OUT OF THE GATES

- The Rockies enter their two-game series at Oakland having taken two of three from the Texas Rangers at Globe Life Field, the first games in the ballpark's history.
- The series win was the Rockies' first opening series win since 2017, and their first road series win since taking two of three from San Francisco June 24-26 of last season.
- The Rockies allowed five runs in the series, their fewest ever in an opening series and their fewest in any series since 2018.

TELL ME A STORY

- Trevor Story connected for two home runs in Sunday's 5-2 win, his 15th career multi-home run game ... his 15 multi-homer games passed Dante Bichette for the seventh-most in franchise history, two shy of Andres Galarraga for sixth.
- His 15 multi-homer games are also tied for the fifth-most in the Majors since his debut in 2016 (Khris Davis leads with 20 such games), the most for any National League player.

PENT-UP

The Rockies bullpen has allowed one run in 9.2 innings through the first three games, tied with the Cleveland Indians for the fewest runs allowed.

DATE Vednesday, July

- Daniel Bard made his Rockies debut in Saturday's game, pitching I.I scoreless innings with two hits allowed and one strikeout ... it was his first Major League appearance since April 27, 2013, as a member of the Boston Red Sox.
- Earned the win, his first since May 29, 2012 in a start vs. Detroit.
- Per the Elias Sports Bureau, the eight years, 57 days elapsed between the two wins is the third-longest stretch of time between wins among pitchers who have debuted in the last 50 years (longest: Chin-Hui Tsao, 10 years, 60 days from May 11, 2005-July 10,

THE WHITE AND GREEN

- The Rockies are 16-15 all-time against Oakland, 11-6 in Denver and 5-9 at the Coliseum.
- Colorado swept Oakland in three games the last time the two teams met, July 27-29, 2018 at Coors Field ... the Rockies held the Athletics to four runs in the series.
- Colorado last played at the Coliseum in 2015, dropping two of three games ... have won one of five series all-time in Oakland (a three-game sweep in 2009), losing seven-straight here from June 15, 1997-July 17, 2001.
- The Rockies will host the Athletics at Coors Field Sept. 15-16.

STOP BULLYING IUNIOR

- Nolan Arenado has reached base safely in 21 consecutive games against the American League, batting .392 (31-for-79) with eight doubles, nine home runs and 28 RBI over that span.
- Since 2018, Arenado leads the Majors with 42 Interleague RBI and is tied for the lead with 13 home runs ... his .337 average over that span ranks
- Arenado's 29 Interleague RBI in 2019 were the most in a single-season in Interleague history.

POOL PARTY

- The Rockies announced yesterday that they added RHP Tommy Doyle, RHP Karl Kauffman, C Willie MacIver, LHP Helcris Olivarez, RHP Wes Parsons, INF Aaron Schunk, INF Michael Toglia, INF Ryan Vilade and INF Colton Welker to their 60-man player pool.
- Toglia (No. 3), Vilade (No. 4), Schunk (No. 6) and Welker (No. 7) all rank in the top 10 in MLB Pipeline's list of Rockies Top 10 Prospects.

WHAT'S ONE MOREYEAR

- Hall of Fame outfielder Larry Walker was originally supposed to be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame Sunday in Cooperstown ... due to the pandemic, Walker and the other members of the 2020 Hall of Fame Class will be inducted during 2021 Hall of Fame Weekend, July 23-26, 2021.
- Walker became the first Rockies player elected into the Hall of Fame when he received 76.6% of the vote in his 10th and final year on the ballot.

EVERY PLAY, EVERY DAY

- The Rockies will play 60 games in his pandemicshortened season ... the best 60-game stretch at any point in a season in franchise $\bar{\textbf{h}} istory$ came in 2009 when the club went 42-19 from June 4-Aug. 10 ... outside of 2009, the club's best 60-game run was a 39-21 strech from June 28-Sept. 7, 2018. Per Elias, Carlos González's 27 home runs from
- July 2-Sept. 10, 2015 is the franchise record for home runs in a 60-game stretch ... Larry Walker holds the record for highest batting average in a 60-game stretch, batting .423 from April 2-June 10, 1997 ... Andres Galarraga's 72 RBI from April 9-June 19, 1997 is the record for RBI in 60 games.

PROUD ROCKOS

Yency Almonte, Jairo Díaz, Phillip Diehl, Josh Fuentes, Chi Chi González, Ashton Goudeau and Sam Hilliard are all on the Opening Day roster for the first time in their career.

THINK HE'LL GET THERE?

 Nolan Arenado enters the 2020 season tied with Carlos González for fourth in franchise history with 227 home runs ... Charlie Blackmon's 172 home runs are tied with Andres Galarraga for eighthmost in franchise history ... Arenado's 1,162 career hits are three shy of tying Troy Tulowitzki for the seventh-most in franchise history.

- · A member of the Opening Day roster for the fourth consecutive season after making his debut in 2017.
- · Originally signed by the Rockies as a non-drafted international free agent on July 8, 2011 out of Valencia, Venezuela.

THAT ONE TIME IN ARIZONA. .. AND TEXAS

 Made three Spring Training starts, going 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER), two walks and eight strikeouts ... the figures include his July 22 exhibition start at Texas, in which he allowed three runs on two hits with one walk and three strikeouts over five innings and earned a win.

1901 CLUB

- Will make his 10th career Interleague start (11th appearance) in tonight's series opener at Oakland ... it will be his second career start against the Athletics, his first the Oakland Coliseum.
- Faced the A's on July 28, 2018 in Denver and earned the win after allowing one run on five hits with four walks and six strikeouts over 5.2 innings pitched.
- In his career, Senzatela is 3-4 with a 6.00 ERA (45.0 IP, 30 ER) against the American League ... in four starts (five appearances) at home, he is 3-1 with a 3.97 ERA (22.2 IP, 10 ER), 13 waks and 17 strikeouts, while in American League ballparks he has gone 0-3 with an 8.06 ERA (22.1 IP, 20 ER), 11 walks and 17 strikeouts across five starts.

ROAD TRIP!

- Has made 29 career starts (43 appearances) on the road, combining to go 9-13 with a 5.18 ERA (163.1 IP, 94 ER), 67 walks and 119 strikeouts .. in his 29 road starts, is 8-12 with a 5.49 ERA (144.1 IP, 88 ER), 61 walks and 100 strikeouts.
- Will be looking to snap a five-game losing streak on the road as a starter that began July 5, 2019 at Arizona ... in five road starts over the streak, is 0-5 with a 17.58 ERA (14.1 IP, 28 ER), 10 walks and eight

TOMORROW'S STARTER:

RHP GERMÁN MÁRQUEZ (0-1, 1.59)

The 25-year-old native of San Felix, Venezuela, will make his second start of 2020 after taking the loss in his first career Opening Day start, last Friday at . allowed one run on two hits with three walks and six strikeouts over 5.2 innings of work ... will be making his second career start against the A's, his first in Oakland ... earned the win on July 29, 2018, after holding the Athletics to two runs on five hits with one walk and eight strikeouts over 7.2 innings ... his Opening Day loss was his first ever in Interleague Play, having taken a seven-game Interleague winning streak into that contest to begin his career ... is 7-1 with a 3.20 ERA (101.1 IP, 36 ER), 24 walks and 89 strikeouts in 16 games against the Junior Circuit.

COMFORT

• Has a career home record of 18-9 with a 5.46 ERA (186.1 IP, 113 ER), 67 walks and 128 strikeouts over 41 appearancings, including 29 starts as a starter, is 17-9 in Denver with a 5.42 ERA (164.1 IP, 99 ER) with 59 walks and 110 strikeouts.

WAY BACK WHEN

- Began the 2019 season on the 10-day injured list with a blister infection in his right heel ... was reinstated on April 15 and made 18 starts before being optioned to Triple-A Albuquerque on July 21 ... was recalled a second time on Aug. 25 and finished the season on the active roster ... his 25 total games started were tied for the second-most on the club with Jon Gray (Germán Márquez led the Rockies with 28 starts).
- In 2019, went 11-11 with a 6.71 ERA (124.2 IP, 93 ER), 57 walks and 76 strikeouts.
- The career-high 11 wins across 25 starts tied for the second-most wins on the Rockies ... his 99 runs allowed tied for fourth in the NL, and his 93 earned runs ranked second.

WORM BURNER

- Among starting pitchers with at least 25 starts in 2019, Senzatela's 54.7% ground ball percentage ranked fourth in the Majors, third in the National League ... his .336 opponent batting average on balls in play ranked third in the Majors and the National League.
- Since his debut in 2017, Senzatela's 50.8% ground ball percentage ranks fifth in the National League (min. 300 IP).

COUNTS

• Earned the win on July 14 vs. Cincinnati despite allowing eight runs over 5.1 innings of work ... he became the second pitcher in franchise history to allow at least eight runs and earn a win (also: Brian Bohanon, June 9, 1999 vs. Seattle) ... he was the first pitcher in MLB to win while allowing at least eight runs since Cliff Lee at Texas on March 31, 2014 as a member of the Phillies.

A TASTE

• Made his postseason debut in 2018 ... not figure in the 3-2 loss at Milwaukee in Game I of the NLDS (5.0,3,2,2,1,2,1), his first and only postseason outing ... allowed a two-run homer in the third inning to Christian Yelich.

Silver Slugger winner who has finished top 10 in NL MVP voting each of the last five seasons. Since 2014, leads the Majors in RBI (682), extra-base hits (464) and total bases (1,951) ... ranks fourth in the Majors (first in the NL) with 217 home runs since 2014.

Set career highs in batting average (.315) and OBP (.379) in 2019 ... became the first NL player since Albert Pujols in 2010 to hit at least 40 home runs while striking out fewer than 100 times.
