## TODAY'S MEDIA SCHEDULE

 Astros pregame availabilities will be from 12:151:30 p.m. CT.TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Athletics will continue their rivalry today for the finale of three games over the weekend between the two top teams in the AL West...Houston enters today looking to snap a couple streaks, their four-game losing streak and the A's eight-game winning streak...to turn the tides, the Astros will send out RHP Cristian Javier for his third Major League start and first against the A's and fellow rookie LHP Jesús Luzardo.

ABOUT JAVIER: Today's Astros starter RHP Cristian Javier, the club's 2019 Minor League Pitcher of the Year, has translated last season's success into the Majors in 2020 as he's allowed just one earned run in each of his first two starts with the Astros...an international signing by the Astros out of the Dominican Republic in 2015, Javier currently checks in as the club's No. 6 prospect per MLB.com.

FREE COVID TESTING AT MMP: Texas Governor Greg Abbott, the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) and the Astros have teamed up to open a free COVID-19 testing site at Minute Maid Park in Houston...the tests will be distributed from Minute Maid Park's Lot C everyday from 8 a.m.-7 p.m. seven days a week....below are the full details:

Testing will be free to all patients as all fees are covered by the state.
The site will feature eight drive-thru testing lanes and four walk-up testing lanes.
The testing site will have capacity to handle up to 2,000 tests per day.
With contact-free testing, all patients will administer their own painless, oral test swab and collection.

- Spanish-speaking staff will be available at the site.
- Patients will be notified of test results within 72-96 hours or sooner.
No healthcare provider is required for test administration.
Appointments can be booked online at Texas.curativeinc.com, but walkups will also be accommodated.

IN THE DUGOUT: Astros Manager Dusty Baker, who managed career game number 3,500 on Opening Day, was named the 19th manager in franchise history on Jan. 29 in what is his fifth managerial position in his storied career...he currently ranks 15th all time in managerial wins with 1,869 , immediately trailing Hall of Famer Bill McKechnie $(1,896)$ on that all-time list.

## YESTERDAY'S PITCHER'S DUEL: The Astros

 and A's played a close ballgame yesterday with the A's eking out a 3-1 victory...it was an old fashioned pitcher's duel between Astros starter LHP Framber Valdez (1ER) and A's starter RHP Frankie Montas ( $0 E R$ ), with both starters pitching through the 7th... the Astros scored their only run in the 9th on an RBI single by 3B Alex Bregman...1B Yuli Gurriel picked up two hits, including a double.ON BASE BREGS: 3B Alex Bregman has reached base safely in 46 consecutive road games and is 10 games from tying his own franchise record for this, a 56-game streak set in the 2018 season.

## SPRINGER UPDATE: OF George Springer exited

 Thursday's game with a right wrist strain, injured on a diving catch in center field...Springer has not played the last two games and is considered day-to-day.PLUG AND PLAY: Despite injuries and limited MLB experience on the Astros pitching staff, the club has combined for a 3.98 ERA (59ER/133.1IP), with the bullpen posting a 3.48 ERA (25ER/64.2IP)...the Astros 15 -man pitching staff currently includes 10 rookie pitchers, with Astros rookies combining for a remarkable 2.37 ERA (18ER/68.1IP).

TAYLOR TERRIFIC: LHP Blake Taylor has began his career with six scoreless appearances, tossing 8.2 innings and allowing just five hits with 10 strikeouts... acquired in the OF Jake Marisnick trade with the Mets this offseason, Taylor made the club out of camp despite spending most of his time in 2019 at Class A... in his short Astros career, Taylor remains scoreless, even when counting the seven appearances he made in Spring Training and Summer Camp (0ER/8IP).
