### OAKLAND NOTES

- The A's have won five straight and six of the last seven games after starting the year 0-6...have now won 19 of the last 20 games from Detroit and are 24-7 (.774) against the Tigers dating back June 2, 2015.
- The A's walked 12 times, which are their most in a game since April 18, 2018 against Chicago (AL) when they also had 12.
- The A's scored eight runs and have now plated 37 runs over the last five games (7.4 per game) after tallying just 19 runs over the first eight contests (2.4 per game).
- Sean Manaea** picked up his first win of the season to extend his winning streak against American League Central teams to nine games dating back to Aug. 23, 2016...has a 1.68 ERA (12 er in 64.1 ip) and .183 (42-for-229) opponents batting average during the streak, which spans 10 starts...he struck out seven and did not walk a batter in 6.0 innings in his 100th career appearance and 99th start.
- Jed Lowrie** had his fifth consecutive multiple hit game, which matches the longest such streak of his career (July 5-9, 2014)...drove in a run for the sixth consecutive game, which is one short of his career best (7, Aug. 14-21, 2018).
- Stephen Piscotty** hit his second home run of the season and has homered in back-to-back games...five of his eight hits are for extra bases as he also has three doubles

### DETROIT NOTES

- The Tigers lost the first game of this four-game series with the A's after sweeping a three-game series at Houston to start the week.
- The Tigers issued 12 walks, which are their most in a game since Aug. 10, 2014 at Toronto when they had 14 in a 19-inning game...the last time they walked 12 or more in a nine-inning game was on June 2, 1996 in the second game of a doubleheader at Chicago (AL) when they also had 12.
- Tarik Skubal** made the 11th appearance and 10th start of his career tonight, the first against the A's for the Bay Area native...tossed 4.0 innings for the second consecutive start and matched his career high with four walks.
- Skubal allowed two runs, one earned, and Detroit starters now have a 1.98 ERA (6 er in 27.1 ip) over the last five games...have allowed two earned runs or fewer in each of those five contests.
- Niko Goodrum** hit his first home run of the season...the Tigers now have 20 home runs over the first 13 games...the 20 home runs match the Braves and Reds for the most in the majors.
- Goodrum had his second three-hit game of the season...dating back to the start of the 2020 season, he is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with five doubles, a triple, three home runs and eight RBI against left-handed pitchers.
