OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** have lost six of the last seven games and are 4-8 (.333) since the All-Star Break...are 0-1 on their season-long 11 game homestand against Cleveland (0-1), Baltimore (three games), and Houston (four games)...the A's are 10-13 in the month of July with one game remaining...it is the first time they will finish July with a losing record since 2009 (12-14).
- **Chris Bassitt** is 0-4 with 3.00 ERA (10 er in 30.0 ip) and .252 (28-for-111) opponents batting average in five starts...has received a total of five runs of support in his five starting assignments.
- **Billy Burns** (1-for-4, r, sb) is batting .362 (54-for-149) at home compared to .250 (42-for-168) on the road.
- **Josh Reddick** (1-for-4, 2b, rbi) is 13-for-33 (.394) with five doubles, two home runs and seven RBI over his last 10 games and is batting .311 (23-for-74) in July.

CLEVELAND NOTES

- **The Cleveland Indians** are 5-8 since the All-Star Break...are 12-13 in July after finishing June with an 11-15 record...are 1-0 on their seven game road trip against Oakland (1-0) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- **Indians starting pitchers** have tossed three consecutive complete games...it is the first time Cleveland starters have had three straight complete games since 1994...last MLB team was Oakland in 2010.
- **Carlos Carrasco** tossed his fifth career complete game (last: May 17, 2015 at TEX)...is 7-2 with a 2.82 ERA (21 er in 67.0 ip) in 10 starts on the road...is 4-0 with a 1.73 ERA (7 er in 27.1 ip) in his last five outings dating back to June 2.
- **Michael Brantley** (1-for-4, 2b, r) is 38-for-118 (.322) since June 24...has hit safely in 40 of his last 50 games.
- **Francisco Lindor** (2-for-4, r, sb) is 19-for-56 (.339) since the All-Star Break.
