### THE LATEST:

- Yesterday the Blue Jays lost **1-0 in 12 innings** in Oakland to drop to 47-41...It was the **12th time** to be held to one run or less (6<sup>th</sup> on the road)... It was the longest game of the season at 4:05 and the second time to play 12 innings...With the loss the Blue Jays fell 0.5 games out of first place – first time since May 21...Held sole possession of first place in the AL East for 42 consecutive days from May 22 to July 2 – longest stretch since 1993 (June 24- end of season, 90 days).
- Prior to yesterday the club **last played a 1-0 game** on July 13, 2012 vs Cleveland when the Blue Jays were defeated in Toronto.
- Yesterday was the club's **93<sup>rd</sup> 1-0 game**, now 50-43, and tied for the third-longest 1-0 game at 12 innings...The longest 1-0 game was a 15 inning loss, also to the A's in Oakland on July 27, 1986...Three of the four longest 1-0 games have been vs the A's in Oakland...The six longest 1-0 games have **all been losses and all road games.**

### STROMAN's DAY:

- Yesterday Marcus Stroman had a no-decision after pitching 7.0 shutout innings to lower his ERA to 3.44 (3H, 3BB, 7K)...As a starter he is now 3-2 with a 2.08 ERA (10ER/43.1IP)...**Six of his seven starts** have been quality starts...Has allowed just **8 hits** in his last three starts - 21.2IP.
- Matched his career best with seven strikeouts for the third time this season...As a starter has 11 walks and 39 strikeouts in 43.1 innings...Threw a career high 115 pitches.

### THIS & THAT:

- Have lost **five** of their last **seven**, **eight** of their last **13** & **11** of their last **17** contests...Have won just **two** of their last **eight** completed series (**2-5-1**) dating back to **June 6**...Since that point have posted a record of **10-17** & have been outscored **112-93** (-19 run differential)...Have batted just **.198** (41-207) with RISP over that period...However, over that stretch since **June 6**, TOR **starters** have worked at least **six** innings in **20** of those **27** games.
- Jose Reyes** now needs just 8 stolen bases to reach **450** for his career...Only 52 players have stolen 450 career bases...Currently ranks **T6th in the AL** with 17 SB this season

### ON THE ROAD AGAIN:

- Tonight, TOR continues a **10-game road trip** with the 3<sup>rd</sup> of a **4-game series** at OAK...Following the series with the A's, travel to Anaheim to take on the Angels in a **3-game set**...Enjoy an **off-day** on **July 10** before concluding the road trip with a **3-game series** at Tampa Bay ...This trip leads into the **all-star break** which will conclude the **1<sup>st</sup>** half of the season.
- Are **22-20** on the road, having dropped **four** straight, **seven** of their last **eight & nine** of their last **12** contests...Prior to those last **12** games on the road, TOR had won **six in a row & 11 of 12** games... Are looking to avoid dropping **five** straight games on the road for the **1<sup>st</sup>** time since a **7-game losing streak** from **Aug. 18-24, 2013**...Have lost back to back series (**0-3** at NYY/1-2 at CIN) for the **1<sup>st</sup>** time since **April 29-May 3** (1-2 at KC/1-2 at PIT).

- Despite yesterday's loss, TOR has won **eight** of their last **14** meetings since **2012**...TOR has also won **four** of their last **seven & six** of their last **12** contests in Oakland.
- TOR recorded a **3-game sweep** in their previous series at **Rogers Centre** (**May 23-25**)...TOR allowed just **five** runs over those **3-games** (outscored them, **11-5**)...It was the **1<sup>st</sup>** sweep of the A's in a series of **3-games or more** since **2003**...It was the **1<sup>st</sup>** time TOR won **three** straight games in a season since **2008** (**six** straight).

### EDWING FLYING!:

- Edwin Encarnacion** is currently tied for **2<sup>nd</sup> in the Majors** with **26-HR** (Joel Abreu-27, **Nelson Cruz-26**)...Since **2012**, **no player in the Majors has hit more HR than Edwin-104 HR** (**Miguel Cabrera** ranks **2<sup>nd</sup>** with **102**)...Has hit **150** career HR as a Blue Jay which ranks **7<sup>th</sup>** on the all-time club HR list...His **26-HR prior to the break** are the **6<sup>th</sup>** most in club history, a career high...The club record for most HR **prior to the break** is **31-HR** set by **Jose Bautista** in **2011**.
- Prior to **May 1**, Edwin was batting **.250** with **2-HR, 15-RBI** & a **.747 OPS** in **27** games...Over his last **60** games since that point, is batting **.291** with **24-HR, 54-RBI** & a **1.062 OPS**...**Since May 1, leads the Majors in HR, RBI, SLG (.677), XBH (37), TB (151) & OPS.**
- He **leads the Majors** with **49-XBH** this season (**one** more than **Mike Trout** who ranks **2<sup>nd</sup>**)...The **49-XBH prior to the break** represents a career high & ranks **T-5<sup>th</sup>** most by a Blue Jay...**Carlos Delgado** (**55-XBH** in **2000**) & **Vernon Wells** (**55-XBH** in **2003**) own the club record for most XBH prior to the break.

### GOING STRONG:

- Jose Bautista** has reached base safely in **76** of his **81** starts this season, having recorded a hit in **60** of those contests...Has hit safely in **33** of his last **45** games since **May 12** (.314, 8-2B, 8-HR, 26-RBI, 26-BB, .421 OBP, .944 OPS)...Despite missing **six** games from **June 23-28**, still **leads the Majors** with **60-BB**...Among the AL, ranks **1<sup>st</sup>** in OBP (.425), times on base (**151**), **5<sup>th</sup>** in OPS (.955), **8<sup>th</sup>** in SLG (.529) & **T-10<sup>th</sup>** in HR (**17**).

### DID YOU KNOW?

- Yesterday hitting coach **Kevin Sietzer** was ejected by **HP Umpire Vic Carapazza**...Was the **second ejection** from an MLB game for Sietzer, who had one ejection as a player on August 9, 1992 by Vic Carapazza's father in law, **Richie Garcia** (David Vincent, Retrosheet).

### TROUBLE ON THE LEFT:

- TOR ranks last in the AL with a **.234** batting average vs. LHP this season, despite posting a record of **12-11** when facing a left-handed starter (5-4 on the road)...Are batting just **.137** (18-131) when facing a southpaw over their last **12** contests.

### YARD WORK:

- TOR **leads the Majors** with **113-HR** this season (**eight** more than BAL who rank **2<sup>nd</sup>**)...The **113-HR** prior to the break currently ranks **T-8<sup>th</sup>** most in club history...Hit **115-HR** in the **1<sup>st</sup>** half of **2013**...No team since **2010**, has hit more HR than TOR in the month of **July** with **137** (**10** more than BAL/BOS who rank **2<sup>nd</sup>**).

### STRONG STARTERS:

- The Blue Jays starting staff ranks **T-2<sup>nd</sup>** in the AL (**T-4<sup>th</sup>** in ML) with **36** victories this season (DET leads AL with **37**)...Did not receive their **36<sup>th</sup>** win from a starter in **2013** until game **#136** (**Aug. 31**)...TOR starters have worked at least **6.0 IP** in **12** consecutive contests, posting an ERA of **2.94** (28ER/85.2) while holding opponents to a **.200** AVG...However, have the team has won just **five** of the **12**.

**TONIGHT'S START & 2013/14 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- ★ Is making his 28th career start (32nd appearance) vs. the Athletics... Will be making his 447th consecutive start without a DL stint...This represents the longest active streak in the Majors.
- ★ Over his last five starts is 0-4 despite a 3.44 ERA (34IP/13ER) and a .254 opponents' average.
- ★ Is T-3rd in the Majors with 10 wins and is 4th in the AL with a 2.50 ERA... Has allowed just eight home runs thru his 17 starts, although six have come in his last five starts...Has allowed 1-ER or less in seven and 2-ER or less in 13 of his 17-GS this season.
- ★ Once again is the MLB leader in pace, being the quickest between pitches at 16.9 seconds...Teammate R.A. Dickey is 2nd at 18.3...Has allowed just 13 hits with RISP, holding opponents to a .149 avg. (13-87), 3rd lowest in AL (Norris-.137/Tanaka-.141).
- ★ Since July 23, 2013 is 2nd in ML with 17 wins, while posting a 2.76 ERA (8th)...In 22 of those 30 starts has limited the opposition to just two ER or less.
- ★ Suffered the loss despite working 8.0 IP, allowing just two runs in his last start vs. CWS, and has now lost his last four decisions (five starts)... Tossed at least 8.0 IP for the 3rd time this season... Has now recorded 12 straight outings of 6.0+ IP which marks the longest such streak since 13 consecutive starts from April 12-June 21, 2009...His career best is 49 straight starts with 6+IP from 5/11/04-7/26/05.
- ★ Lost his 3rd consecutive start, 7-3 at NY...1st time to lose three straight starts since June 1-19, 2012.
- ★ Earned the victory (8.0, 6H, BB, 3K) to improve to 10-1 on the season, June 1 vs. KC... Was the quickest to 10 wins in his career & in the Majors this season, becoming the 1st Jay to do so since Roy Halladay in 2009 (June 7, 13-GS)...Only Roger Clemens reached 10 wins in a season quicker than Buehrle, doing so in his first 11 starts of 1997...The 6-game win streak was one shy for longest streak in Majors this season (K. Lohse, 7G)...It marked the 4th time this year that he has worked at least 7.0 IP without allowing a run...He and Roger Clemens are the only Blue Jays to win at least 10 of their first 12 starts (Clemens won 12 of his first 13 in 1997).
- ★ In his season debut came within one out of a complete game shutout, winning 3-0 at TB on April 2... Struck out 11, one shy of his career-high and was only 2nd time in career to post 10+ strikeouts.
- ★ Extended his streak of 10+ wins, 30+ starts and 200+ innings to 13 seasons representing the longest active streak in the Majors.

**VS. THE ATHLETICS:**

- ★ First start vs. A's in 2014...Won both last year, tossing seven shutout innings in OAK on July 30...Has now won four consecutive starts vs. the A's and dating back to 2011 is 4-0 with a 2.41 ERA (33.2IP/9ER) in five starts.

**CAREER NOTES:**

- ★ Became just the 2<sup>nd</sup> pitcher ever to record a streak of 13 or more seasons with more than 200.0 innings pitched and fewer than 61 walks, joining Cy Young who did so in 13 straight seasons from 1897-1909.
- ★ Set a Major League record by retiring 45 consecutive batters from July 18-28, 2009.

- ♦ On the road has a **2.08** ERA (3ER/13.0), holding opp. to a **.192** AVG.

- ♦ As a reliever, since **2013**, has posted a **2.18** ERA (11ER/45.2)...Has **41-SO** over that span while surrendering **5-HR**.
