Dating back to Aug. 11, **Ryon Healy** is batting .380 (19x50) with 6 R, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 RBI, 2 BB in 14 games...during this stretch his .380 average ranks 6th in the Majors (min. 50 AB)...teammate **Jean Segura** ranks 2nd ML during this time frame with a .415 (22x53) average.

James Paxton's 11.37 strikeouts per 9.0 innings (176 SO, 139.1 IP) is the 3rd-highest in club history, trailing only Randy Johnson in 1995 (12.35/294 SO, 214.1 IP) and 1997 (12.30/291 SO, 213.0 IP).

The Mariners and Athletics meet for the 14th (8-6) of 20 games in 2018...since 2015, the Mariners are 24-12 (.667) at Oakland:

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue their penultimate road trip of the season - a 10-day, 9-game, 3-city trip - with the 3rd of 4 games at the Oakland Athletics (1-1)...the Mariners opened the road trip taking 2 of 3 games vs. the Arizona Diamondbacks at Chase Field and fell 0-2 in a brief 2-game series vs. the San Diego Padres...following this series, will return to Safeco Field on Monday for a 10-day, 8-game homestand against Baltimore (3 G), New York-AL (3 G) and San Diego (2 G)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...Mariners have won 10 of their last 20 and 12 of their last 24 games...are 20-29 (7/4-current) since winning a season-high 8 straight games (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners have won 35 of their last 71 games, 42 of their last 80, 46 of their last 86 and 53 of their last 96...Seattle is 61-49 in its last 110 games, 66-52 over its last 118 games...Seattle is 23-23 during the day and 52-37 at night...Seattle is 38-28 at Safeco Field, 37-32 on the road.

- **Close Games** - the Mariners are 48-22 (.686) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 32-18 (.640) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 16-4 (.800) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 54-18 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 21-42 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (64-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (66-0).
- **1,000 RBI** - **Nelson Cruz** (295) is 5 doubles away from 300 in his career...Cruz (996) is also 4 RBI away from 1,000 in his career...he will become the 12th active Major League player with at least 1,000 RBI.
- **Heating Up** - **Dee Gordon** has an active 7-game hitting streak, batting .333 (9x27) with 2 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 RBI and 2 stolen bases.
- **Milestone** - **Kyle Seager** (534) trails Raúl Ibañez (540) by 6 for 8th-most runs scored in club history.
- **On the Road** - the Mariners are 37-32 this season on the road, the 6th-highest winning percentage in club history...Seattle has finished .500 or better on the road 8x in club history: 2001 (.59-72/.728), 2014 (.46-35/.568), 2002 (.45-36/.556), 1997 (.45-36/.556), 2000 (.44-37/.543), 2003 (.43-38/.531), 1996 (.42-38/.525) and 2016 (.42-39/.519).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING...**Mitch Haniger** currently has a season-high 12-game hitting streak (8/18-current), batting .327 (17x52) with 10 runs scored, 2 doubles, 4 home runs, 6 RBI, 1 HBP and 6 walks...his active 12-game hitting streak is currently the longest in the Major Leagues and also tied for the longest hitting streak by a Mariners player this season (also: 12, Dee Gordon - 3/29-4/14)...Haniger's 12-game hitting streak is also the 2nd-longest in his career, trailing only a 13-game hitting streak, April 6-19, 2017.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH...**Mitch Haniger** has hit safely in 24 of 28 games in August, including 12 multi-hit games...over that span, he is batting .345 (41x119) with 19 runs, 12 doubles, 5 home runs, 15 RBI, 1 HBP, 9 walks, a .392 on-base percentage and a .571 slugging percentage (.964 OPS)...among American League leaders in the month of August, Haniger ranks 5th in average, trailing only Mallex Smith-TB (.389/28x72), J.D. Martinez-BOS (.373/38x102), Whit Merrifield-KC (.358/39x109) and Mookie Betts-BOS (.353/36x102)...leads the AL during August in hits (41), while also ranking T1st in doubles (12), 4th in total bases (67), T4th in extra-base hits (17) and 11th in on-base percentage (.393).

JEAN, JEAN, THE HITTING MACHINE...dating back to Aug. 5, **Jean Segura** has hit safely in 13 of his last 18 games, including 10 multi-hit contests, batting .373 (28x75) with 9 runs scored 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 7 RBI, 1 HBP, 4 walks and 5 stolen bases...during this stretch his .373 average is the 3rd-highest in the Major Leagues, trailing only Justin Turner-LAD (.416/37x89) and José Martínez-STL (.388/33x85).

VS. THE A'S...**Dee Gordon** has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games vs. the Athletics (5/23/17-current), including recording 7 multi-hit contests...during this stretch he is batting .419 (26x62) with 10 runs scored, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 9 RBI and 8 stolen bases...since 2017, his .419 average vs. the A's is the 2nd-highest in the Major Leagues (min. 30 PA), trailing only Dustin Pedroia-BOS (.483/14x29).

ROAD WARRIOR...**Jean Segura** is batting .336 (86x256) with 47 runs, 16 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 28 RBI, 3 HBP, 17 walks and 13 stolen bases in 61 games on the road this season...he leads the American League with 86 hits on the road, while also ranking 2nd in average (.336), T3rd in runs scored (47), T4th in stolen bases (13) and 10th in on-base percentage (.383)...Segura's .336 road batting average is currently the 13th-highest in franchise history (best: **Ichiro Suzuki**, .405 in 2004) and highest since Ichiro's .337 average in 2007.

STEAL AWAY...**Dee Gordon** currently leads the American League with 30 stolen bases...Gordon has recorded 5 consecutive seasons with 30+ stolen bases...only Jose Altuve (6, 2012-17, 15 SB in 2018) has a longer active streak while Billy Hamilton (4, 2014-17, 29 SB in 2018) is also 1 stolen base away from his 5th consecutive season with 30+ stolen bases.

THE DÍAZ REPORT...in 64 games this season, **Edwin Díaz** is 50-for-54 (92.6%) in save opportunities with a 1.97 ERA (14 ER, 64.0 IP) with 108 strikeouts and 15 walks...here are some notes on Díaz's standout season:

- Leads the Major Leagues with 50 saves...Craig Kimbrel-BOS is 2nd with 37.
- Is the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in ML history to record at least 50 saves in a season.
- Ranks 2nd among Major League relievers with 108 strikeouts...Josh Hader-MIL is 1st with 113.
- Leads the Major Leagues with 25 one-run saves...Blake Treinen-OAK is 2nd with 16.
- Has struck out 44.8% (108 K, 241 BF) of batters faced this season, the 5th-best single-season strike-out rate by a reliever in Major League history.
- Has struck out his 1st batter faced 30 times this season, most in the Majors (Adam Ottavino-COL, 29).
- His 50 saves are a franchise record, passing Fernando Rodney (48, 2014).
- His 108 strikeouts are 2nd-most as a reliever in club history...trails only Bill Caudill (111, 1982).
- The Mariners are 59-0 when he enters with a lead, including 28-0 when he enters with a 1-run lead.

MAKING THEMSELVES AT HOME...since 2015, the Mariners are 24-12 (.667) in 36 games vs. the Athletics at the Oakland Coliseum...Seattle's .667 winning percentage at the Oakland Coliseum since 2015 is the 2nd-best road winning percentage by any team against a divisional opponent, trailing only Boston at Toronto (25-12/.676) and ranking ahead of Houston at Seattle (24-13/.649), Chicago-NL at Milwaukee (23-13/.639) and New York-NL at Philadelphia (23-13/.639)...during that stretch, Seattle is averaging 5.08 runs/game (183 R, 36 G) while posting a 3.74 ERA (133 ER, 320.1 IP) against the Athletics.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Ryon Healy** is batting .330 (65x197) with 29 runs scored, 12 doubles, 9 home runs, 26 RBI and 10 walks in 50 career games in September...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...**Healy's** .330 average in September is currently the highest among all active Major League players (min. 200 PA)?...**Healy** ranks ahead of Mookie Betts-BOS (.327/135x413), **Dee Gordon** (.325/180x553), **Joey Votto**-CIN (.324/290x894), **José Ramírez**-CLE (.322/118x366) and **Michael Brantley**-CLE (.322/170x528)...**Robinson Canó** (.315/429x1360) ranks 13th in Sept. average.

ABOUT PAXTON...

- 29-year-old left-hander is making his 25th start of 2018, his 99th career MLB start & 9th career start against the Athletics tonight.
- Selected by Seattle in the 4th round of the 2010 MLB June Draft.
- Native of Ladner, BC...attended Delta Secondary School.
- Pitched for the University of Kentucky, 2007-09...was 11-5, 4.91 ERA (81 ER, 148.1 IP) and 168 K's in 55 G/24 GS.
- Originally selected by Toronto in the Supplemental 1st round (39th overall) in the 2009 MLB June Draft, but did not sign.
- Went 1-2 with a 4.08 ERA (8 ER, 17.2 IP) in 4 starts with Grand Prairie in the Independent League in 2010.
- Pitched for the World squad in the 2011 MLB Futures game... named to Midwest League All-Star team in 2011.
- Pitched 6th no-hitter in Mariners history on May 8, 2018 at Toronto.
- Is 7-8 with a 3.87 ERA (46 ER, 107.0 IP) in 21 career starts in September.

LAST OUTING...exited with an injury after just 13 pitches in his last start, a 2-3 Mariners loss in Oakland on Aug. 14... sustained a left forearm contusion after being hit by a comebacker off the bat of Jed Lowrie; was placed on the 10-day disabled list (8/15-8/31).

LEADERBOARD...among Major League leaders, ranks 6th in strikeouts-per-9.0-innings (11.37/176 K, 139.1 IP), 10th in K/BB (4.76/176 K, 37 BB) and T13th in strikeouts (176)...his 7 games with 10+ strikeouts are T4th-most in the American League, tied with Gerrit Cole-HOU and trailing only Chris Sale-BOS (11), Trevor Bauer-CLE (10) and Justin Verlander-HOU (8).

THE RIGHT STUFF...has held right-handed hitters to a .202 batting average (86x425), while lefties have batted .326 (31x95) against Paxton this season... righties hold an OPS of .604 against him this year, while lefties have posted an .884 mark...for his career, Paxton has limited right-handed batters to a .633 OPS, while lefties have recorded a .743 OPS against him.

HE'S BACK...activated from the 10-day disabled list prior to tonight's start...originally placed on the DL on Aug. 14 with a left forearm contusion after being hit with a comebacker...previously spent time on the disabled list July 13-30 with lower back inflammation.

NO-NO...pitched the 6th no-hitter (5th by a single pitcher) in Mariners history in Toronto on May 8...issued 3 walks, struck out 7 batters and needed just 99 pitches to accomplish the feat...recorded his 1st career complete game and 1st career shutout.

- Is the 2nd Canadian-born pitcher in MLB history to throw a no-hitter, joining Dick Fowler, who tossed a no-no for the Philadelphia Athletics vs. the St. Louis Browns in the second game of a doubleheader on Sept. 9, 1945.
- Became the first American League pitcher to record a 16-strikeout game and a no-hitter in the same season since Nolan Ryan achieved both in the same game on May 1, 1991 vs. Toronto with the Texas Rangers...STATS, Inc.
- Marks 4th Mariners no-hitter since 2012, tied with SF for most during that span.
- Marks the 3rd no-hitter in the Majors this season (Sean Manaea-OAK, 4/21 vs. BOS; four pitchers-LAD, 5/4 at SD in Monterrey, Mexico).

KKKKKKKKKKKKKKKKK...recorded a career-high 16 strikeouts across 7.0 scoreless innings on May 2 vs. OAK...Paxton's 16 strikeouts are tied for the most in a single game in the Majors this season (also: Gerrit Cole-HOU, 5/4 at ARI)...marks the most strikeouts by a Mariners pitcher since Randy Johnson struck out 19 on 8/8/97 vs. CWS...became the first pitcher in Mariners history to record at least 2 strikeouts in each of the first 7 innings of a start.

WHIFF...recorded 49 strikeouts over his 5 starts from April 11 to May 2...is one of 5 Mariners pitchers in club history (done 65x) with at least 49 strikeouts over a span of 5 starts, the first since Félix Hernández also had 49 strikeouts over 5 starts, June 23 - July 14, 2012...Randy Johnson accomplished this feat 56 times while with the Mariners, followed by Mark Langston (4), Mike Moore (3), Hernández (1) and Paxton (1).

2017 SEASON RECAP...went 12-5 with a 2.98 ERA (45 ER, 136.0 IP) with 156 strikeouts and 45 walks in 24 starts... led club in wins (12) and strikeouts (156)... recorded a career-high 12 wins and 136.0 IP (previous: 121.0 IP in 2016)...spent 2 stints on the 10-day DL (5/3-30/17, 8/11-9/15/17)...went 6-0 with a 1.37 ERA (6 ER, 39.1 IP) with 46 strikeouts and 6 walks in 6 starts in July; named AL Pitcher of the Month...became the first pitcher in club history to earn 2 AL Player of the Week honors in a single season.

CAREER...is 40-25 with a 3.38 ERA (211 ER, 561.1 IP) with 585 strikeouts in 98 career starts...has spent 8 years in the Mariners organization, including parts of 6 Major League seasons, after being selected by Seattle in 4th round of the 2010 MLB Draft...made MLB debut on Sept. 7, 2013 vs. TB.
