TODAY'S GAME: The Cardinals continue an 8-game (1-1 at HOU, 0-1 at OAK, LAA-3), 10-day interleague roadtrip today with the 2nd of three games here in Oakland...first pitch is set for 1:05 p.m. CT...the Cardinals snapped a season-high 3 game losing streak on Tuesday, but have lost 5 of their last 6 and are 13-13 in the month of June.

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny last season became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history... in his first year at the helm in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs, having captured the 2nd Wild Card berth on the next-to-last day of the regular season...he became the first rookie manager to lead the Cardinals to the postseason since Eddie Dyer in 1946...he won his 100th career game on Apr. 23, 2013, at Washington in his 182nd game...Matheny had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and for consecutive errorless chances (1,565).

THIS DATE IN STL HISTORY: In 1933, in the top of the 2nd, Ethan Allen of the Cardinals races around the bases for an inside-the-park HR at the Polo Grounds, but is out for batting out of turn, as Joe Medwick was the correct batter.

REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The 2012 N.L. Wild Card Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 122nd season of play in the National League...the Cardinals snapped their season-high 3-game losing streak with a 13-5 win on Tue. at HOU, but have lost their last two games and in doing so have fallen from 1st place in the NL Central for the first time since April 29...they had held sole possession of 1st place since April 30 and had a season-best 4.0 game lead as recently as June 9...St. Louis leads the majors with a +108 run differential.

INTERLEAGUE: The Cardinals began a string of 11-straight interleague games last Friday (TEX-3, at HOU-2, at OAK-3, at LAA-3) playing their 2nd ever regular season series with Texas...St. Louis is 4-6 (3-2 on road) in interleague play this season, and the Cardinals are 129-116 (.527) all-time in interleague play, the top winning pct. amongst all NL teams...**RARE BIRD SIGHTINGS:** The Cardinals this weekend are making only their 2nd appearance in Oakland, having last appeared at the Coliseum in 2007 when they won 2-of-3 games...the Redbirds will make their first ever visit to Anaheim next week when they will take on the Angels in a 3-game series, completing the circuit of current MLB cities that they had never visited...the Texas Rangers last weekend became the last team to have visited St. Louis prior to this season, although they did get to the Mound City for the 2011 Fall Classic.

DESIGNATED TO HIT: Cardinals designated hitters are the all-time leaders amongst N.L. teams in batting (.315; 151-479), on-base pct. (.391) & slugging pct. (.532)...St. Louis has employed Matt Holliday (twice), Carlos Beltran (twice) & Allen Craig (once) as its designated hitters this season.

NO SWEAT: Edward Mujica on June 19th converted his 21st straight save opportunity to begin the season...it's the best start to a season for a Redbirds closer since 1995 when Tom Henke was perfect in his first 22 save opps, the club record..."Chief" Mujica has posted 13 saves without allowing a baserunner this season...Lee Smith had 22 "perfect" saves for the Redbirds in 1992 among his league-leading 43 rescues.

CENTERPIECE: Jon Jay owns the NL's longest active errorless streak (222 games/522 chances) for centerfielders dating back to his last error on Aug. 24, 2011...his 222-game errorless streak is 2nd only to Curt Flood (226 games, 9/3/65 to 6/2/67) amongst Cardinals outfielders.

CRAIG'S LIST: Allen Craig, 2nd in the NL with 62 RBI, is batting a league-leading .455 with runners in scoring position (tied with Carlos Beltran) and he's T3rd in the NL with 17 go-ahead RBI...Craig's 62 RBI with just 8 HR's are the most by a Cardinals batter with less than 10+ HR's in the team's first 79 games since 1985 when Tom Herr had 63 RBI with just 3 home runs thru the team's first 79 games...Dwight Evans (BOS), who had 62 RBI and just 7 HR's in the Red Sox first 79 games in 1988, is the last to have accomplished what Craig has done thus far.

ADAM WAINWRIGHT • RHP • 6-7 • 228 • 31 yrs • #50

⇒ Will make his team-leading 17th start, 2nd career start vs. OAK.
 ⇒ Only prior meeting with A's came on 6/19/10 at STL when he posted a 4-3 win, allowing one unearned run in 8.0 IP.
 ⇒ Is 1-1, 2.45 ERA this season in interleague play (5/27 at KC: 8.0 IP, 3R & 6/23 vs. TEX: 6.2 IP, 2 R). Has a career 7-5 interleague record, 3.09 ERA in 20 games, 14 starts.
 ⇒ Last season went 1-1 in 3 interleague starts, lasting 7.0 innings in each start and allowing no more than 2 runs in any of them.
 ⇒ Has lost 3-straight games only 3 times in career, last 8/31-9/11/12.
 ⇒ Recorded 1,000 career strikeout 6/13 at NYM (D.Wright) in 1st inn.
 ⇒ Was the first N.L. pitcher to 10 wins, doing so at NYM on 6/13.
 ⇒ Allowed four first inning runs vs. CHI in his 6/18 start and went 6.0 scoreless more (7.0 IP), but still took the loss, 4-2. Gave up 2, 1st-inning HRs after allowing 2 all season (both at MIL).
 ⇒ T2nd in NL wins (10), 6th in ERA (2.31), 4th in IP (116.2), 4th in strikeouts (106), 1st in BB/9 IP (0.77) and 2nd in HR/9 IP (0.31).
 ⇒ BBed 10 batters, fewest among NL starters. Seven starts w/o BBs.
 ⇒ Didn't walk a batter in first 34.2 IP to start season. Since 1900 is 2nd longest STL streak: Slim Sallee in 1913, no walks in 1st 40.0 IP.
 ⇒ Pitched a CG 4-hit shutout with 12 K's vs. MIL on 4/13. Became 1st Cards pitcher since Bob Gibson (6/17/70) to pitch CG shutout w/a K in every inning as Adam fanned 12 (tied career high).
 ⇒ Signed largest contract by STL pitcher (5 yrs, 2014-18) on 3/28.
