#### THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - AUG. 18

**2015** - **Marwin Gonzalez** connects for his first career walk-off homer, sending the Astros to a 3-2 victory in 10 innings over the Rays and RHP Brad Boxberger.

**2001** - In a 3-0 win over the Pirates at Minute Maid Park, **Carlos Hernandez** hurls 7.0 shutout innings in his Major League debut and **Jeff Bagwell** steals home.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros continue this nine-game AL West road trip today as they try to even-up the three-game series against the A's at Oakland Coliseum...**LHP Dallas Keuchel** (9-9) takes his four-game road winning streak to the hill today opposite **RHP Trevor Cahill** (4-2) and the A's.

**VINTAGE KEUCHEL:** **LHP Dallas Keuchel**, the 2015 AL Cy Young Award winner, has found his form over his last 11 starts, posting a 6-1 record with a 2.19 ERA (17ER/70IP) and nine quality starts.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Astros have been the top road team in the Majors Leagues, as their 41-19 (.683) road record is the best in baseball...the Astros road winning percentage is the third-best of the expansion era (since 1961), behind only the 2001 Mariners (59-22, .728) and 1971 Athletics (55-25, .688).

**GOING BACK TO CALI:** The Astros have been at their best in the state of California this season, as they have gone 14-4 (.778) in 18 games in The Golden State...this includes games against the A's (6-1), Angels (4-2), Dodgers (2-1) and Giants (2-0).

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Astros fell to the A's in walkoff fashion last night, 4-3...with Houston up 3-2 in the 9th, a controversial overturned call via replay review gave the A's the tying run...**LHP Tony Sipp** gave up a walkoff HR to **Matt Olson** to start the 10th...**3B Alex Bregman** (1x3) homered and drew 2 walks...**C Martín Maldonado** (1x3) hit his first HR with the Astros...**RHP Charlie Morton** (1ER/5IP) started for Houston.

**DOWN BY THE BAY:** Last night's loss snapped the Astros six-game winning streak at Oakland Coliseum...dating back to the 2016 season, the Astros have gone 16-5 (.762) in their last 21 games at the venue.

**THE KID:** **3B Alex Bregman** has reached base safely in 37 consecutive road games, the longest active streak in the Major Leagues and the fourth-longest streak in franchise history...only **Jeff Bagwell** (51 games from 1998-99, 43 games in 1998) and **Jose Altuve** (43 games in 2016) posted longer streaks.

**NO FREE PASSES:** The Astros pitching staff gave up six walks last night, snapping a run where they had allowed one walk or less in six consecutive games...that streak was tied for the longest in franchise history (also June 13-18, 2006)...on the year, the Astros 7.1% walk rate is the third-lowest in the Majors.

**TWO-HUNDO CLUB:** **RHP Charlie Morton** struck out four batters last night and has already set a career-high for strikeouts in a season with 175...Morton has a chance to make the Astros the fourth team in Major League history to have three pitchers reach the 200-strikeout mark in a single season, as he would join **RHP Gerrit Cole** (219) and **RHP Justin Verlander** (217).

**THE RACE IS ON!** The AL West race is in full swing as the Astros enter today with a 1.0-game lead in the division over the A's...the Astros and A's will match up in two series to close out the regular season: this three-game series in Oakland, and a three-game series in Houston later this month from Aug. 27-29.

**INJURY REPORT:** The Astros extensive injury report got considerably lighter with yesterday's activation of **OF George Springer** (left thumb sprain) and last week's activation of **SS Carlos Correa** (lower back soreness)...Houston's injury report still includes **OF Jake Marisnick** (left groin discomfort) and four former All-Stars in **2B Jose Altuve** (right knee soreness), **RHP Chris Devenski** (left hamstring tightness), **C Brian McCann** (right knee discomfort) and **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (right elbow discomfort).

**GETTING STRONGER EVERY DAY:** **RHP Chris Devenski** struck out three batters in a scoreless inning last night in the second game of his injury rehab assignment at Triple A Fresno...**C Brian McCann**, who underwent arthroscopic surgery on his right knee on July 3, began an injury rehab assignment with Fresno on Thur. night, going 1x4 with a walk and a run scored in a start at DH.

**STEPPING UP:** Since **2B Jose Altuve** was placed on the DL on July 29, the Astros have gone 7-9 in 16 games...since that date, **IF Marwin Gonzalez** has hit .304 (17x56) with two doubles and four home runs, while **IF Tyler White** has hit .347 (17x49) with two doubles, a triple, four home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.142 OPS.

**FIVE GUYS:** The Astros have only used five starting pitchers this season, the fewest in the Majors, and two less than their closest counterparts, the Rockies (7) and Indians (7)...the Astros rotation has posted the best ERA (3.05) and WHIP (1.09) and the most strikeouts (864) in the Majors this season.

**FEEL THE BREEZE:** Astros starters have posted 25 double-digit strikeout games this season, a new club record (previously 24 in 1969)...also ties the second-most double-digit strikeout games by a team in AL history (last, 2017 Indians)...the Astros are seven shy of the AL record of 32, set by the 1973 Angels.

**UNHITTABLE:** **RHP Collin McHugh** has posted a 1.12 ERA (7ER/56.1IP) this season, which ranks second among all relievers behind A's **RHP Blake Treinen** (0.87)...McHugh is on pace to set a franchise record for ERA by a reliever (**Don McMahon**: 1.53 in 1962).

**SHARK WEEK:** **IF Tyler White** is on a career-long seven-game hitting streak in which he has hit .400 (10x25) with one double, one triple, four homers and 10 RBI.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY!** To Astros **DH Evan Gattis**, who turns 32 years old today...in his career, he has gone 3x10 (.300) with one double, one walk and one RBI in three games on his birthday.

**RBI WORLD SERIES:** The Astros RBI softball team won the 2018 RBI World Series softball championship Thursday, defeating the Rays RBI Tampa team, 9-1.

**LAST START - 8/12 VS. SEA:** did not factor into the decision in Houston's 4-3 loss vs. the Mariners...gave up just 2 runs on 7 hits over 7.0 innings pitched...struck out 5 with 1 walk.

**DK60:** is set to make his 26th start of the season today...has thrown 155.0 innings, also his most since 2016 (168.0).

- has put together another solid season in what is his 7th season in the Majors...ranks 6th in the American League in innings pitched and 12th in ERA (5th among lefties).

**HITTING HIS STRIDE:** over his last 11 starts since June 16, has gone 6-1 with a 2.19 ERA (17ER/70IP) ...9 of those 11 starts have been quality starts.

- among all AL pitchers during this recent run, ranks 2nd in ERA behind only Trevor Bauer (1.62)...also ranks T-4th in wins.

**YOU'RE GROUNDED:** ranks 2nd in the Majors in groundball rate (56.0%) behind Clayton Richard (57.8%) of the Padres...leads the American League in groundball to flyball ratio (2.82).

- is one of the greatest groundball artists in recent memory...since 1987, the year groundballs were first tracked, is 1 of 4 pitchers to post a career groundball rate of at least 60% (min. 800IP)...his 60% mark trails only Brandon Webb (65.1%), Derek Lowe (62.7%) and Bill Swift (61.7%).

**SOFT SERVE:** among all AL pitchers, ranks 3rd in in soft contact percentage (23.7%)...behind Chris Sale (28.7%) and CC Sabathia (25.5).

- since his breakout 2014 season, no starting pitcher in the Majors has induced soft contact at a higher rate...has posted a 23.7% soft contact rate since 2014, the top mark in MLB in that span directly ahead of Tyler Anderson of the Rockies (22.8%).

**BACK TO HIS OLD TRICKS:** the 3-time Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner (2014-16) has not made an error in his 25 starts and 32 total chances this season...ranks 3rd among AL pitchers in assists (20) and T-4th in total chances (32).

**VS OAK:** will be making is 21st-career start against Oakland and 3rd of the season...in his career is 6-5 with a 2.78 ERA (40ER/129.2IP), with 83 strikeouts and 38 walks.

**JET SETTER:** while he has been better at Minute Maid Park than on the road during his career (3.06 ERA), this season, he has been one of the AL's top pitchers on the road...in 13 road starts, has gone 6-4 with a 3.00 ERA (27ER/81IP), which ranks 9th in the AL in road ERA.

- has given up just 6 earned runs over his last 5 road starts, going 4-0 with a 1.60 ERA (6ER/33.2IP), 24 hits allowed and 24 strikeouts in that span.

**UP THE CHARTS:** has surpassed a couple milestones this season, his 7th in the Majors with the Astros.

- became the 16th pitcher in franchise history to reach 1,000 innings (4/16 at SEA) in an Astros uniform and the 5th left-hander...currently ranks 13th in franchise history in innings pitched and is 3rd among lefties, trailing Wandy Rodriguez (1306.2).

- recorded his 800th career strikeout on 4/10 at MIN...became the 13th pitcher in Astros history to record 800 strikeouts...currently ranks 12th in strikeouts in franchise history, immediately trailing Bob Knepper (946) on that list.
