OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** are 7-11 over the last 18 games and 14-28 (.333) over the last 42 contests...are 1-4 against San Francisco this year...sold out the O.co Coliseum for the second consecutive game and for the sixth time this season...tied the team record for pitchers used in a nine-inning game with eight (last: July 7, 1994 at Baltimore)...thare 1-4 on the final homestand of the season, a six-game stand against Texas (0-3) and San Francisco (1-1).
- **A's starting pitchers** are 5-12 with an 8.22 ERA (98 er in 107.1 ip) in 23 games in September...have tossed five innings or fewer 13 times over that span.
- **Barry Zito** made his first major league start since Sept. 25, 2013 and his first start for Oakland since losing Game 1 of the 2006 ALCS against Detroit...faced San Francisco for the first time since May 22, 2005...is 1-2 with a 4.34 ERA (29.0 ip, 33 h, 20 r, 14 er, 10 bb, 14 so, 6 hr) in five career appearances, all starts, against the Giants.
- **Billy Butler** (2-for-4, 2 r, hr, 2 rbi, so) has six home runs and 17 RBI in 23 September games...is 7-for-16 (.438) against San Francisco this year.
- **Mark Canha** (2-for-4, 2b, 2 rbi) is batting .291 (43-for-148) with seven doubles, seven homers and 30 RBI over his last 35 games...had his 26th multiple hit game of the year.
- **Danny Valencia** (3-for-4, 2 r, bb) has reached base safely in each of his last 13 games, which is the longest reaching base streak of his career...is 17-for-50 (.340) with seven walks over that span...has hit safely in each of his last nine games (14-for-33, .424)...recorded his 25th multiple hit game of the season.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- **The San Francisco Giants** snapped a three-game losing streak...snapped a six-game losing streak at the O.co Coliseum...won for just the seventh time in the last 26 road games...are 2-3 on their final road trip of the season, a six-game trip to San Diego (1-2) and Oakland (1-1).
- **Tim Hudson** made his first career start at the O.co Coliseum as an opponent...had not pitched in Oakland since October 3, 2004...is now 46-15 with a 3.01 ERA (223 er in 666.1 ip) in 94 career starts at the Coliseum...is 1-2 with an 8.64 ERA (16 er in 16.2 ip) in four career starts against the A's.
- **Trevor Brown** (3-for-5, r, 2b) recorded the second multiple hit game of his career (both this season) and his first career three-hit contest.
- **Kelby Tomlinson** (4-for-6, 3 r, rbi) recorded his 12th multiple hit game of the season and his first career four-hit game.
- **Jarrett Parker** (3-for-5, 3 r, 3 hr, 7 rbi, so) became the first Giants rookie ever to hit three home runs in a game...is the first Giant to have three home runs and seven RBI in a game since Willie Mays had four home runs and eight RBI on April 30, 1961 at Milwaukee...is the first Giant since Pablo Sandoval to hit three homers in a game (Sept. 4, 2013 at SD) and the first Giants Rookie since Brandon Belt to hit multiple homers in a game (Aug. 14, 2011 at Florida)...is the first major league rookie to hit three home runs in a game since Andrew McCutchen (Aug. 1, 2009 vs. Washington)...became the first Giants rookie since Brandon Belt to homer in three straight games (Sept. 15-18, 2011)...hit his first career grand slam, had his first career multiple hit game and recorded his first career multiple homer game...is 9-for-18 (.500) with eight runs, a double, six home runs and 12 RBI since his Sept. 11 call-up.
