ALS AWARENESS DAY: The A's will donate \$150,000 to ALS Therapy Development Institute (ALS TDI), a nonprofit biotech research lab focused on ALS, when the team hosts ALS Awareness Day. Longtime season ticket member Corey Reich, who has ALS, will join a representative from ALS TDI to throw the ceremonial first pitch. During the game, the club will play videos from Stephen Piscotty, whose mother, Gretchen, passed away from ALS on May 6, 2018; ALS TDI's CEO Dr. Steve Perrin; Reich; and A's President Dave Kaval.

ATHLETICS HALL OF FAME: Baseball Hall of Famers Dennis Eckersley, Rollie Fingers, Rickey Henderson, Catfish Hunter, and Reggie Jackson; 1989 World Series MVP Dave Stewart; and former A's owner Charley Finley will be inducted as members into the inaugural class of the Athletics Hall of Fame.
