OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have gone 10-3 over their last 13 games...have a magic number of three over Cleveland to clinch a playoff spot...the
 magic number to clinch the American League West is four.
- Dan Straily tossed a career-high 105 pitches...is 4-0 with a 2.15 ERA (7 er in 29.1 ip) over his last five starts.
- Alberto Callaspo (1 for 2, r, hr, rbi, so) hit his second career pinch-hit home run (previous: May 26, 2012 at Seattle).
- Coco Crisp (2 for 4, 2 r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) hit his 21st home run of the season, which is an on-going career high...recorded his 57th walk, also a career high.
- **Josh Donaldson** (2 for 4, r, bb) has reached base safely via hit or walk in each of his last 24 games, which is the longest streak by an Athletics over the last five years...is batting .372 (32 for 86) with 20 runs, nine doubles, one triple, five home runs, 18 runs and 15 walks (2 hbp, 1 sf).
