San Francisco Giants (28-22) at Oakland Athletics (28-23)

**TODAY'S GAME...**The Giants begin a four-game series today with their cross-bay rival, the Oakland Athletics...this four-game series will feature two games here in Oakland and then two in San Francisco (Wed.-Thurs.), part of MLB's new home-and-home series format for "prime rival" Interleague games...**RHP Dan Straily** (2-2, 5.73) will face **LHP Madison Bumgarner** (4-2, 2.89) in the opening game of this series.

**THE GIANTS...**Are coming off a six-game homestand where they went 4-2 against the Washington Nationals (2-1) and Colorado Rockies (2-1)...the Giants enter today's contest tied with the D-backs for first place in the NL West.

**HAPPY MEMORIAL DAY!**...Across Major League Baseball today, players and coaches will wear Marine Corps-licensed jerseys and caps, along with participating in a moment of silence before all games.

**WELCOME TO THE BIGS...**The Giants announced yesterday that **LHP Michael Kickham** (#59) will make his big league debut tomorrow, starting in place of **RHP Ryan Vogelsong**, who fractured his right hand last week...Kickham is scheduled to be added to the Major League roster tomorrow and SF will have to make 40-man and 25-man roster moves.

**MORE ABOUT THE KID...**Kickham, 24, has gone 3-4 with a 4.33 ERA (26er, 54.0ip) in 10 starts for the triple-A Fresno Grizzlies this season...he was 0-3 with a 7.94 figure (20er, 22.2ip) in his first five starts, but has gone 3-1 with a 1.72 ERA (6er, 31.1ip) in his past five assignments...he will become the first player from the Giants' 2010 draft class to reach the Majors, as he was drafted in the sixth round that year by SF.

**TOUGH ROAD AHEAD...**Today begins a stretch for the Giants in which they play 14 of their next 18 games on the road, with visits to teams with the top four records in the National League: the Cardinals (32-17, .653), Pirates (31-19, .620), Braves (30-19, .612) and D-backs (28-22, .560)...24 of the Giants' next 35 games are on the road.

**ROAD WOES...**The Giants are just 9-13 (.409) on the road this season, losing their last three road contests and five of their last six...in fact, the Giants have lost 11 of their past 15 road games and have won just three road series all year.

**INSIDE THE SERIES...**San Francisco went 4-2 against Oakland last season and have won 10 of the last 15 meetings, although they are just 19-27 here at O.co Coliseum, dropping seven of their last nine games here.

**FIRST INNING RUNS...**The Giants lead the league in runs allowed in the 1st inning, having allowed 35 runs in the 1st frame...SF gave up two runs in the 1st inning in each game of their last three games with the Rockies...the Twins have given up the most 1st inning runs in the Majors, allowing 53.

**POSEY AT THE PLATE...****C Buster Posey** enters today's contest with a season-high 10-game hitting streak, batting .421 (16-for-38) with two HRs and five RBI...Posey has recorded at least one hit in 16 of his last 17 games, hitting .371 (23-for-62).

**TODAY'S STARTER...****LHP Madison Bumgarner** is 2-2 with a 4.79 ERA (19er, 35.2ip) in six career Interleague games...the southpaw was 0-2 with a 14.73 figure (12er, 7.1ip) in his first two Interleague starts, but is 2-0 with a 2.22 ERA (7er, 28.1ip) in his last four outings.

**ANOTHER COMEBACK...**Over half of the Giants' 28 wins this season have been come-from-behind victories...their 15 such wins are tied with the Braves, A's and Rangers for the most in the Majors.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY...**The Giants are 0-2 in Interleague play this season, losing their only two games thus far to the Toronto Blue Jays...besides the A's, the Giants will play the Blue Jays, Rays, Orioles, Red Sox and Yankees in the AL this season...SF went 7-8 in Interleague last season and have gone 130-126 (.508) overall in Interleague since it began in 1997.

**WITH THE BATS...**The Giants' offense enters today's game leading the National League with a .272 batting avg. (466-for-1,716)...the Giants are also averaging 4.56 runs per game, the fourth-highest figure in the NL.

**GAME TIME CHANGE...**Please be advised that ESPN has selected the game of Sunday, June 16 (SF @ ATL)...the game will be dropped from the CSN Bay Area TV schedule and the game time will be moved from 10:35 a.m. (PT)/1:35 p.m. (ET) to 5:05 p.m. (PT)/8:05 p.m. (ET).

**TODAY'S OUTING**

- 23-year-old will be making his 11th start of the 2013 season...will mark his 95th start and 98th career appearance.
- Has been the Giants' best and most consistent pitcher thus far, going 4-2 with a 2.89 ERA (21er, 65.1ip) and .209 avg. against (49-for-235) in 10 starts, seven of which are quality outings...the Giants are 6-4 in his assignments (SF won his first four outings, but are 2-4 since).
- Is 2-0 with a 1.61 ERA (5er, 28.0ip) in four day games.

**2013 STARTS (LAST THREE)**

- Did not factor into a decision in his last outing on Wednesday vs. Washington in the Giants' 2-1 10-inning loss...matched up with former A's hurler Gio Gonzalez and tossed 7.0 innings, allowing just one run (a Bryce Harper HR) on four hits.
- Was touched for a career-high nine runs (seven earned) in his start on May 17 at Colorado, a 10-9 Giants loss...was staked to a 4-0 lead through the first 2.0 innings, but SF committed a season-high four errors, including one by Bumgarner that led to a run in the 2nd inning...couldn't escape the 5th inning as the Rockies scored five runs off him on three hits, including a grand slam from Jordan Pacheco that ended his night.
- Earned a win on May 11 against the Braves at AT&T Park in the Giants' 10-1 victory...struck out a season-high 11 batters in 7.0 innings of work while allowing just one run on four hits.

**VS. OAKLAND**

- Will make his second career start against the A's in the opening game of this four-game series.
- In his only start against Oakland, he earned the win on June 23, 2012, tossing 6.0 innings and allowings four runs on 11 hits in SF's 9-8 win here at the Oakland Coliseum.

**IN INTERLEAGUE**

- Has gone 2-2 with a 4.79 ERA (19er, 35.2ip) in six career Interleague starts.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER: Michael Kickham**

- 24-year-old left-hander will be making his Major League debut tonight, taking the place of Ryan Vogelsong in the starting rotation as Vogelsong is on the disabled list with a fractured right hand...has made 10 starts for triple-A Fresno this season and has gone 3-4 with a 4.33 ERA (26er, 54.0ip)...prior to being called-up, ranked third in the PCL with 54 strikeouts...was striking out 9.0 batters per 9.0 innings pitched.

- LH hitters are hitting .394 (13x33) off him compared to .188 (12x64) vs. RHH.
- His 25.1 innings pitched rank as the second most out of the bullpen.

- Since '09, has allowed just 23/164 (14.0%) IRs to score, which is the lowest figure in ML.

- Left-handers are hitting .308 (8-for-26) off him.

- Has a career WHIP of 0.89, the second-lowest figure in the Majors among active pitchers with at least 250.0ip.
