#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics now have lost five of their last seven series and are 9-12 over that stretch,,,finished the homestand with a 4-5 record against Houston (1-2), Cleveland (2-1) and Seattle (1-2).
- A.J. Griffin** allowed his Major League leading 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> home runs of the season...22 of the 30 home runs have been solo shots...was the 11<sup>th</sup> game this season in which he has allowed at least two home runs...walked the leadoff hitter in three of his six innings, but just one of those walks scored (Morales, sixth inning)...has gone 0-2 with two no decisions over his last four starts.
- Coco Crisp** (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, bb) hit his 12<sup>th</sup> career leadoff home run in the bottom of the first inning...was his 10<sup>th</sup> with the A's and fourth this season...tied Campy Campaneris for second most in Athletics history (Henderson, 43).
- Jed Lowrie** (1 for 4, 3b) tripled for the second consecutive game...prior to yesterday, he had not tripled since September 25, 2011 at New York (AL)...is batting .373 (22 for 59) with nine doubles, two triples, two home runs and 10 RBI in 15 games against Seattle this season.
- Brandon Moss** (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, so) hit his second home run of the series and fifth against Seattle this season...the five home runs are the most he has hit against a single opponent this season...he is now tied for the team lead with 20 home runs (Céspedes).

#### SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners finished their road trip with a 5-4 record against Tampa Bay (1-2), Texas (2-1), and Oakland (2-1).
- Hisashi Iwakuma** allowed three or fewer earned runs for the seventh time in his last eight starts...surrendered two home runs today after allowing two home runs over his last seven starts combined (46.2 IP)...improved to 5-2 over his last seven decisions.
- Michael Morse** (2 for 4, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) broke a 0 for 18 stretch with a home run in the second inning...was just his second home run since May 28 (27 games)...is now 6 for 9 in his career against A.J. Griffin with two doubles, two home runs, two RBI and three strikeouts.
- Brendan Ryan** (2 for 4, 2b, 3 rbi, 2 so) recorded his first extra-base hit since hitting a home run on July 10 vs. Boston (11 games)...entering today, he had just four RBI in his last 28 games dating back to June 10.
