#### OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** have lost three in a row...fell to 6-8 over the last 14 games and to 13-25 (.342) over the last 38 contests...hit their 39th and 40th triples of the year, tying the best single-season total in Oakland A's history (1968)...are 14-29 when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...have a tragic number of two to clinch a last place finish in the West...are 0-1 on the final homestand of the season, a six-game stand against Texas (0-1) and San Francisco (three games).
- **A's starting pitchers** are 6-19 with a 6.18 ERA (134 er in 195.0 ip) over the last 38 games dating back to Aug. 11...have tossed five innings or fewer in 18 of those contests.
- **Sean Nolin** is 1-0 with a 5.06 ERA (6 er in 10.2 ip) in two career starts against the Rangers...has pitched at least five innings in all four of his starts this season...has not allowed a hit to the opponent's clean-up hitter (0-for-12).
- **Billy Burns** (1-for-5) is batting .333 (28-for-84) over his last 19 contests...is 13-for-43 (.302) against Texas in his career (all in 2015).
- **Mark Canha** (2-for-5, r, 2b, rbi) is batting .303 (40-for-132) with seven doubles, a triple, seven home runs and 28 RBI over his last 30 games...is 14-for-49 (.286) with three home runs and 12 RBI in his career against Texas (all in 2015).
- **Marcus Semien** (2-for-4, 3b, rbi, so) is batting .289 (43-for-149) with five home runs and 20 RBI over his last 41 games dating back to Aug. 1...recorded his 28th multiple hit game of the season.

#### TEXAS NOTES

- **The Texas Rangers** have won eight of the last 11 games...won for just the third time in the last nine contests against the A's...are 31-36 (.463) against the AL West...improved to 13-7 in the month of September...are 30-29 when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...are 1-0 on their final road trip of the season, a six-game trip to Oakland (1-0) and Houston (three games).
- **The Rangers** had seven sacrifices (four sacrifice flies, three sacrifice bunts), which is one shy of the team's single-game record of eight set on Aug. 1, 1977 (five sacrifice bunts, three sacrifice flies).
- **Martin Perez** is 3-3 with a 4.02 ERA (24 er in 53.2 ip) in nine starts since Aug. 1...has now allowed more than three runs in a start twice over that span...is 3-4 with a 5.93 ERA (27 er in 41.0 ip) in eight career starts against the A's...is 0-4 with a 5.59 ERA (23 er in 37.0 ip) in six road starts this year.
- **Elvis Andrus** (2-for-4, 2 r, 2b, bb) snapped a 19 at-bat road hitless streak with a sixth-inning single...had his 40th multiple hit game of the season.
- **Adrian Beltre** (2-for-4, 2b, 2 rbi, so) is 20-for-43 (.465) with two home runs, six doubles and 14 RBI over his last 11 contests...is batting .313 (80-for-256) in 66 games since July 8, raising his average from .244 to .278...had his 42nd multiple hit game of the year.
- **Delino DeShields** (1-for-2, 2 r, 2 rbi, bb) has at least one hit in eight of his last nine games and is batting .286 (10-for-35) with nine runs over that span.
- **Mitch Moreland** (3-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) hit his 23rd home run of the season, tying the career-high he set in 2013...has hit five home runs over his last 12 games...recorded his 31st multiple hit contest of the season and his fifth three-hit game of the year.
- **Mike Napoli** (2-for-3, 2b) is batting .345 (19-for-55) with four home runs, two doubles and eight RBI over his last 21 games (16 starts)...recorded his 23rd multiple hit contest of the year...has started seven of the last nine games in left field after having no prior outfield experience as a professional.
