#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The **Oakland A's** had their four-game winning streak snapped, which was their second longest winning streak of the season...are now 3-1 against the Yankees this season after earning a sweep in the first series in New York...are 3-1 on this seven-game homestand against Texas (3-0) and New York-AL (0-1).
- The A's have 15 home runs over the last seven games after hitting just six home runs over the prevous 11 contests.
- Kendall Graveman remains winless in his last five starts, with his last win coming on April 20 at New York-AL...is 1-1 with a 3.14 ERA (6 er in 17.2 ip) in three career starts against the Yankees.
- Khris Davis (0-for-3, 2 so) is 15-for-60 (.250) with nine home runs and 20 RBI over his last 15 games, including four homers in the last three games.
- Josh Reddick (2-for-3, r, rbi, hr, sb) has hit in five straight and is 22-for-47 (.468) with six multiple hit games over his last 14 games...is hitting .414 (24-for-58) in 17 games in May.
- Marcus Semien (0-for-3, 2 so) had his four-game hitting streak snapped...is 13-for-46 (.283) with four home runs and nine RBI over his last 14 games after going 8-for-55 (.145) with two homers and six RBI over his previous 17 contests.
- Danny Valencia (1-for-4, 2 so) has hit safely in three straight games...is 16-for-37 (.432) with nine runs, six home runs and 12 RBI in 10 games since his return from the disabled list on May 6.

- The **New York Yankees** are 9-5 in their last 14 games and 2-2 on this seven-game road trip to Arizona (1-2) and Oakland (1-0)...are 1-3 this season against the A's this season after being swept at New York in April.
- Ivan Nova is 2-0 with a 1.68 ERA (3 er in 16.1 ip) in three starts this season after making his first six appearances out of the bullpen...is now 2-0 with a 3.52 ERA (9 er in 23.0 ip) in five career appearances (four starts) against the A's.
- Chase Headley (2-for-4, 2b, so) has reached base safely in each of his last 10 games...is 5-for-15 with an RBI on this road trip.
- Brett Gardner (2-for-3, 2 r, 2 bb) has reached base 27 times in 16 games in May.
