OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** snapped a 12-game losing streak in one-run games at home that dated back to September 6, 2014 (4-3 vs. Houston)...it was the longest such streak in Athletics history...are 1-10 in one-run games at home this season...have won 15 of their last 20 games against the Yankees...improved to 7-16 (.304) at home this season...are 9-18 in May...have committed at least one error in 21 of the last 25 games (30 errors total) and have 51 errors for the season...the errors have led to 30 unearned runs...are 2-2 on this seven-game homestand against Detroit (1-2) and New York (1-0).
- A's** starting pitchers had their streak of five consecutive games without allowing an earned run snapped...it was the longest such streak by an A's team since at least 1914...are 4-7 with a 2.39 ERA (25 er in 94.1 ip) over the last 16 games and have a 3.28 ERA (107 er in 294.0 ip) for the season.
- Kendall Graveman** tossed more than five innings for the third time in six starts this year...is 0-2 with a 10.54 ERA (16 er in 13.2 ip) at home this season.
- Fernando Abad** has pitched fewer than 1.0 innings in each of his last 14 outings (5.2 ip, 8 h, 6 r, 6 er, 2 bb, 4 k, 3 hr, 9.53 ERA), which is the longest such streak in Athletics history.
- Billy Burns** (2-for-4, 2 r, hr, rbi) homered for the second time in his past five games...that matches his total in 406 career minor league games...recorded his ninth multiple hit contest of the season.
- Brett Lawrie** (1-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, k) is batting .298 (28-for-94) in May after hitting .229 in April.
- Marcus Semien** has committed at least one error in 10 of his last 19 games (12 errors total) and now has 18 errors for the season...they are the most errors by an A's shortstop over the last four years (Pennington, 22 in 2011).

NEW YORK NOTES

- The **New York Yankees** snapped a three-game winning streak...are 1-10 in their last 11 games at the O.co Coliseum...have homered in 34 of 48 games this season...are 0-1 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (0-1) and Seattle (three games).
- CC Sabathia** is 9-10 with a 4.75 ERA (94 er in 178 ip) in 28 career starts against the A's...lost his first road start since April 20 at Detroit (8 ip, 7 h, 2 r).
- Carlos Beltran's** (0-for-4, k) 15-game hitting streak was snapped...it was the second-longest of his career.
- Brian McCann** (3-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, k) has homered and reached base safely at least three times in three consecutive games...is 8-for-19 (.421) with five runs, one double, three homers, 10 RBI and six walks over his last six games...has at least one RBI in each of those contests...recorded his second three-hit contest and ninth multiple hit game of the season.
- Alex Rodriguez** (1-for-3, r, rbi, k) recorded his 1,996th career RBI with a fifth-inning sacrifice fly...that ties him with Barry Bonds for second all-time...has hit safely in 12 consecutive starts...is batting .354 (17-for-48) since May 13 (14 games).
