OAKLAND NOTES

- **Matt Olson** tallied his first career game-ending RBI with a single in the bottom of the 14th inning.
- **Jed Lowrie** notched his team-leading sixth homer of the season in the bottom of the eighth inning...with the homer, he recorded his 20th and 21st RBI of the season, which are the most RBI by him in any month as an Athletic.
- **Mark Canha** hit his second homer of the season, and has hit safely in four of his last six games.
- **Stephen Piscotty** extended his hitting streak to eight games...he is batting .419 (13-for-31) during that span.
- With a single in the second inning, **Khris Davis** extended his hitting streak to eight games... he finished the day 3-for-7 and is 14-for-38 during the streak.
- **Andrew Triggs** got knocked around for six runs on five hits while going 1.1 innings on the mound...it was his shortest start since 9/2/16 vs. Boston (1ip, 1er).
- **Matt Joyce** walked two more times and got on base three of his four plate appearances...he entered the game with 14 walks and .403 on base percentage.
- **Lou Trivino** recorded the win...his first MLB win.
- At 5 hours and 48 minutes, marked the 3rd longest game by time in Oakland A's history.

CHICAGO NOTES

- **Yoán Moncada** clubbed his first career grand slam in the top of the second inning...his second homer of the series and third of the season.
- Moncada (22 yr, 326 days) is the fifth youngest player in White Sox history to hit a grand slam... the youngest player to hit a grand slam since Kevin Bell (20 yr, 345 days) on 6/22/76.
 - Johnny Callison (20 yr, 198 days) 9/26/59 @ DET
 - Kevin Bell (20 yr, 345 days) 6/22/76 @ KC
 - Carlos May (21 yr, 16 days) 6/2/69 @ BOS
 - Bibb Falk (22, 115 days) 5/22/21 vs WAS
 - **Yoán Moncada (22, 326 days) 4/18/18 @ OAK**
- Moncada matched a career-high with four RBI (last, 7/21/17 at Kansas City).
- **Carson Fulmer** went one inning, allowed four runs on five hits...it was his second shortest start of his career (0.1ip at Houston on 9/21/17).
- **José Abreu** added three hits and two RBI in the game... has recorded 24 RBI in 29 career games against Oakland.
- **Bruce Rondón** went a career-high 3.0 innings, his previous high was 2.0 ip.
- **James Shields** made his second career relief appearance, first since 6/19/10 at Florida.
- Chicago stole a season-high five bases...most stolen bases since 9/5/10 at Boston (6 sb's)... they entered the game tied for the American League lead with 13 (CLE).
