OAKLAND NOTES

- **Bob Melvin** recorded his 1,000 career victory, becoming the 64th manager in MLB history with 1,000 career wins.
- Chris Smith (5 ip, 7 h, 4 r, 4 er, 3 bb, 4 k, 1 hr) turned in his shortest outing of the season...he had thrown at least six innings in his previous three starts.
- Rajai Davis (4-5, 2r, hr, 2 rbi) recorded his first walk-off hit of the season with a two-run homer in the ninth inning...it was his ninth career game ending RBI and second career walkoff homer (6/30/2014 vs. OAK)...matched a season-high with a four-hit game (last: 6/7 vs TOR).
- Matt Chapman (1-4, hr, rbi, so) notched his sixth homer of the season in the eighth...all of his homers have been solo homers.
- With a double in the first inning, **Ryon Healy** (2-4, 2 2b) recorded his first extra-base hit since July 8 at Seattle...first multi extra-base hit game since June 17 vs New York.
- Jed Lowrie (1-3, bb) snapped an 0-for-14 hitless streak with a single in the bottom of the third inning.
- The A's challenged a play at first base in the second inning...
 the ruling on the field was confirmed, and the runner was
 declared safe...the approximate time of review was 1 minute
 and 30 seconds.
- Chad Pinder went 1 for 3 in his rehab start with the Nashville Sounds tonight...in his eight games with the Sounds, he is 5-for-27 with a homer and one RBI.

- Adalberto Mejía (5 ip, 8 h, 2 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 2 so) took the no-decision...in his six road starts, he owns a 2.54 ERA while posting a 4.91 ERA at home.
- Miguel Sanó (1-5, hr, 2 rbi, 3 so) clubbed his first homer on the road since July 1 at Kansas City...with his 24th homer of the season, the infielder is one homer shy of his career high 25, which he set in last season.
- With two hits on the night, **Eduardo Escobar** (2-5, r) is batting .338 (22-for-65) in his career against the A's.
- Zack Granite (2-4, 2 rbi) extended his hiting streak to nine games, the longest of his major league career...he is batting .412 (14-for-34) during the streak.
- The Twins challenged a play at second base in the six inning...the ruling on the field was confirmed, and the runner was declared out...the approximate time of review was 1 minute and 44 seconds.
