WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers lost last night, 5-1 on a walkoff grand slam, as the team is still seeking its first win streak of the season...team is 1-3 on this 6 -game, 7 -day initial road trip to SF (1-2) and OAK (0-1) ... Texas has dropped 3 of 4 and 6 of the past 8 G since winning on Opening Day, 7/24 vs. COL...team is now season-low 3 G under .500 for 2 nd time on this trip (also after Sat. loss), needing a win tonight to avoid a new season low point...team has opened at 3-6 for 2nd time in 3 years (also 2018), as this matches team's fewest wins thru 9 G in the past 14 seasons (opened 2-7 in 2006)...need a win tonight to avoid slowest $10-\mathrm{G}$ start since 2006 (3-7)...club has not been at the .500 mark since a 1-1 record after loss on $7 / 25$ vs. COL...team is T3rd place in the A.L. West, season-high 3.0 games behind 1 st place Oakland.

SERIES STUFF: Texas is $0-2-1$ in its 1 st 3 series of the season, 1st time to go without a series win this late into a campaign since 2018 (opened 0-3-1)...have won consecutive series finales to avoid sweeps, and need to win final 2 games of this series to avoid another series loss...last series win came in final series of 2019, taking 2 of 3 from NYY in the last games at Globe Life Park from 9/27-29...TEX was 5-156 in road series in ' 19 , losing final 2 road series since last win from $9 / 5-8$ at BAL (4-0).

ON THE ROAD: Texas has opened with a 1-3 road record in 2020...team began 2019 with records of 1-4 and then 2-9 in away games...this marks 3rd straight year to go winless in 1 st road series ( $0-2-1$ in that span) since taking 2 of 3 in Anaheim to begin the 2017 road slate... Rangers finished 33-48 (.407) on the road in 2019 for a 2nd straight season, T9th in A.L. and T21st in MLB...beg. June 29, team was 15-27 (.357) in final 42 away games in '19, 3rd-lowest win pct. in A.L.

TAKE THE BAY BRIDGE: This is the Rangers' 1st road trip of the season, with a series this past weekend at SF followed by 3 G in Oakland this week...this is the Rangers' 3rd such visit to Northern California (playing Giants/A's back-to-back), the others were from $8 / 20-26 / 18$ and $6 / 4 / 10 / 12 \ldots$...t is the 1 st of those 3 visits in which the 1 st series has been at SF.

VS. OAKLAND: This $3-G$ series marks the 1st of 3 series against the A's in ' 20 , the others taking place in Arlington from 8/24-27 (4 G) and 9/11-13 (3 G)...Rangers won final meeting of last season on 9/22/19 at OAK, which snapped a 7 -game losing streak to the A's...team went 6-13 overall vs. OAK in 2019, including 3-7 at the Coliseum...after last night's loss, Rangers are 7-23 at the Coliseum since the start of 2017, going 0-7-2 in the 9 series here in that span...last series win at this historic facility was when club took 2 of 3 from 9/2325/16 ...OAK leads the all-time series, 379-373, with a 201 176 advantage here at the Coliseum.

- This is the Rangers' 1st series against an A.L. team in 2020, 1st of 3 straight series vs. A.L. West foes...the Rangers played COL/ARI/SF in its 1 st 3 series, becoming the 1st team in MLB history with 3 different opponents in their 1st 3 series and each opponent being from the oppostie league (credit Elias Sports Bureau).

TOUGH FINISH: Last night's walkoff grand slam by Stephen Piscotty handed Texas its 1st overall walkoff defeat since 8/9/19 at MIL, when Eric Thames hit a solo HR off Emmanuel Clase to end it...it was just the 10th walkoff grand slam ever in a Rangers defeat, 1st since 9/16/18 at SD (Francisco Mejia off Jeffrey Springs)... 3 of the 10 walkoff slams have come here at the Coliseum: Piscotty last night, Khris Davis on 5/17/16 (off Shawn Tolleson) and Gene Tenace on 9/14/73 (off Lloyd Allen)...TEX has been the victim of 4 walkoff slams since 2013, 3rd-most in MLB (TB and LAA have 5 losses each).

WHEN I LOOK AT THE TELEVISION: Thursday's game, which will be on FSSW+, will be offered by MLB.TV as a Free Game of the Day"...the game will also air nationally on MLB Network.

LYNN AGAIN: Despite allowing one run over his 1 st 3 starts and 18.1 innings, Lance Lynn has a record of just $1-0$, as he has now missed out on his 1st 2 opportunities at career win no. 100 ...his 1.96 run support avg. is the 5 th-lowest in the A.L., and his lone win came in a 1-0 victory on Opening Day.

Lynn opened the 2020 season with a span of 18.0 consecutive scoreless innings....according to Elias Sports Bureau, it is T2nd-longest scoreless streak to start a season in Rangers history, longest since Jon Matlack's club-record 19.0-inning span to open 1980.

START ME UP: Last night was the 6th qualifying start by a Ranger in '20, with the starter allowing one-or-zero earned runs in 5 of those 6 outings...rotation still has just a single win (Lynn on Opening Day) despite ranking among A.L. leaders in opp. BA (1st, .183), SLG (1st, .268), OPS (1st, .556), and ERA (2nd, 2.72)...starters have an A.L.-low 2.93 run support average ( $\mathrm{RS} / 9$ ).

MEET THE METS: Earlier today, the Rangers announced a trade of RHP Ariel Jurado to the New York Mets in exchange for cash considerations and a player to be named later...Jurado, who has been in the TEX organization for over 8 years, was designated for assignment on July 31 when the Rangers selected 1B Greg Bird and RHP Jimmy Herget from the AIternate Training Site.

HERNÁNDEZ AGAIN: Jonathan Hernández posted 1.2 SHO IP last night, whiffing both batters faced in the 7th to strand an inherited runner and maintain a 1-1 tie at that point...Hernández has a swing-and-miss rate of team-high $35.8 \%$ over his first 5 appearances, the 10th-best figure in the A.L. among pitchers with $25+$ batters faced in ' $20 \ldots$...his 10 relief K's are T4th in both the A.L. and MLB this season.

BIG HITS FOR FLAVA FRAZ: Todd Frazier had the Rangers lone RBI last night on a double in the 6th inning that broke a scoreless tie...it was Frazier's team-high 3rd go-ahead hit this season, all in the club's last 5 contests...the others: 2-run single in 1st on Sat. at SF, solo HR in 4th on Thurs. vs. ARI. Frazier owns 3 of the 9 go-ahead hits by Rangers in ' 20 , and his 4 RBI rank T2nd on the club (8-Gallo, 4-Frazier/Choo).. Frazier's team-high 4 doubles also rank T4th in the A.L.

HITS FOR KINER-FALEFA: Isiah Kiner-Falefa went 2-for-2 with a walk last night, as he now has hits in 4 of the past 5 games at 5 -for-17 (.294)...Kiner-Falefa ranks among team leaders in hits (3rd, 6) and times on base (T4th, 9) despite missing 2 games with a minor hamstring issue...he has gone 3 -for-8 w/ 2 BB against LHP...Kiner-Falefa's 4 hits on this road trip are 2nd-most among Rangers to only Gallo (6).

PUT IT ON THE BOARD?: Last night was the 6th time in 9 games for the Rangers to score one or 2 runs, including all 4 series openers, T2nd-most instances in MLB (8-CLE, 6-TEXI ARI/SEA)... Texas has still yet to be shut out in ' 20 despite the 4th-lowest run total after 9 G in club history ( 17 in 1988, 26 in 1977/1978, 28 in 2020).

SHORTS: On this date in 2014, Colby Lewis posted a CG SHO, blanking the White Sox 16-0 in the largest shutout in Rangers history...TEX went homerless last night after hitting HR in 6 straight...club is 8 -for-last-8 in steal attempts since lone CS on $7 / 25$ vs. COL.

## TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER <br> \#44 Kyle Gibson, RHP <br> (0-1, 0.00)

TONIGHT: The 32 -year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 2 nd start of the season in the middle tilt of this 3 -game set against the Athletics...will be working on extended 7 days' rest due to a pair of off days, as he last worked and took a tough-luck loss in his Texas debut on $7 / 28$ vs. ARI (5.0 IP, 3 R-0 ER), a 4-1 Rangers defeat...finished 1-1, 4.50 ( 5 ER/10.0 IP) in 3 collective "Spring Training" starts, with the 1st 2 taking place in Arizona before the original camp was halted...final outing was exhibition on $7 / 21$ vs. COL (L, 5.0 IP, 5 R-ER) - the 1 st ever baseball game at Globe Life Field...posted a 3.00 ERA ( 6 R-5 ER/15.0 IP) over 3 Summer Camp starts against his teammates, all at GLF...signed a 3 -year contract thru 2022 on 12/6/19 after spending the 1st 10 years of his pro career in the Minnesota organization...tied a career high with 13 wins for the A.L. Central Division champion Twins last season despite being bothered much of the season by an ulcerative colitis condition...won 65 games for the Twins over the last 6 seasons with 10 -or-more victories 5 times in that span and has recorded 6 consecutive years of 25 -or-more starts...is one of 7 A.L. pitchers to post at least 510 -win seasons from 2014-19...joined Jake Odorizzi, Rick Porcello, and Chris Sale as the only A.L. pitchers with $25+$ starts in each of last 6 seasons...was Minnesota's 2015 pitcher of the year...selected by the Twins in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2009 June draft out of the University of Missouri.

LAST START: Will be working on extended 7 days' rest due to a pair of off days, as he last worked and took a tough-luck loss in his Texas debut on $7 / 28$ vs. ARI ( 5.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R-0 ER, 3 BB, 4 SO, 93 pitches/ 55 strikes), a 4-1 Rangers defeat... all 3 runs allowed were unearned due to a throwing error by 3 B Isiah Kiner-Falefa in the 1st inning...marked just the 3rd time in his career to allow 3 UER (last $5 / 3 / 19$ at NYY, 5 R-2 ER in 5.0 IP)...did not permit an extra-base hit...the last Ranger starter to take a loss when 3+ UER accounted for only runs allowed?: Colby Lewis on 10/1/16 vs. TB ( 6.1 IP, 4 R-0 ER).

SPRING TRAINING/SUMMER CAMP: Finished 1-1, 4.50 ( 5 ER/10.0 IP) in 3 collective "Spring Training" starts, with the 1 st 2 taking place in Arizona before the original camp was halted...final outing was exhibition on $7 / 21 \mathrm{vs}$. COL (L, 5.0 IP, 5 R-ER) - the 1st ever baseball game at Globe Life Field...opponents went 8 -for- 38 (.211) in those games...posted a 3.00 ERA (6 R-5 ER/15.0 IP) over 3 Summer Camp starts against his teammates, all at GLF.

OAKLAND: Has gone $3-2$ with a 3.82 ERA ( $15 \mathrm{ER} / 35.1$ IP) in $6 \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{GS}$ career vs. Oakland, incl. 1-1, 3.93 ( $8 \mathrm{ER} / 18.1 \mathrm{IP}$ ) in $3 \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{GS}$ at the Coliseum....has quality starts in 3 straight against A's since the start of 2018, going 1-0, 2.03 (3 ER/13.1 IP) in those games.

Minnesota won both Gibson starts against A's last season: 7/3/19 at the Coliseum (ND, 6.0 IP, 3 R-2 ER) and 7/18/19 at Target Field (W, 7.0 IP, 3 R-ER)...opposed Mike Fiers in both outings.

ON THE ROAD: Gibson is making his 1st road start of the season...owns a slightly lower career ERA on the road (4.33) compared to home (4.67)...went 5-3, 4.35 (35 ER/72.1 IP) w/ 23 BB/81 SO in $17 \mathrm{G} / 13$ GS away from Minnesota last season, with opponents slashing .303/.358/.490/.848...Twins went 9-4 in his 13 starts.

2019: In final season with Minnesota ranked 3rd on the staff in wins (13), innings (160.0), strikeouts (160), and starts (29-tied)...set career bests for wins (tied), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (9.00), strikeouts per walk (2.86), and swing-andmiss percentage ( $29.5 \%$ )...his 52.9 groundball percentage ranked 6th in MLB among pitchers with at least 150.0 innings pitched, trailing only OAK's Brett Anderson ( $55.5 \%$ ) in the A.L....had the league's 14th best winning percentage at career-best .650...was 13-7, 4.89 ( $84 \mathrm{ER} / 154.2 \mathrm{IP}$ ) in 29 starts with a 3.38 ERA ( $2 \mathrm{ER} / 5.1 \mathrm{IP}$ ) in 1st 5 MLB relief appearances...his 1st 174 big league outings were starts before working in relief on $6 / 25 / 19$ vs. TB, pitching 17 th inning of 18-inning Twins loss.
