 (April 9-19).
- The A's scored four runs and now have 70 for the season, which is two more than their total for the entire month of April last year...the four runs snapped their streak of six consecutive games with six or more runs, which was the fourth longest streak in Oakland history...had their streak of eight straight games with 10 or more hits snapped, which **matched the longest streak of consecutive games with at least 10 hits in Oakland history** (August 22-30, 2002).
- Coco Crisp** (2 for 4, rbi, so 2 sb) left the game in the 10th inning with a strained left groin...he is day-to-day...has hit safely in each of his last nine games (16 for 41, .390)...had his streak of eight consecutive games with a run snapped, which matched the longest of his career (Sept. 5-13, 2010).
- Josh Donaldson** (2 for 5, 2 r, 2b, hr, rbi) hit a "walk-off" home run, his first career "walk-off" hit.
- Josh Reddick** (1 for 4, rbi, bb, 2 so) returned to the lineup after missing the past three games with a sprained right wrist.

- The Detroit Tigers took the loss in their first extra-inning game of the season...are 0-1 on this nine-game, 10-day road trip to Oakland (0-1), Seattle (three games) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Max Scherzer** recorded 11 strikeouts, his seventh career game of 11 or more strikeouts (last: 12 so, June 17, 2012 vs. Colorado).
- Prince Fielder** (4 for 5, r, 2b, hr, 3 rbi) had a season-high four hits, his sixth career game of four or more hits (last: 4, Oct. 1, 2012 at Kansas City)...the four hits extended his hitting streak to seven games (13 for 24, .542).
- Austin Jackson** (2 for 6, r, so) has started each of the first 10 games and has reached base safely in all 10 contests...has scored at least one run in nine of those games (14 runs total).
