#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The A's recorded a season-low tying two hits...also had two on 5/17 at SEA.
- In his first career game against Atlanta, **Jed Lowrie** extended his hitting streak to five games with a double in the ninth...with the double, he tied the Oakland record for doubles before the All-Star Break (26, Joe Rudi in 1974 and Bobby Crosby in 2008)...he is now one shy of 200 career doubles.
- **Lowrie** is 12-for-31 (.387) with eight doubles, one home run and eight RBI in eight interleague games.
- **Matt Olson** hit a home run in the ninth inning to break up the no-hitter and extend the A's streak of consecutive games without being no-hit to 4,139...that is the longest active streak in the majors and it is fourth longest in American League history.
- Oakland has not been no-hit since July 13, 1991 when Bob Milacki, Mike Flanagan, Mark Williamson and Gregg Olson combined to no-hit the A's for Baltimore.
- **Sonny Gray** gave up a season-low two hits and tied his season-low in runs allowed, giving up just one in seven innings.

#### ATLANTA NOTES

- **Dansby Swanson** snapped an 0-for-12 hitless streak with a double in the third inning...entered the contest ranked second among NL rookies with 61 hits...including tonight, he now has 62 hits.
- With a double in the third inning, **Johan Camargo** extended his hitting streak to six games, a season high streak (previous was five games on three occasions).
- In his 18 starts (15 at third base), rookie **Camargo** has batted .308 (20-for-65) with nine runs scored and 11 RBI.
- **Ender Inciarte** snapped an 11-game hitting streak that dated back to 6/18.
- **Mike Foltynewicz** became the first Braves starter to win a game at Oakland Coliseum since 6/12/03, when RHP Shane Reynolds beat the A's 4-2.
- In a career-high tying eight innings of work, Foltynewicz fanned eight, allowed four walks and gave up just one hit, a home run, and one run.
