**WINS AND LOSSES:** The Rangers lost last game on Sunday at LAA, 3-1, and finished with a 3-4 record on the 7-G road trip to Seattle (2-2) and Anaheim (1-2)...club has lost 3 of 4 and 5 of last 8, but have gone 3-3 in last 6 G and 5-5 in last 10 G, winning 7 of last 13 contests...team's 7-6 (.538) record since 5/22 ties LAA for 2nd-best in A.L. West in that span (SEA is 10-3)...have gone 9-13 since 5/12.

• At 25-37 (.403), the Rangers have the 4th-lowest winning percentage in the A.L. and 6th-lowest in MLB (ahead of BAL, CWS, MIA, CIN, KC)...the 25 wins are the team's fewest through 62 games since 2007 (23-39/23-40), T7th fewest ever, and 2nd-fewest through 62 games in last 16 seasons (beginning 2003).

• Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...club was season-high 13-under .500 mark on 5/21 (18-31)...longest win streak of 2018 is 3 games, 4/25-28...team had a season-long 5-G losing streak, 4/8-13.

**IN THE STANDINGS:** The Rangers have been 13.5 GB of division-leading SEA for 2 straight days, matching largest deficit in 2018 (6 days total)...have gained ground in the division on 3 of last 7 and 4 of last 10 days, and have been between 11.5 and 13.5 GB for 15 straight days...current deficit of 13.5 GB is 5th largest in the majors (BAL: -23.0 GB; CIN: -16.0 GB; MIA/TOR: -14.5 GB)...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 57 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 67 of the 68 days this season (T2nd following win on 3/30).

**SERIES STUFF:** The Texas loss in Sunday's rubber game in Anaheim ended a span in which Rangers had gone 1-0-2 over previous 3 series...club is now 0-4-2 in last 6 road series...at home, team has gone 2-6-1 in 9 series this season, including 2-0-1 in last 3 after dropping each of 1st 6...Rangers are 0-4-2 in last 6 series vs. A.L. West clubs since taking 2 of 3 from 4/13-15 at HOU.

**AT HOME:** The Rangers have gone 11-19 (.367) in Arlington this season, 4th-lowest win pct. in A.L. and 6th-lowest in MLB...team has won 4 of 6, 5 of 8, and 6 of last 10 at home, but have dropped 18 of last 28 at home...have gone 6-4 in last 10 G in Arlington after opening year at 5-15...the 11-19 mark matches slowest 30-G start at home in club history (also 1982 and 2001)...slowest 31-G start in team history is 11-20 in 2001.

• Over 14 home games since the start of May, the Rangers are averaging 1.64 HR/G (4th in MLB) and 5.29 R/G (6th in MLB), this after ranking in the bottom 6 in those categories at home through the end of April (0.69 HR/G; 3.56 R/G).

**THE SWINGIN' A'S:** The Rangers are 3-4 vs. the Athletics in 2018, dropping 2 of 3 in last meeting 4/23-25 in Arlington...Texas has lost 3 of 5, 5 of 8, 12 of 17, 14 of 22, and 18 of last 31 vs. A's...Rangers have gone 21-20 vs. OAK beginning 6/14/16...Texas was 8-11 against Oakland in 2017, and Rangers have lost season series vs. A's in 4 of last 6 seasons...Rangers went 7-3 vs. the A's at home last season, and have won 12 of last 19 meetings in Arlington...Texas leads all-time series 364-356, and holds leads of 192-168 in Arlington and 104-101 at Globe Life Park...teams are playing 3 straight series in Arlington, the next from 7/23-26 (4 G).

**SOME REST:** Texas enters this homestand with a 2-3 record following an off day this season, as yesterday's respite fell after a season-long span of games on 20 consecutive days...after 2 days off in May, the Rangers are slated for 5 days off in June, as club will not play for more than 6 consecutive days until 9 in a row from July 3-11.

**TOUGH LUCK FOR FISTER:** On Sun. at LAA, Doug Fister (6.0 IP, 3 R-ER) took a loss in quality start for a 2nd consecutive outing...became just 4th Ranger since the start of 2014 to lose back-to-back starts, both quality outings...the others: Yovani Gallardo (4/27-5/3/15), Derek Holland (5/16-23/16), and Miguel Gonzalez (9/23-28/17)...Fister is one of only 10 MLB pitchers to endure an 0-2 span in consecutive quality starts in 2018.

**NO FREEBIES:** Texas pitchers combined for a 4th walkless game on Sun. at LAA, 2nd such effort on the road trip (also last Tues. at SEA)...since 5/16, Rangers staff has 6 G with one-or-zero walks, 2nd-most in A.L. and T2nd-most in MLB (7-SEA, 6-TEX/PHI/PIT)...since the start of May, TEX has averaged 2.49 BB/9, 4th-best figure in MLB to WAS (2.43), HOU (2.45), and SEA (2.48)...TEX averaged 3.36 BB/9 thru the end of April.

• Staff had a 7.33 SO/BB figure in Anaheim (22 SO/3 BB), 2nd-best for TEX in any 3-G series since start of 2014 (8.33 SO/BB, 5/16-18/17 vs. PHI).

**PROVIDING RELIEF:** The Texas bullpen has not allowed a run in its last 11.0 innings and has issued just 3 runs in 31.2 innings over the last 10 games with 4 wins and 3 saves...relievers have a 2.34 ERA (23 ER/88.1 IP) with .219 opp. BA in last 27 G to drop season figure from 4.71 to 3.72, lowest since 4/14 (3.66)...**2.34 ERA beginning 5/6 is the lowest in MLB**...the bullpen has earned the last 4 and 5 of the last 6 Rangers wins...4 straight wins by relievers is club's longest streak since 5 in a row, 5/10-14/17.

**CHOO TRAIN ROLLS ON:** Shin-Soo Choo had 2 doubles and a walk on Sun. at LAA in his 1st start in LF since 8/20/14 at MIA...Choo's active on-base (20 G) and hit (11 G) streaks are longest by a Ranger in '18...the 20-G on-base streak is longest current run in MLB, and 11-G hit streak ties longest active span (also COL's Charlie Blackmon and NYY's Austin Romine)...longest on-base streak for a Ranger since a 21-gamer for Joey Gallo, 8/14-9/12/17...since 5/1, Choo's .419 OBP ranks 6th in the A.L.

• Since 2008, the only other Rangers aged 35-or-older with a 20-G on-base streak were Adrián Beltré (2x in 2014) and Vladimir Guerrero (2010).

**THE COMEBACK KIDS:** Each of the Rangers' last 6 wins have been come-from-behind victories over team's past 12 G beginning 5/23...it is longest span for each win to be a comeback W since 9 straight, 6/9-26/13...the Rangers had just 4 comeback victories in 1st 19 wins/50 games of the 2018 season.

**SEEKING THE CLUTCH HIT:** Sunday's loss marked 3rd time this season for TEX to score one-or-zero runs while stranding 10+ baserunners (4-CHC, 3-BAL/MIA/TEX)...Rangers have had 12 baserunners in each of those 3 defeats...team is 2-for-27 w/ RISP the past 4 G since back-to-back games with 5 H w/ RISP on Tues./Wed. at SEA.

• Sunday's loss was the Rangers' 1st when allowing 4-or-fewer baserunners (incl. reach on error) since 7/21/01 at TB.

**MAZ PROVIDES THE OFFENSE:** Texas has scored one or zero runs in each of its last 3 losses, and in 2 of those defeats the club's lone run scored on a Nomar Mazara solo HR (Sun. at LAA, Thurs. at SEA)...a Mazara solo HR has accounted for the Rangers' lone run in 3 different games in '18.

**BELTRÉ IS BACK:** Adrián Beltré enters the homestand seeking his 1st game action in Arlington since 5/9 vs. DET...in 3 G since his return from the DL, Beltré has played 3 times, making 2 starts as DH and one (Sat. at LAA) at 3rd base...Beltré in 16 G at Globe Life Park this season: .386/.433/.509/.942 (22-57) with 7 2B and 9 RBI.

**SHORTS:** Happy birthday to Robinson Chirinos (34)...only previous b-day game for Chirinos was 6/5/15 at KC (1-4, 2 RBI)...last Ranger to homer on b-day: Nelson Cruz, 7/1/11 vs. FLA...TEX has used 13 pinch-runners in '18, T5th-most in MLB (30-DET, 17-SEA, 14-CLE/LAA, 13-TEX/CWS)...TEX used 2 pitchers on Sun. at LAA to match season low (5th time)...have used just 2 pitchers 4 times in last 11 G after just one instance in Rangers' 1st 51 contests...Rangers are in span of 13 straight against the A.L. West, facing each of the division's other 4 clubs in one series apiece...TEX will not face an A.L. West club outside of OAK and HOU until August...Rangers are 6-3 in last 9 night contests.

**TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#55 Matt Moore, LHP  
(1-5, 7.85)**

**TONIGHT:** The 28-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 11th start and 12th appearance in tonight's homestand opener against the A's...will be making his 2nd start since a return from the disabled list, pitching on 5 days' rest since taking no decision in the Rangers' come-from-behind 7-6 win on Wed. at SEA...was on the DL 5/19-29 with right knee soreness...last 3 starts have all been road outings, as he is pitching in Arlington for 1st time since 5/7 vs. DET...has gone 0-3, 7.83 (20 ER/23.0 IP) in his 5 G/GS at Globe Life Park this season...in 5 May starts, went 0-2, 10.80 (26 ER/21.2 IP) with an opponent slash of .379/.441/.660/1.101, although Rangers were 3-2 in those starts...is among the A.L. trailers in runs allowed (T3rd, 45) and hits allowed (T10th, 71)...has the highest ERA among ML pitchers with at least 10 starts...was acquired in a 3-player trade with SF on 12/15/17...has returned to the American League, where he went 39-28 with 3.88 ERA from 2011-16 with TB...was traded to the Giants on 8/1/16, going 6-5 the rest of that season...tied for the N.L. lead with 15 losses in 2017 while receiving the 3rd lowest run support of any Major League qualifying pitcher...posted 10+ victories 3 times with the Rays, going 17-4 and earning A.L. All-Star honors in 2013...had Tommy John surgery in 2014 when he made just 2 starts...was selected by TB in 8th round of 2007 MLB Draft and made ML debut in September 2011...team is 4-6 in his 10 starts.

**LAST START:** Was activated from the 10-day DL on Wednesday, and took no decision in the Rangers' 7-6 come-from-behind win on Wed. at SEA (5.1 IP, 8 H, 5 R-4 ER, 2 BB, 6 SO, 108 pitches/68 strikes)...posted a season high for pitches in what was his 3rd-longest start (innings-wise) with Texas...allowed hits in each of the final 6 frames in which he pitched, but only walks came in the 4th...gave up 3 R in a 33-pitch 4th inning.

**VS. OAKLAND:** Is 1-2, 6.82 (25 ER/33.0 IP) in 6 G/GS in his career against Oakland...posted strong performance in his other outing vs. A's in '18, as he also started series opener in OAK's other visit to Arlington on 4/23 in Rangers' 9-4 loss (ND, 5.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R-ER, 2 BB, 2 SO, 0 HR, 86 pitches/56 strikes)...with that 4/23 game tied 3-3, came back out for the 6th inning, but gave up a leadoff single to Matt Olson and was lifted for José Leclerc, who stranded the inherited runner...game remained tied until the 9th, when Kevin Jepsen was tagged for 4 runs in a 6-run frame for the A's.

**AT GLOBE LIFE PARK:** Has gone 0-3, 7.83 (20 ER/23.0 IP) in his 5 G/GS in Arlington...including his start in Game 1 of the 2011 ALDS for the Rays against the Rangers, began career with 13.1 scoreless innings in Arlington...prior to this season had made just one regular season start at this facility, a 2-0 Rays win on 4/10/13 (5.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R-ER, 6 BB, 5 SO)...outdueled Derek Holland (8.0 IP, 2 R) in that contest...only hit allowed was a single by Craig Gentry...also tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in Tampa Bay's 9-0 win over the Rangers in Game 1 of the 2011 ALDS...had made just 3 career starts in the regular season before that postseason start...was the Rays' only win of the series as Texas went on to win the next 3 games and the series.

**IN RELIEF:** Only relief outing this season was on 4/29 at TOR (1.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 10 pitches), finishing out a 7-2 loss in series finale vs. Jays ahead of his scheduled start at the end of the road trip...it was just the 4th relief outing of his career, and joined 9/3/17 vs. STL (while with SF) as only bullpen appearances since his rookie season in 2011.

**2018:** Rangers are 4-6 in his starts...for the season, opponent slash line is .345/.415/.544/.959, and he owns a 2.000 WHIP figure...LHB have a .441 (15-34) BA with a 1.206 OPS...Robinson Chirinos (7.45 ERA, 24 ER/29.0 IP) has caught 7 G/6 GS, Juan Centeno (8.40 ERA) caught 3 starts, and Carlos Pérez caught outing on 5/13 at HOU...opposition hitting .282 (31-110) with 2 strikes, but just 7-for-33 in last 3 outings...opponents after 1-0 count: .394 (26-66)...after 0-1 count: .298 (34-114)...batters leading off an inning have hit .213 (10-47) with 2 BB and HBP...1st batters faced are 1-for-11...batters have a .362 (25-69) BA with RISP, just 2-for-9 in start Wed. at SEA...opponent avg by PA in game (starts): 1st - .333 (28-84), 2nd - .449 (35-78), 3rd - .150 (6-40), 4th- 1-for-1...suffered the loss in his Texas debut, a 9-3 Rangers defeat on 3/31 vs. HOU in Arlington (4.0 IP, 4 R-ER, 0 BB, 6 SO)...was the 2nd starter in Texas history with 6+ SO and zero walks in a start of 4.0 innings-or-less, joining Colby Lewis on 6/23/12 vs. COL (4.0 IP, 0 BB, 6 SO)...Rays went 0-for-final-12 vs. Moore on 4/17 at TB, as he earned win in 1st-ever appearance against his former club...on 5/13-18, became 1st Texas starter to complete less than 4.0 IP in back-to-back starts since Cole Hamels, 9/26-10/1/17.

**0-AND-3:** Lost each of his 1st 3 starts before his win on 4/17 at TB...1st pitcher to lose each of 1st 3 starts to begin his Rangers career since Jason Jennings in April 2008...last longer streak was Ed Figueroa, who lost his 1st 4 starts in August 1980.
