#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have won consecutive games and are 4-2 in their last six games...have won consecutive home games to snap a four-game home losing streak and improve to 19-26 (.422) at home...have played five consecutive one-run games for the first time this year and are now 12-15 (.444) in one-run games...improved to 15-21 (.417) in day games...lead the season series against the Blue Jays 3-2 and are 32-38 against Toronto dating back to 2008 (215-189 all-time)...are 2-0 on this current 10-game homestand against Toronto (2-0), Houston (three games), and Tampa Bay (four games).
- The **A's** have made six errors in the past three games to snap an Athletics franchise record streak of 15 consecutive games without an error...have hit six home runs in the past two games after hitting five over their previous nine games.
- Sonny Gray** earned his first win since April 22 at Toronto...snapped a seven-game losing streak, which was a career high (previous: 4, Aug. 1-16, 2014)...also snapped a streak of 12 consecutive starts without a win, the second longest streak by an A's starter this century (13, Braden, April 29-Sept. 29, 2007; 12, Bassitt, Aug. 9, 2015-April 28, 2016)...it was the longest losing streak by an A's pitcher since Tyson Ross had an eight-game losing streak from May 19-Sept. 24, 2012...is 1-3 with a 4.07 ERA (22 er in 48.2 ip) in eight starts since his return from the DL June 5...is 1-7 with a 6.01 ERA (47 er in 70.1 ip) over his last 13 starts.
- Khris Davis** (2-for-4, 2 r, 2 hr, 2 rbi, 2 so) recorded his ninth career multi-homer game and his third this season...it was his first since he hit three in one game on May 17 vs. Texas...is 8-for-19 (.421) with four home runs and seven RBI in five games against Toronto this year and 11-for-24 (.458) in his career.
- Ryon Healy** (2-for-3, r, hr, 3 rbi) earned his first Major League hit with a three-run home run in the second inning...earned his first career multi-hit game.
- Stephen Vogt** (1-for-3, r, bb) has hit safely four consecutive games (9-for-15, .600)...is batting .357 (20-for-56) over his last 16 games.

#### TORONTO NOTES

- The **Toronto Blue Jays** have lost three of their last four games, however are 8-3 in their last 11...fell to 24-22 (.522) on the road...dropped to 8-4 (.667) in July...fell to 9-17 (.346) in one-run games...trail the A's in the season series 3-2 and are 95-107 all-time in Oakland...have scored 193 runs in 30 games since June 11 (6.43 runs per game)...are 0-2 on this five-game road trip to Oakland (0-2) and Arizona (0-2) (two games).
- R.A. Dickey** is 3-2 with a 4.18 ERA (15 er in 32.1 ip) over his last five starts...is 4-6 with a 4.38 ERA (49 er in 100.2 ip) in 19 appearances, including 15 starts, against Oakland...is 1-4 with a 3.33 ERA (19 er in 51.1 ip) in nine games, including seven starts, at the Coliseum...allowed at least three home runs in a game for the 11th time in his career and third time this season, the first since allowing four home runs on June 25 at Chicago-AL (also: 3, May 18 vs. Tampa Bay).
- Josh Donaldson** (0-for-3, bb) has reached base safely in 21 straight games and is batting .388 (31-for-80) with 18 walks over that stretch.
- Edwin Encarnacion** (2-for-4, r, hr, rbi) is batting .414 (12-for-29) over his last 19 games.
- Kevin Pillar** (0-for-4) had his eight-game hitting streak snapped...was batting .414 (12-for-29) over that stretch.
- Josh Thole** (2-for-3, 2b, 2 rbi) snapped a streak of 77 at-bats without an extra base hit with a double in the second inning.
- Troy Tulowitzki** (1-for-4, r, 2b) is batting .321 (27-for-84) with seven home runs and 21 RBI over his last 20 games.
