The Mariners have hit 3 go-ahead home runs in the 7th inning and later this season, tied with Chicago-AL for 3rd-most in the Majors...trail Baltimore (4) and Toronto (4).

# 4

Kyle Seager has hit safely in 4 of his last 5 games (4/7-c), including 3 multi-hit games...during this span, Seager is batting .381 (8x21) with 4 runs, 2 doubles, 2 home runs and 8 RBI.

# 11

Dee Gordon has hit safely in the first 11 games of the season, batting .319 (15x47) with 7 runs scored, 1 double, 1 home run, 3 RBI, 1 HBP, 2 walks and 5 stolen bases.

# 64

The Mariners have hit 64 home runs against the Athletics over the past 3 seasons (2016-c), which is T5th-most by any team against a single opponent in that span (also: New York-AL vs. Baltimore)...trails only Chicago-NL vs. Cincinnati (77), Milwaukee vs. Cincinnati (69), New York-NL vs. Philadelphia (68) and New York-AL vs. Tampa Bay (66).

The Mariners and Athletics meet for the 2nd (1-0) of 19 games this season...Seattle has won the season series 5 years in a row, including going 12-7 vs. the A's in 2017...the Mariners have won 9 of their last 10 games vs. the Athletics:

**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners continue their second homestand of the season with the second (1-0) of 3 games vs. the Oakland Athletics...following this series, will face the Houston Astros for 4 games...the Mariners went 4-3 on a recently-completed 10-day, 7-game road trip to San Francisco (1-1), Minnesota (1-1) and Kansas City (2-1)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...Seattle has won 3 straight games and 4 of their last 5...team is 4-3 during the day and 3-1 at night...Seattle is 3-1 at Safeco Field and 4-3 on the road.

- **Best vs. the West - Marco Gonzales** has a 2.95 ERA (6 ER, 18.1 IP) in 5 career games (3 GS) vs. AL West teams.
- **Seeing Double - Robinson Canó** is tied for 2nd with Rogers Hornsby for most home runs by a second baseman in Major League history, trailing only Jeff Kent's 377 career home runs.
- **Left vs. Right** - the Mariners are 3-0 when facing a left-handed starter and 4-4 vs. right-handed starters.
- **Four Square** - Seattle is 6-1 when scoring 4 runs-or-more, but 1-3 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Series Record** - Seattle has won or tied each of its first 4 series (2-0-2) to begin the season for the 2nd time in club history, trailing only the 2001 team which began the season with 9 consecutive series without a loss.

**WINNING AND LOSING WITH THE HOME RUN**...six of the Mariners 11 games this season have been decided by a home run...a home run has been the game-winning hit in four of the Mariners seven wins: **Nelson Cruz** (3/29 vs. CLE), **Dee Gordon** (4/1 vs. CLE), **Kyle Seager** (4/11 at KC) and **Mitch Haniger** (4/13 vs. OAK)...in two of Seattle's four losses, a homer has been the decisive hit: Yonder Alonso-CLE (3/31) and Mitch Garver-MIN (4/5).

**OFFENSIVE DISPLAY**...this series features two of the top-6 batting clubs in the Major Leagues...Oakland ranks 4th in the Majors with a .263 (127x483) average, while Seattle is 6th with a .258 (94x364) average...Los Angeles-AL (.294/165x562) leads the way, followed by Pittsburgh (.272/123x453), Boston (.264/122x462), Oakland, Atlanta (.261/120x460) and Seattle...the Mariners and Athletics are also neck-and-neck in runs-per-game...Seattle is averaging 4.64 runs-per-game (51 R, 11 G), tied with Minnesota for 5th-best in the AL, while the Athletics are posting 4.57 runs-per-game (64 R, 14 G), 7th-best in the AL.

**HAMMERIN' HANIGER**...Mitch Haniger is off to another fast start this season...he has hit safely in 8-of-11 games...he has driven in at least 2 runs on 4 occasions this season, most recently matching his career-high with 4 RBI last night (4x, last: 8/19/17 at TB)...his 4 games with 2+ RBI are T4th-most in the Majors (also: Shohei Ohtani-LAA and Yadier Molina-STL), trailing Hanley Ramirez-BOS (5), Gregory Polanco-PIT (5) and Bryce Harper-WAS (5)...among American League leaders, Haniger ranks T1st in game-winning RBI (3), T2nd in RBI (12), 7th in on-base percentage (.426), 8th in OPS (.993) and 9th in slugging percentage (.568)...in April of 2017, he hit .342 (27x79) with 20 runs, 7 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 16 RBI, 13 walks, a .447 on-base percentage and a .608 slugging mark.

**DIABOLICAL DÍAZ**...Edwin Díaz has retired 18 of 22 batters faced over 6.0 innings this season, including striking out 13 of those 22 batters...he has allowed only 1 walk and hit 2 batsmen while 1 batter has reached on a team fielding error...he is the only pitcher in the Major Leagues to have faced at least 20 batters without allowing a base hit...Díaz has successfully converted 5-of-5 save opportunities, tied Toronto's Roberto Osuna for the American League lead...his 13 strikeouts rank T3rd-most among AL relievers (also: Chad Green-NYY and Noe Ramirez-LAA)...Díaz's 19.50 strikeout-per-9.0-innings ratio is 2nd-best among all relievers (Josh Hader-MIL, 19.96/17 K, 7.2 IP).

**GREEN AND GOLD**...since 2015, the Mariners are 38-20 (.655) in 58 games vs. the Athletics, including winning 9 of their last 10 games vs. Oakland (7/9/17-c)...Seattle's .655 winning percentage vs. the Athletics is the best record by an American League team against a division opponent during this span: Seattle vs. Oakland (38-20/.655), Houston vs. Seattle (37-20/.649), Cleveland vs. Detroit (38-21/.644), New York-AL vs. Tampa Bay (37-22/.627) and Los Angeles-AL vs. Oakland (40-24/.625).

**DON'T YOU KNOW**...Robinson Canó has reached base safely in all 11 games this season, including 10 games with at least 1 hit...it matches the longest streak of his career to reach base safely via a hit, walk or HBP to start a season (also: 2017)...overall, he is batting .424 (14x33) with 12 runs scored, 4 doubles, 4 RBI, 2 HBP and 10 walks...among American League leaders, he ranks 1st in batting, on-base percentage and OPS and T6th in RBI and walks.

**STREAKING**...dating back to Sept. 26, 2017, **Dee Gordon** has hit safely in 17 consecutive games, batting .342 (25x73) with 14 runs scored, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 3 RBI, 1 HBP, 2 walks and 9 stolen bases...his 17-game hitting streak combined over the last 2 seasons matches his career-high 17-game hitting streak, Aug. 27-Sept. 14, 2017...also dating back to Aug. 27, 2017, Gordon has hit safely in 40 of 44 games, including 21 multi-hit contests, batting .356 (68x191) with 33 runs scored, 4 doubles, 4 triples, 2 home runs, 11 RBI, 1 HBP, 4 walks and 19 stolen bases...during this stretch, Dee's .356 average ranks 4th in the Majors (min. 75 PA), trailing only Josh Reddick-HOU (.364/39x107), Jose Martinez-STL (.362/50x138) and Asdrubal Cabrera-NYM (.359/55x153).

**MILESTONE TRACKER**...Kyle Seager is in his 8th season with Seattle after making his debut with the Mariners in 2011 and is quickly ascending the all-time offensive rankings in club history:

- **Seager** (216) is tied with Raúl Ibañez (216) for 5th-most doubles in franchise history.
- **Seager** (535) is tied with Bret Boone (535) for 8th-most RBI in franchise history.
- **Seager** (155) trails Raúl Ibañez (156) by 1 home run for 6th-most in club history.
- **Seager** (363) trails Raúl Ibañez (367) by 4 walks for 8th-most in club history.

**DID YOU KNOW?**...that the Mariners 1-4 hitters lead all Major League clubs in combined batting average and OPS?...Seattle's 1-4 hitters are batting .323 (54x167) while posting an .891 OPS (.412 OBP, .479 SLG)...among club's cumulative batting average by their 1-4 hitters, the Mariners rank ahead of Colorado (.288/67x233), Oakland (.281/63x224), Boston (.281/61x217) and Los Angeles-AL (.280/72x257)...Seattle also ranks ahead of New York-AL (.886), Toronto (.881), Colorado (.877) and Minnesota (.851) in combined OPS among team's 1-4 batters...STATS LLC.

**ABOUT GONZALES...**

- 25-year-old left-hander is making his 13th Mariners appearance, 10th start, 3rd start of season...tonight is his 25th career appearance, 17th career start and his 1st career start vs. Oakland.
- Acquired by Seattle from St. Louis in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill on July 21, 2017.
- Native of Fort Collins, CO...attended Gonzaga University for 3 seasons (2011-13).
- Originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program.
- Made his MLB debut with Cardinals June 25, 2014 at Colorado.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (3 ER, 6.0 IP) with 4 strikeouts and 2 walks with St. Louis in the 2014 postseason...earned 2 wins in the NLDS vs. Los Angeles, becoming the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002).

**LAST OUTING**...took his first loss of the season on April 9 in a 0-10 Mariners loss at Kansas City...allowed 4 runs on 8 hits and 1 walk while striking out 4 in 2.1 innings pitched...faced 9 batters in the 1st inning, giving up 3 runs on 5 hits and 1 walk...after a scoreless 2nd inning, allowed consecutive base hits and recorded a strikeout before being lifted.

**SPRING TRAINING RECAP**...in 7 Cactus League starts, compiled a record of 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA (6 ER, 26.0 IP) with 21 strikeouts and 9 walks...threw 4.2 innings in his final spring start on 3/27 at COL, allowing 2 runs on 7 hits while walking 2 and striking out 3.

**SPRING BREAKOUT**...compiled a 2.08 ERA, the seventh best mark in the Majors (4th among AL pitchers) this spring...he trailed only Clayton Kershaw-LAD (0.00 ERA, 0 ER, 21.1 IP), Lance McCullers Jr.-HOU (1.29 ERA, 3 ER, 21.0 IP), Noah Syndergaard-NYM (1.35 ERA, 3 ER, 20.0 IP), Julio Teheran-ATL (1.40 ERA, 4 ER, 25.2 IP), José Berríos-MIN (1.42 ERA, 3 ER, 19.0 IP) and Justin Verlander-HOU (1.64, 4 ER, 22.0 IP)...led Mariners starters in Spring Training innings pitched (26.0), strikeouts (21) and WHIP (1.19).

**2017 SEASON RECAP**...went 1-1 with a 6.08 ERA (27 ER, 40.0 IP) with 32 strikeouts and 11 walks in 11 games (8 starts)...was acquired from STL on 7/21/17 in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill...posted a 5.40 ERA (22 ER, 36.2 IP) with 30 strikeouts and 11 walks in 10 games (7 starts) with Seattle.

**AAA RECAP**...combined for 13 AAA starts last season, 11 with AAA Memphis in the Cardinals organization and 2 with AAA Tacoma after being acquired by the Mariners...was 8-4 with a 3.14 ERA (28 ER, 80.1 IP) with 66 strikeouts and 22 walks in 13 combined starts...went 6-4 with a 2.90 ERA (22 ER, 68.1 IP) with 57 strikeouts and 17 walks in 11 starts with Memphis...was 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA (6 ER, 12.0 IP) with 9 strikeouts and 5 walks in 2 starts with Tacoma.

**BULLDOG ROOTS**...played 3 seasons (2011-13) with the Gonzaga Bulldogs, compiling a career record of 26-7 with a 2.34 ERA while recording 9 complete games and 4 shutouts...tallied 278 strikeouts over 303.2 innings of work...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program when he was selected 19th overall by St. Louis in 2013...shared West Coast Conference Player of the Year honors with the Cubs' Kris Bryant (University of San Diego) as a freshman in 2011 and as a junior in 2013...in 2013, earned John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year honors as well as WCC Co-Player of the Year for the 2nd time in his career.

**POSTSEASON GLORY**...added to the Cardinals roster for the 2014 National League Division Series vs. Los Angeles-NL...made 3 appearances in the NLDS, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk...picked up the wins in Game 1 and Game 4 vs. the Dodgers...became the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002)...in the 2014 NLCS vs. San Francisco, went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (3 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk in 3 appearances.

**ML CAREER**...in parts of 4 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c), is 6-4 with a 5.65 ERA (54 ER, 86.0 IP) with 70 strikeouts and 34 walks in 24 games (16 starts)...originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University.
