WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers bear the Angels last night, 4-2, and club enters tonight's finale with a 3-4 record on this 8-game, 9-day homestand vs. LAD (0-2), MIN (2-1), and LAA (1-1)...have won 3 of 4 since snapping a 5-G losing streak that was T2nd-longest by TEX in 2018...team has still dropped 6 of 9, 8 of 13, 9 of 15, 12 of 21, and 15 of last 27 G...TEX is 15-15 in last 30 G, and club's 19-16 (.543) record since 7/27 remains T6th-best in A.L. w/ HOU, T2nd-best among A.L. West clubs (OAK: .611, 22-14)...have lost 27 of 48 and 29 of last 51 G, the longer span beginning 7/6...team is 34-34 beg. 6/16...at 20-22 (.476) since the AS break, TEX owns 8th-best record in the A.L.

• At 61-78 (.439), Rangers are 11th in the A.L. in winning percentage...the 61 wins are fewest for Texas after 139 G since 2014 (53-86) and T6th-fewest at this point in Rangers history.

• Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...club's high point since the break is 14-under (6 times, last on 8/24)...team was season-high 20 G under .500 at 42-62 on 7/26...TEX won season-high 7 straight from 6/16-23, preceded by longest losing skid at 7 G, 6/7-15.

BURN RUBBER: The Rangers enter tonight with a 7-7 record in rubber games this season, including a 6-1 mark in Arlington...club has won 6 straight rubber games in Arlington since its only loss on 4/8 vs. TOR...Texas earned a series win over the weekend vs. MIN, ending an 0-3-0 stretch in series...club had gone 4-1-2 in 7 series from 7/27-8/19...Texas is 4-1-1 in last 6 series in Arlington.

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas was eliminated from A.L. West contention with Tuesday night's loss in game no. 138, earliest point to be out of division race since 2014 (game no. 135)...current 25.0-game deficit matches season high (2nd time, also 7/26)...team was between 20.0 and 23.0 GB for 30 straight days from 7/28-8/26...Rangers have lost 4.0 games in the standings in the past 11 days...current 25.0-G deficit is 4th-largest division margin in MLB to BAL (-54.5), TOR (33.0), and KC (-32.0)...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 148 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 158 of 159 days this season (T2nd following win on 3/30).

AT HOME: Texas is 32-42 (.432) in Arlington this season, 4th-lowest home win pct. in A.L...club secured a losing campaign at home with Friday's defeat...team has gone 12-8 at home since the beginning of August, this after going 1-9 in Arlington in July...Texas is 25-25 in last 50 G after opening year at 5-15...overall 32-42 record is T3rd-fewest wins in club history after 74 G at home (28-46 in 2014, 30-44 in 1972).

VS. THE HALOS: Texas is 5-7 vs. the Angels this season, but has won 5 of 8 after losing 1st 4 meetings in 2018...Rangers took last series, 3-games-to-1, from 8/16-19 in Arlington...Texas has dropped 9 of the last 15 overall beginning 9/15/17, but has a 26-24 advantage since the start of 2016...Rangers have won 4 of last 6 at home after dropping 4 of prior 6 meetings at GLPIA...Rangers have won season series in each of last 2 years...Angels hold the lead in the all-time series, 377-349, but Rangers have the advantage both in Arlington (192-177) and at Globe Life Park (110-105).

• TEX and LAA are playing 4 series in final 6 1/2 weeks, as 13 of Rangers' final 40 games (32.5%) are against the Halos...the teams will play a Mon./Tues./Wed. series in 3 of the 4 weeks in September...Texas will make 2 more trips to Anaheim this month, 9/10-12 and 9/24-26.

• Last night was Leclerc's 13 straight appearance of 3+ outs, zero runs allowed, and at least one strikeout, the longest such span in Rangers history (previous high was 11 G by Joakim Soria in 2014)...the last longer single-season streak in MLB was OAK/WSH's Ryan Madson (14 G, 7/4-8/10/17).

ELVIS PLAYS ARLINGTON: Elvis Andrus has homered twice on this homestand and all 6 of his homers this season have come at Globe Life Park...dating back to last season, Andrus has hit 11 of his last 13 home runs in Arlington...each of the other 2 homers were hit in a series at ATL, 9/4-6/17... BELTRÉ CLOSING IN ON WANER: Adrián Beltré has hit safely in each of the 1st 4 G of September, including a 2-hit effort last night...Beltré enters play tonight with 3147 career hits, 5 shy of matching Paul Waner for 16th place on the all-time list...Beltré has homered in 2 of his 1st 4 G this games this month, and now has 1137 career extra-base hits, 2 shy of matching Ty Cobb for 14th all-time.

• Last night Beltré hit his 46th career home run vs. the Angels, 3rd-most ever vs. the Angels (70-Alex Rodriguez; 49-Rafael Palmeiro).

EXTRA CREDIT FOR MAZ: Nomar Mazara matched a season high with 2 doubles last night, and now has 7 extra base hits in his last 5 G dating back to 8/31, most in MLB over that span...in that same stretch, Mazara's 9 RBI are tied with MIL's Christian Yelich for most in the majors.

TONIGHT: The 45-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 26th appearance and 24th start of the season tonight in the finale of this 3-G set with the Halos... will be 1st action since he was activated from the disabled list on Saturday...was placed on the disabled list on 8/24, retroactive to 8/21, with a lower back strain... took the loss in his last start on 8/20 at OAK, when he pitched on extra rest after enduring back issues during the club's homestand from 8/13-19...has gone 2-4, 8.04 (30 ER/33.2 IP) in last 6 starts to raise ERA from 4.64 to 5.45...this season, has set MLB marks for wins by a native of the Dominican Republic, followed by wins for a native of Latin America (see below)...ranks among A.L. leaders in BB/9 (2nd, 1.54) and pitches per inning (5th, 15.1)...has permitted 29 HR, 2nd-most in A.L. (BAL's Dylan Bundy-35)...has taken a decision in 14 straight starts beg. 6/1, longest streak in MLB this season...was selected Rangers March/April Player of the Month by broadcasters and writers that cover the team on a regular basis, this after going 1-0, 2.87 (10 ER/31.1 IP) in 6 G/4 GS in April...took perfect game bid into 8th inning on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball, 4/15 at HOU...has won games with 11 different teams, tied for most all-time (also LaTroy Hawkins, Edwin Jackson, Mike Morgan, Ron Villone)...Colon is the oldest MLB player since Omar Vizquel's final game on 10/3/12 (age 45.162)...joins teammate Adrián Beltré (21 seasons) as the only active MLB players to have appeared in 20+ seasons...Rangers are 10-13 in his 23 starts.

DISABLED LIST: Tonight will be 1st start since being activated from DL on Saturday...was placed on DL on 8/24, retroactive to 8/21, with a lower back strain... endured back issues during club's homestand from 8/13-19 and pitched on extra rest 8/20 at OAK.

NONE SHALL PASS: Colon has issued 2-or-fewer walks in all 23 of his starts this season, the longest single-season and overall streak by a Texas starter in team history (prev. 20-Rick Honeycutt in 1981, and 21-Honeycutt in 1981-82)...it is also the longest streak in MLB in 2018.

MAKING HISTORY: Earned career win no. 244 on 8/7 vs. SEA, becoming the winningest pitcher in ML history from Latin America (previously Nicaragua's Dennis Martinez-245)...Colon's win on 6/18 at KC (no. 244) made him all-time wins leader for a native of the Dominican Republic (formerly 243 by Hall of Famer Juan Marichal)... the Rangers honored Colon for the 2 milestones in a pre-game ceremony before game on 8/18 vs. LAA...Colon leads all active pitchers with 247 wins and 3455.2 IP (Sabathia is 2nd w/ 244 wins/3451.2 IP).

LAST START: Took the loss in Rangers' 9-0 defeat on 8/20 at Oakland (5.0 IP, 10 H, 7 R-ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 3 HR, 94 pitches/58 strikes)...pitched on extra rest after enduring back issues during the club's homestand from 8/13-19...Ramon Laureano hit 2 of 3 HRs allowed by Colon, the 1st 2 long balls of his career...A's went 5-for-8 w/ 5 XBH (4 2B, HR) and one BB 1st time thru order...Rangers recorded 3 total hits, just one off A's starter Mike Fiers (7.0 SHO IP).

VS. THE ANGELS: Pitched for Halos from 2005-07 and won 2005 Cy Young Award after leading A.L. with 21 wins...has gone 12-9 with a 3.88 ERA (72 ER/167.0 IP) in 27 G/26 GS career vs. the Angels, including 0-1, 10.50 (7 ER/6.0 IP) in 2 G/one GS this season...relief outing on 4/10 in Arlington (3.0 IP, 1 R-ER) was final appearance before joining rotation...loss in matchup with Jaime Barria on 6/1 in Anaheim (3.0 IP, 6 R-ER) was 1st road loss of 2018...winless in last 4 starts at 0-3, 12.15 (18 ER/13.1 IP), last win on 7/26/13 w/ Oakland at the Coliseum.

IN ARLINGTON: Has won 2 straight and 4 of last 6 starts at home...is 4-4 with a 5.64 ERA (43 ER/68.2 IP) in 13 G/11 GS at Globe Life Park in Arlington this season...opponents have similar home/road splits, batting .279/.314/.548/.862 in Arlington and .284/.308/.509/.817 on the road.
