OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have won 16 of their last 21 home games after losing six straight...with tonight's win, the A's are a season-high 17 games over .500...are 5-2 on this 10-game homestand against New York-AL (2-1), Texas (2-1) and Boston (1-0).
- **Scott Kazmir** is 4-0 with a 1.27 ERA (5 er in 35.1 ip) over his last five starts and has allowed two runs or fewer in each of those starts.
- **Dan Otero** recorded his first career major league save.
- **Yoenis Céspedes** (2 for 4, r, hr, rbi) is batting .324 (23 for 71) in 17 games in June after batting .245 over his first 52 games.
- **Coco Crisp** (1 for 3, bb, sb) is batting .383 (23 for 60) with 17 runs, six doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, 11 walks, and six multiple hit games over his last 17 games.
- **Josh Donaldson** (1 for 4) has hit safely in the each of his last five games (6 for 20, .300) since snapping his career-high 0-for-33 hitless streak.
- **Stephen Vogt** (1 for 2, 2 rbi, bb) is 10 for 25 (.400) over his last eight games after going 5 for 19 (.263) over his first six contests.

BOSTON NOTES

- The **Boston Red Sox** have scored just seven runs in their last four games despite being 3-1 over that span...are now 0-1 on their 10-game roadtrip to Oakland (0-1), Seattle (three games), and New York-AL (three games).
- **Jake Peavy** has lost each of his last five decisions dating back to May 1...is 1-3 with a 5.23 ERA (25 er in 43.0 ip) in seven road starts this season.
- **Jackie Bradley Jr.** (1 for 2, 2b) snapped his 0-for-11 hitless streak with a double in the third inning.
- **Brock Holt** (1 for 4, r, so) has hit safely in 16 of his last 19 games (.354, 29 for 82) since May 31 with multiple hits in nine of those contests.
- **Dustin Pedroia** (2 for 4, r, 2b, hr, 2 rbi, so) hit his fourth career home run off of Scott Kazmir, including two in the postseason...that is his most home runs against any single pitcher.
