OAKLAND NOTES

- **Jed Lowrie** has a 72-game errorless streak as a second baseman... it is the third-longest such streak in Oakland history.
- After committing at least one error in 11 consecutive games, the Athletics have now been error-free in five straight games...the last time the A's went five games or more without committing an error was 7/21-7/27/2016 when they had a seven-game streak.
- The Athletics snapped a five-game win streak.
- **Ryon Healy** singled in the fourth inning and doubled in the seventh inning and is now batting .524 (11-for-21) over his last seven games after going 6-for-40 (.150) over his previous 10 contests.
- **Adam Rosales** snapped his hitting streak of five games.
- **Andrew Triggs** recorded his first loss of the season after going 3-0 and not allowing an earned in each of his previous contests...he gave up five hits, six runs, one home run and registered two walks and a hit by pitch.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Mariners snapped a six-game losing streak on the road, avoiding the sweep, and are now 2-9 away from Safeco this season.
- Seattle recorded the most runs in a game this season (11) and saw its largest win margin (10 runs) of the year.
- With a home run in the seventh inning, **Nelson Cruz** extended his hitting streak against the Athletics to 12 games, dating back to 8/13/2016...he is batting .400 (18-for-45) during that stretch.
- **Cruz** recorded five RBI, a season high...the last time he recorded five RBI was 5/17/2016.
- **Mitch Haniger** recorded a single in the third inning, extending his on base streak to 24 games, which dates back to 9/29/2016...had three hits for his sixth multi-hit game of the season which is a team high.
- **Jarrod Dyson** has reached safely in 17-of-his-last-18 games.
- **Mike Freeman** is on an 0-for-14 hitless streak.
- **Taylor Motter** registered the first grand slam of his career in the third inning to give the Mariners a 6-0 lead...the home run marks his fifth of this season and it is a career high for RBI (four)...he now has four multi-RBI games on the season.
- **Yovani Gallardo** earned his first win as a Mariner, giving up four hits, one run, one walk and throwing seven strike outs...he recorded his longest outing of the season, pitching 6.1 innings...the last time he threw six or more innings was 7/25/16 versus Colorado (6.2 innings pitched).
- **Daniel Vogelbach** recorded his first Major League RBI with a single in the ninth inning.
