WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers beat the A's last night, 7-5, and team is 4-2 to on this 10-game, 10-day trip to Seattle (2-1), Oakland (2-1), and St. Louis (3 G)...Texas is 5-3 in last 8 G after having lost just 2 times in previous 13 G...have won 2 straight, 4 of 5, 10 of 13, 14 of 18, 16 of 21, and 26 of 37...have gone 30-15 since 4/26, tied w/ Giants (31-15, .674) for most wins and best win pct. in MLB in that span...**Texas has the best record in the A.L. at 41-25 (.615)**, T2nd-best record in the majors (also WAS) to only CHC (.688, 44-20)...**current record is best 66-game start in club history** (see chart)...club is **season-high 16 games** above .500 for the 1st time since the end of 2013 season (19-over at 91-72)...this year is just 2nd time team has reached 16-over by June 15 in a season, having previously gotten there as early on 6/10/96 (39-23)...team was 36-30 after 66 G in 2015...**since 5/1/15, Rangers have best record and most wins in A.L. (122-85, .589), 2nd-best in MLB** in both categories to only the Cubs (129-77, .626).

WITH A WIN TODAY, Texas could:

- Climb to a season-high 17 games above .500 for the 1st time since the end of the 2013 season, which would be earliest date ever for Texas to reach 17-over (currently June 22 in both 1996 and 2012).
- Match a club record (3rd time) by winning an 8th consecutive series (see chart).
- Move to 7-2-1 in series in '16 when losing series opener.

STANDINGS: The Rangers have a season-best 6.5-game lead in the A.L. West, largest lead in the division for Texas since 5/19/13 (+6.5 GA)...largest lead in 2013 was 7.0 games (last on 5/16/13), and have not led by 7.5 games since winning the division by 10.0 games in 2012...in fact, have not led by at least 7.5 games before the All-Star break in club history...have gained ground in the division on 10 of last 14 days...current 6.5-G lead is largest in A.L., and 2nd-largest in MLB to the Cubs (+9.5 GA in N.L. Central)...have been in sole possession of 1st place for 13 straight and 17 of the last 18 days...from 5/3-28, Texas spent 24 of 26 days in 2nd place...team has had at least a share of 1st place for 40 days in '16, including sole possession of 1st for 31 different days.

SERIES STUFF: The Rangers have won 7 straight series for just 7th time in club history (see chart)...team has won 10 of its last 11 series overall (only loss was 0-3 from 5/16-18 at OAK) and is 15-4-1 in 2016...have won 3 straight and 4 of last 5 road series, going 5-3-1 in away series overall in 2016.

ON THE ROAD: This 10-game road trip for Texas matches longest of the year (also 10 G, 6/27-7/6 and 9/5-14)...Texas is 17-15 (.531) away from home, 4th-highest among A.L. clubs in road winning percentage...club has won 4 of 5, 9 of 12, and 12 of 18 after a 5-9 start to season in away tilts...of team's 15 road defeats in '16, 9 have been one or 2-run losses, and club has lost MLB-high 7 times on walkoffs.

VS. OAKLAND / WEST: Rangers are 2-4 vs. A's in '16, winning 2 straight, 6 of 10 and 7 of 12 dating to 2015...Rangers have gone 15-10 at Coliseum since start of '14, 20-14 since start of '13.

- Rangers are 25-13 (.658) vs. the West in '16, 2nd-best in-tradivision record in ML to only CHC (.750, 18-6)...have won 12 of 15 and 15 of last 19 vs. West.

BIG COMEBACK: Last night's win was Rangers' 20th come-from-behind win in 2016, tied with BAL for most in MLB...it 5-run deficit matched largest in any Texas win this year (also 5/10 vs. CWS), and was **the largest road comeback win in nearly 8 years**, since another victory in Oakland on 7/25/08 (club trailed 5-0 in 4th, won 14-6)...credit STATS LLC.

THE LONG BALL: Texas hit 4 HR last night, 3rd game with 4+ HR in '16...club has hit 3+ HR in 3 straight for the 1st time since May 10-12, 2013 (all at HOU), and club record is 4 in a row done 3 times (last Aug. 4-7, 2005)...4 of the Rangers' 7 games with 3+ HR this season have come on this road trip, and 4 of the 7 in 2016 have come at the Coliseum.

- Texas has hit 17 HR over the 1st 6 games of this road trip, most in a 6-G span for club since Aug. 2-7, 2005 (17) - all home games...last time to have such a streak over 6 straight, all on the road, was July 3-8, 2004 at HOU and CLE.
- Have 27 HR in June, 2nd in MLB (BAL-33), and team ranks T2nd in majors in HR since 5/7 with 58 (BAL-66, SEA-58)...club's 82 HR for the season are now 5th in the A.L.

UNPRECEDENTED POWER AT COLISEUM: According to baseball-reference.com, the Rangers are the only visitor to ever hit 3+ HR in 3 straight games at the Coliseum in a season (or one series)...Baltimore did it in 3 in a row spanning the 1985-86 seasons, only other visitor to pull the trick...A's have done it 3 times in park history, last in 2006 (5/30-6/1).

WITH LOVE FROM VENEZUELA: All 4 Texas HR last night were hit by Robinson Chirinos and Rougned Odor (both w/ 2 HR)...**according to Elias Sports Bureau, it was the 1st time 2 Venezuelan-born players had ever hit multiple HR in a single MLB game** (whether teammates or not)...it was the 15th game in club history in which 2 players hit multiple HR, 1st since the club's record-setting 30-3 win on Aug. 22, 2007 at BAL (G1)...Ramon Vazquez and Jarrod Saltalamacchia both hit 2 HR in that game...it was the 1st instance at the Coliseum since Oakland's John Jaha (2) and Randy Velarde (2) pulled the trick on 8/24/99 vs. CLE, and just the 3rd time 2 visiting teammates have done it...the others: TOR's Carlos Delgado and John Olerud on 4/11/94 and MIN's Kirby Puckett and Bernardo Brito on 8/15/93.

- It was Odor's 1st career multi-HR game, 2nd for Chirinos (also 8/5/14 at CWS)...Chirinos' effort was 1st multi-HR game from 9-hole for TEX since Leonys Martin, 2 on 6/25/13 vs. NYY.

ODOR IN LEAD: Rougned Odor has a team-high 12 HR after his 1st career multi-HR effort last night...his 24 HR since the 2015 All-Star break also lead all Rangers, 3 more than Beltre.

HARD SUN: Texas has an 11-7 record in day games entering today's tilt, winning 6 straight and 10 of 11 after opening with a 1-6 mark...club is 4-3 in away day contests, winning 4 of 5...the 11-7 (.611) record is best in the A.L.

CAPTAIN'S ORDERS: Adrian Beltre has missed 7 consecutive games since leaving contest last Wed. vs. HOU due to a mild left hamstring strain, but could play today...the 7 straight games missed marks longest such span in his Rangers career without a disabled list stint...previous longest span was 3 straight from April 21-23, 2012 (left hamstring strain)...he also did not start 5 in a row, May 1-6, 2012, with that hamstring injury, but pinch hit 4 times...had played 151 consecutive games before his current injury.

MEET ME IN ST. LOUIS: Texas is scheduled for a 3-game weekend series in St. Louis...marks 1st meetings between the clubs since Rangers won all 3 games at Busch from June 21-23, 2013, which was the only other time for Texas to play regular season games in St. Louis.

- Texas is 2-1 in Interleague this season, taking last 2 of 3 vs. PIT, 5/27-29...club has won 8 of its last 11 meetings vs. N.L. clubs dating to 2015...Rangers were 6-4 in N.L. parks in 2015, winning 4 of last 5.

TEAM PITCHING: A's are batting .324 (35-108) with 25 R-22 ER in 1st 3 games of this series to raise Texas season ERA from 3.87 to 4.03, 7th in A.L... allowed season highs in hits (17) and runs/ER (14 R/12 ER) Mon. at OAK...also have 3.66 ERA (92 ER/226.0 IP) last 25 G beg. 5/20 to drop season figure from 4.26...staff's 82 HR are 4th-most in A.L...no BB Tues. at OAK for 4th time in '16, but 210 BB in '16 are T4th-most in A.L...have fewest strikeouts in MLB w/ 449...have induced MLB-high 77 GDP's...lone SHO: 4/12 at SEA...staff's 3.83 away ERA is 4th-lowest in A.L. (TOR-3.19; CLE-3.55).

STARTERS: Starters have 7.0+ IP in 3 of last 5 G...have 17 R/14 ER allowed in 14.1 IP in this series to raise season rotation ERA from 3.38 to **3.58, still lowest in the A.L.** and 6th in MLB, but highest since 5/18 (3.61)...rotation has a 3.33 ERA (72 ER/187.2 IP) in last 31 G since 5/13 to drop from 3.69... quality starts in just 3 of last 8, but 43 QS are 2nd in A.L. and 4th in MLB (CHC-45; TOR/WAS-44), also most in club history thru 1st 66 G of a season...rank among A.L. leaders in win pct. (1st, .700, 28-12), wins (T2nd, 28), opp. avg. (2nd, .244)...starters are 15-5 last 26 G after going 1-4 in 1st 17 G in May... rotation has won 11 of last 13 decisions, and 8-G win streak from 5/28-6/9 was longest single-season run since opening 2012 at 10-0.

RELIEVERS: Bullpen had 5.1 SHO IP last night, most scoreless innings in a 9-inning win since 4/17/14 vs. SEA (6.2) and most in a 9-inn. road win since 6/10/12 at SF (6.0), across the bay...have allowed 11 R-ER in 13.2 IP last 4 G to rise from 4.73 to A.L.-high 4.90, 2nd-highest in ML (CIN-6.25)...bullpen has allowed runs in 8 of 10, 9 of 12, and 12 of 16...still have a 3.93 ERA (33 ER/75.2 IP) in last 25 contests to drop season mark from 5.47...relievers have worked 3+ innings in 17 of last 21 G...bullpen's 13 losses are T2nd-most in A.L. (TOR-16, MIN-13)...Texas is tied for A.L. lead with 24 saves (also BAL-24) and lead MLB w/ 49 holds...2nd-most relief HR allowed (32) in A.L. (MIN-35)...have converted 24 of 31 save chances, including 11-for-last-11 since blown save on 5/17 at OAK.

43 TONY BARNETTE 3-2-0, 3.81 vs. LHB: 18-for-48 (.375) vs. RHB: 16-for-58 (.276)
 • Has allowed 6 R-ER in 4.2 IP last 5 G, opponents batting .478 (11-23) in that span, to rise from 2.11 to 3.81, highest since 4/23 (4.15)...has allowed runs in 7 of 26 outings in 2016, including 3 straight and 4 of last 5 appearances.
 • Is T5th in A.L. in relief wins (3), all in May to match Lewis in team high for wins in the month...has allowed 3 of 19 IR (15.8%) to score, entering w/ bases loaded 3x...has entered in 7th-or-later in 21 of 26 G...issued walk-off 1B to R. Martin in 9th 5/4 at TOR for 2nd loss...earned his 1st ML win on 5/2 at TOR.
 • Barnette was 32 years, 148 days old for his ML debut, 2nd-oldest in Rangers history (RHP Yoshinori Tateyama - 35.149 on 5/24/11 vs. CWS).

 • Has 2.0 perfect innings past 2 G...has 17 K's and just 3 BB in 1st 16 ML outings...**opponents 1-for-18 w/ 8 K last 6 G**, just .207 (12-58) w/ 2 XBH (both 2B) for season...posted 2nd win Sat. at SEA, escaping bases-loaded jam in 10th...career-high 3 K's last Thurs. vs. HOU, 3rd TEX reliever with a 3-SO inning in '16...has allowed 2 R last 11 G/9.2 IP after 5.2 scoreless IP over 1st 5 appearances.
 • Had K's in each of 1st 5 ML outings, 1st Ranger reliever to do that since Yoshinori Tateyama (1st 5 in 2011) and Neftali Feliz (1st 5 in 2009).

 • Has also made 3 appearances w/ Round Rock (AAA) in '16, posting 5.2 scoreless innings, incl. 3.2 SHO frames over 2 games this month after being optioned on 6/3 when Shawn Tolleson was activated...last appearance at AAA was on Thursday at Iowa (1.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 SO, 22 pitches).
 • Career-high 4.1 IP on 5/10 vs. CWS, allowing just one run, to record 2nd ML win...longest relief outing by a Ranger to record a win since Dustin Nippert, 9/14/10 vs. DET (also 4.1 IP).

 • 1st career save last Thurs. vs. HOU...also earned win 6/7 vs. HOU, 1st win w/ TEX and 1st since 6/22/15 at NYY with Philly.
 • Has 17 holds, 2nd in A.L...ranks among A.L. relief leaders in opp. avg. (3rd, .148), games (T7th, 31), WHIP (7th, 0.82)...holds in 7 straight outings, 5/11-28, T2nd-longest span in team history (Cris Carpenter-9 in 1993; Mike Venafro-7 in 1999).
 • Did not issue an earned run with just 1 BB in 1st 11 outings (8.1 IP) in 2016 until season-high 3 ER on 5/1 vs. LAA.

 • Has allowed runs in 6 of last 11 G (14 R-13 ER/10.1 IP), opponents at .356/.423/.756/1.179 in that span w/ 5 HR, 6 BB/12 SO to raise season figure from 5.40 to 8.41...permitted walk-off grand slam to K. Davis on 5/17 at OAK...converted just 2 saves in 5 chances over 6 appearances from 5/3-17...still has team-high 11 saves...has 4 blown saves, T2nd in A.L., 11-for-15 in save tries...1st Ranger w/ back-to-back 10-save seasons since Joe Nathan in 2012-13.
