OAKLAND NOTES

- **Stephen Piscotty** extended his hitting streak to eight games, his longest since a season-high 11-game streak from 7/7/18 to 7/21/18.
- Oakland is now 50-21 since June 16, the best record in the majors over that span...At 84-57, the Athletics have the fourth-best record in the majors...The A's are 98-64 over their last 162 games.
- With six doubles, the A's need just two more extra-base hits to reach 500 for the 12th time in the team's history...The A's hit six or more doubles in a game for the fifth time in 2018, and the third time in their last 23 games.
- The A's are now 10-0-2 over their last 12 home series, matching the longest single-season home unbeaten streak in team history (4 times, last from 5/16/05 to 8/11/05).
- The A's are now 60-0 when leading after seven innings and are the only team in the majors that is undefeated when leading after seven.
- **Mike Fiers** improved to 4-0 with the A's...he has won each of his last five decisions, the longest winning streak of his career...Fiers has not taken a loss since 7/13/18 at Houston, while he was pitching for Detroit...In six starts with the A's, Fiers has an ERA of 2.94 and has allowed two runs or fewer in five of his six starts.
- The A's are 24-15 (.615) against the Yankees since the start of the 2013 season, the best mark by any American League team over that span.
- **Matt Chapman** hit his 35th double of the season...his 33 extra-base hits since the All-Star break lead the major leagues.

NEW YORK NOTES

- **Luis Severino** recorded his 200th strikeout of the season by fanning Stephen Piscotty in the first inning...he became just the third Yankees pitcher to record multiples seasons with 200 or more strikeouts, and the first since David Cone in 1997-98.
- Severino allowed five earned runs over just 2.2 innings, his shortest regular-season outing since 5/14/17 vs. Houston (54 starts)...Severino has allowed two earned runs or more in each of his last 11 starts, including three starts with five or more earned runs.
- The Yankees hit a home run in their seventh straight game...their 228 team homers lead the major leagues.
- The Yankees have now dropped six of their last seven games at the Oakland Coliseum.
