WINS AND LOSSES: Texas fell to the A's last night, 13-10 in 10 innings, and club has a 1-4 record on this 2nd 'half' opening 7-day, 7-game homestand against CLE (1-2) and OAK (0-2)...team has dropped 6 of 7, 9 of 11, and 12 of 14...at 4-14 (.222), Texas has the lowest win pct. in MLB this month...TEX has more losses this month (4-14) than in entire month of June (14-11)...the 4 wins this month have come against DET (2), BAL (1), and CLE (1), and 2 of the 4 wins have been SHO...team still has a 15-16 record beginning 6/16.

- At 42-60 (.412), Rangers rank 12th in A.L. in winning pct...the 42 wins are the fewest for Texas after 102 games since 2014 (40-62) and 2nd fewest in last 16 seasons (beg. 2004).
- Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...team is season-high 18 games under .500...this is just 7th season in TEX history to be 18+ under as early as 7/24 (last 2014, 38-56 on 7/12)...club lost a season high 7 straight games from 6/7-15 and directly followed that with a 2018 best 7 consecutive wins from 6/16-23.

SERIES STUFF: Texas will need to win each of the final 2 G of this series to avoid a 4th straight series loss...Rangers are 0-4-1 in last 5 series after having won a season-best 5 consecutive series from 6/15-7/1...team is still 6-3-1 in last 10 series in Arlington, only losses in that span to the Astros (0-4 from 6/7-10; 0-2 from 7/3-4) and Indians (1-2 from 7/20-22).

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas is a season-high 24.5 GB of division-leading HOU, the 2nd-earliest date ever for Rangers to have a 24.5-game deficit (6/5 in 2001) and just the 10th season overall in club history to have a deficit so large...club has gained ground on just 2 total days in July (once on an off day)...only other season with a 24+ game deficit in last 16 seasons (beg. 2004) was 2014...club has lost 8.0 games in the standings over the last 21 days...current deficit is 2nd-largest in the majors...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 106 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 116 of 117 days (T2nd following win on 3/30).

AT HOME: Texas is 20-32 (.385) in Arlington this season, 3rd-lowest home win pct. in A.L. and 4th-lowest in MLB...team has gone 1-7 in 8 home games in July, a span which was preceded by a 6-1 stretch in Arlington from 6/16-6/30...team is 7-8 in last 15 at home, this after a 5-G losing skid from 6/7-15, and are 13-15 in last 28 G after opening year at 5-15...overall 20-32 record matches slowest 52-G start at home in TEX history (also 2014)...team was 20-33 after 53 G in 2014.

THE SWINGIN' A'S: The Rangers are 5-7 vs. OAK in '18, losing 2 straight to the Athletics...TEX has still won 3 of 5 and is 4-4 in last 8 G vs. A's...Rangers have gone 23-22 vs. OAK beginning 6/14/16...Texas was 8-11 against Oakland in 2017, and Rangers have lost season series vs. A's in 4 of last 6 seasons...Rangers went 7-3 vs. the A's at home last season, and have won 14 of last 23 meetings in Arlington...Texas leads all-time series 366-358, and holds leads of 194-170 in Arlington and 106-103 at Globe Life Park...this is the 3rd straight series between the clubs to be played at Globe Life Park, as each of final 2 meetings will be at the Coliseum (8/20-22 and 9/7-9).

TURN THE PAGE: The Rangers held an 8-run lead last night (led 10-2 after 6 innings) before Oakland tied the game in the 9th...it was the team's largest blown lead in a game since a 13-12 win on 5/6/10 vs. Kansas City (led 8-0 at one point)...last night marked the 2nd-largest lead in any loss in Texas history (1972-2018), as only other time to lose after leading by 8+ runs was on 5/16/06 at the New York Yankees (club led 9-0 and 10-1 in that game)...it was the 1st time Texas had lost a game this season when leading after 8 innings (35-0) entering the contest.

- The Rangers had not scored as many as 10 runs in a game that they had lost since a 22-10 setback on 7/26/17 vs. MIA.

JOEY GALLO has homered in 7 of his last 16 games started dating back to 6/29, tied for most in the A.L. and 3rd-most in MLB over that span (STL's Matt Carpenter-10; SD's Wil Myers-8)...Gallo's 25 home runs overall are T5th in the A.L.

- According to baseball-reference.com, Gallo is the 9th batter in Texas history with multiple 25-HR seasons before his age 25 season (age as of 6/30)...Gallo joins Rougned Odor (2016-17), Hank Blalock (2003-05), and Mark Teixeira (2003-04) as the only Rangers to accomplish the feat since 1994.

ELVIS ANDRUS hit his 1st career grand slam and matched a career best with 5 RBI last night...the 5 RBI match a single-game high for a Texas batter this season, joining Jurickson Profar (6/6 vs. OAK) and Nomar Mazara (5/3 vs. BOS)...Andrus has hit safely in 6 straight at .409/.462/.727/1.189 (9-22) with 2 HR and 7 RBI, matching his 2nd-longest hit streak of the season (9 G, 6/25-7/5).

ELVIS WITH THE BASES LOADED: Last night's grand slam pushed Andrus' career average with the bases loaded to .336 (40-119), 5th-highest in team history (min. 60 PA)...the only higher averages in Rangers history belong to Rusty Greer (.418, 33-79), Mitch Moreland (.359, 23-64), Pudge Rodriguez (.351, 47-134), and Michael Young (.338, 47-139)...Andrus had been 0-for-his-last-5 with the bases loaded dating back to last season before the home run.

ROUGNED ODOR has an extra-base hit in a season-high 3 straight games, and a team-high 8 extra-base hits in the month of July...Odor is now batting .349/.425/.571/.996 (22-63) in the month of July, posting the 9th-highest average in the A.L.

SHIN-SOO CHOO had a single and walk last night, and has now reached safely in 55 of his last 56 games dating back to 5/13...Choo has posted .322/.458/.559/1.018 slash line during the 56-G stretch, ranking among the ML leaders over that span in OBP (2nd-Mike Trout leads at .459), walks (3rd, 51), and OPS (8th)...he has been on base 121 times since 5/13, 2nd-most in the majors to Trout (124).

CORY GEARRIN has logged 6.1 scoreless innings in his 1st 6 outings with the club since he was acquired in a trade with San Francisco on 7/8...over that span, Gearrin has retired 19 of 23 BF...including his last 7 outings with the Giants, Gearrin has compiled an 11.2-inning scoreless streak dating back to 6/11, tied for the 9th-longest active scoreless streak in the majors.

SUMMER SLAMS: Texas has 3 grand slams this season, including 2 within the last 6 games (Elvis Andrus last night vs. OAK and Ronald Guzmán on 7/15 at BAL)...the 3 grand slams already match the club's 2nd-most in a season since the start of 2012 (5 in 2016)...each of the team's last 3 slams had come on the road, as Andrus' slam last night was the club's 1st in Arlington since Ryan Rua on 4/26/17...Andrus also hit the 1st grand slam by a Texas shortstop since Michael Young on 9/16/07 at OAK...a TEX shortstop had not hit a grand slam at Globe Life Park since Young on 9/21/04 vs. OAK off Mark Mulder.

SHORTS: RHP Brett Eibner made his 1st career appearance on the mound last night for the AZL Rangers, recording a pair of strikeouts in an inning of work...last night was the 1st time Eibner appeared in an official game since 7/7/17 with the Oklahoma City Dodgers...Shin-Soo Choo is batting .393 (11-28) with 4 BB in his career vs. Edwin Jackson, 6th-highest average among active players...the Rangers are 3-for-14 with 2 HR with the bases loaded since 6/30...Mike Minor has held opponents to a .217 average in his last 8 starts dating back to 6/9, 9th-lowest in the A.L. over that span...Adrián Beltré is tied for the A.L. lead with 7 sacrifice flies (also Carlos Correa and Didi Gregorius).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#33 Martin Pérez, LHP
(2-4, 8.05)

TONIGHT: The 27-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 8th start of the season tonight in the 3rd of 4 games against the Athletics this week...will be working on regular 4-days' rest after a no decision in the club's 9-8, 11-inning loss to the Indians in the 2nd 'half' opener on Friday...has allowed at least 6 runs in 3 of his 7 starts in 2018...has allowed 7 R-ER over 12.1 IP in 2 starts since returning from the disabled list...was on the DL 4/30-7/13 with right elbow discomfort...made 3 starts in the minors on an injury rehabilitation assignment, going 2-0 with a 0.52 ERA (1 ER/17.1 IP) and 3 BB/19 SO with Low-A Hickory, Double-A Frisco, and Triple-A Round Rock...opened the season on the DL while still recovering from arthroscopic surgery on 12/18/17 to repair a broken right radial head in his right (non-throwing) elbow...pitched in 2 spring training 'A' games, but opened the season on the DL while still recovering from offseason surgery on his right (non-throwing) elbow...posted a career-high 13 wins in 2017...one of just 12 American League pitchers with 30+ starts in each of the last two seasons, Pérez ranks T15th in Texas history in starts (119 - also Jon Matlack), 3 shy of Yu Darvish (14th, 122)...saw two seasons cut short in 2014-15 following 'Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on his left elbow on 5/19/14...the Venezuela native signed a four-year contract through 2017 with club options for 2018, 2019, and 2020 on 11/7/13...made his major league debut in 2012 at the age of 21, and was rated as one of the Rangers' top five prospects by *Baseball America* in five straight seasons from 2009-13...celebrated his 27th birthday on the eve of his season debut...Texas is 2-5 in his starts.

LAST START: Took a no decision in the club's 9-8, 11-inning loss to the Indians in the 2nd 'half' opener on Friday (5.1 IP, 10 H, 6 R-ER, 2 BB, 4 SO, 2 HR, 105 pitches/64 strikes)...matched a season high with 10 hits allowed (3rd time)...threw 31 pitches in the Tribe's 3-run 2nd inning...surrendered a 2-run home run to Jason Kipnis, his 1st HR allowed to a LHB since 9/8/17 vs. NYY (Didi Gregorius).

VS. OAKLAND: Has gone 8-7 with a 5.23 ERA (54 ER/93.0 IP) over 17 career starts vs. the Athletics...has more starts, wins, and losses vs. A's than any other club...earned his 1st win of the season in a 6-3 Texas victory on 4/5 at the Coliseum (5.1 IP, 10 H, 3 R-ER, 0 BB, 1 SO, 0 HR, 76 pitches/52 strikes)...was the 1st Texas starter to allow 10+ hits and earn the victory since Yovani Gallardo (5.1 IP, 11 H) in a 5-3 Rangers win on 8/16/15 vs. TB...Athletics are batting .313/.356/.471/.827 in last 9 starts dating back to the start of 2016...has won 3 straight vs. the A's in Arlington, compiling a 1.96 ERA (4 ER/18.1 IP) during the streak.

DISABLED LIST STINTS: Has a pair of stints on the disabled list this season related to off-season surgery on his right elbow...was on the DL from 4/30-7/13 with right elbow discomfort and did not pitch for nearly 2 months until a rehab start with Hickory on 6/25...opened the season on the DL while still recovering from offseason surgery despite pitching in 2 spring training 'A' games, and was activated on 4/5...pitched in a simulated game on 3/30 at Round Rock in preparation for his 1st outing on 4/5 at OAK.

REHAB: Had 3 starts in the minors on an injury rehabilitation assignment during his 2nd DL stay, going 2-0 with a 0.52 ERA (1 ER/17.1 IP) and 3 BB/19 SO with Low-A Hickory, Double-A Frisco, and Triple-A Round Rock...last started for Round Rock on 7/5 at Oklahoma City (6.1 IP, 6 H, 1 R-ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 6 SO, 87 pitches/58 strikes)...combined to throw 72% of pitches for strikes in the 3 starts...had a 70% groundball rate...opposing batters combined to hit .161/.200/.226/.426 in the 3 outings.

AT GLOBE LIFE PARK: Has made just 3 starts in Arlington this season, going 1-1 with a 10.05 ERA (16 ER/14.1 IP)...Pérez ranks among all-time leaders at this park in starts (7th, 64), wins (T9th w/ Aaron Sele, 27), and innings (8th, 378.0)...next on list in starts is Yu Darvish (6th, 65) and next in innings is C.J. Wilson (7th, 379.1)...next in wins is combo of Millwood/C.J. Wilson (T7th, 28)...has won 8 of his last 12 decisions in Arlington, but has a 7.21 ERA (43 ER/53.2 IP) over his last 10 starts here beg. 7/30/17.

2018: Team is 2-5 in his 7 starts...Robinson Chirinos (0-4, 10.03 ERA) has caught 5 starts and Juan Centeno caught 2 starts (2-0, 3.97 ERA)...batters leading off innings are 16-for-33 with 4 BB and 5 HR...opponents batting .362 (17-47) w/ RISP...opponent by time through order - 1st time: .389 (21-54); 2nd time - .404 (23-57); 3rd time - .316 (12-38); 4th time - 0-for-1...opposition hitting .462 (12-26) on the 1st pitch of an at-bat...is the 1st Texas starter with 3 starts of 10+ hits allowed in a season since Colby Lewis (6) in 2015.

SURGERY: Underwent arthroscopic surgery on 12/18/17 to repair a broken right radial head in his right (non-throwing) elbow and has spent the last 2 months of the offseason on a rehab and throwing program...the surgery was performed by Dr. Thomas Diliberti in Dallas, as he removed the fragmented pieces and replaced the radial head...sustained the injury in an accident at his ranch in his native Venezuela on 12/11/17.

GROUNDING: Induced 32 GDP's in 2017, 2nd-most in A.L. and T2nd-most in MLB to only TOR's Marcus Stroman (34)...it was also the 2nd-highest single-season total in club history to only Pérez's 2016 total (36)...he is 1st pitcher with back-to-back seasons of 32+ GDP's induced since NYY's Chien-Ming Wang in 2006-07.

2017: Led staff in wins (career-high 13), GS (32), and IP (185.0)...also established career high in SO (115), 2nd on club (Darvish-148)...over final 11 starts beginning 8/9, went 8-2 with a 3.71 ERA (28 ER/68.0 IP) in 11 G/GS to drop final ERA from 5.46 to 4.82...won a career-best 7 consecutive starts (zero no decisions) from 8/9-9/8, T2nd-longest streak by a Texas starter in team history.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER — RHP BARTOLO COLON (5-8, 4.85 ERA in 20 games/18 starts)
