TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and A's meet for the final game of this three-game series...the Giants enter today having lost 10 of their last 13 games while the A's have won 12 of their last 14.

ON THE MOUND: RHP Logan Webb will make his fifth start of the season today...he's faced the A's once in his career, tossing 4.2 innings and allowing four runs on six hits last August 25 at Oakland in what was just his second career big league start...Webb has been able to get out of trouble in 2020 by limiting opponent hits with runners on base (see chart).

IN NEED OF A WIN: The Giants need a win today to avoid being swept by Oakland in a series of three-or-more games for the first time since June 17-19, 2011 at Oakland...SF hasn't been swept in a series of three-or-more games to the A's in San Francisco since June 13-15, 2008.

WITH RISP: Giants pitchers have held A's batters to just two hits in 19 at-bats with runners in scoring position in this series...however, those two hits are the Stephen Piscotty game-tying game slam in the 9th inning on Friday night and Mark Canha's three-run homer in the 9th yesterday.

RUNS AT HOME: Through their first eight home games, the Giants are averaging 6.38 runs per game here at Oracle Park...that's the third-most runs/game at home among MLB teams behind the Yankees (7.63 r/gm) and Blue Jays (7.00).

MAKE IT 17 GAMES: IF Donovan Solano went 1-for-4 yesterday to extend his career-best hitting streak to 17 games, the longest active streak in the big leagues and the longest by a Giant since Angel Pagan hit safely in 19-straight from July 31-August 23, 2016.

TOO MANY LONGBALLS: SF pitchers have allowed 36 home runs this year, the second-most in the Majors behind the Diamondbacks (45)...the Giants have allowed a home run in 18-consecutive games, the longest such streak in franchise history (*Stats, LLC*).

TOUGH LOSS: Friday night's 8-7 Giants loss was their first loss after leading by five or more runs in the 9th inning or later since June 25, 1929 vs. Brooklyn (led 10-5, lost 12-10 in 10 innings)...according to Stats, LLC, the Giants had won their last 2,133 games when leading by five-plus runs in the 9th or later before last night, the longest such streak in the modern era.

ON DECK: Following today's game the Giants will embark on a brief two-game road trip to Los Angeles-AL before returning home on Wednesday for the start of an eight game homestand...the Giants are 19-12 all-time against the Angels.

GIANTS FAN CUTOUTS: The Giants returned home Friday night to an additional 5,459 fan cutouts at Oracle Park that were installed this week, bringing the total number of fan cutouts to 10,205.

BALLDUDE & BALLDUDETTE: The Giants installed Balldude/Balldudette Cutouts that are secured against the wall near the 1st and 3rd baseline spots and will feature many of our regular Balldudes and Balldudettes...each cutout will be a \$300 donation toward the Giants Community Fund & Junior Giants program...for more info on how to be a Balldude this season, visit jrgiants.org.

Mike Yastrzemski continued his excellent rookie season for the Giants with the first three-homer game of his career, coming in a 10 - 9 win over the Diamondbacks. The two teams combine to hit 12 homers, one shy of the MLB record.

MANAGER GABE KAPLER

- Is in his first season as the skipper of the Giants after being
- named the 39th manager in club history on November 12, 2019.

 Spent the 2018 and 2019 seasons as the skipper of the Philadelphia Phillies, going 161-163 (.497) in his two seasons.
- ▶ The 2020 campaign marks his fourth season managing and his third at the Major League level...he managed Class A Greenville in the Boston Red Sox organization in 2007.
- Prior to joining the Phillies, Kapler was the Director of Player Development for the Dodgers from November 2014 until being hired by Philadelphia in October 2017.
- ▶ From 2015-2017, the three seasons Kapler was at the helm of the Dodgers Player Development, the Dodgers minor league affiliates went a combined 1,299-1,128 (.535)...the .535 winning pct. was fourth-best among MLB teams in that time
- ► Had a 12-year career as a player from 1998-2010, suiting up for Detroit (1998-99), Texas (2000-02), Colorado (2002), Boston (2003-06), Milwaukee (2008) and Tampa Bay (2009-10)...a former 57th-round pick in 1995, Kapler hit .268 over his 1,104 career games.

TODAY'S OUTING: Will make his fifth start of the 2020 campaign and his second career outing vs. the Athletics.

LAST TIME OUT: Turned in the second-shortest start of his young Major League career on Wednesday night in Houston in the Giants 6-4 loss...worked 3.1 innings and allowed five runs (two earned) with three strikeouts while throwing 81 pitches...in Webb's 3.1 innings on the hill, the Giants defense committed three errors (two throwing and one catcher's interference)

NICE RUN: Dating back to the end of 2019, Webb is 2-2 with a 3.00 ERA (11er, 33.0ip) with 28 strikeouts and a .236 opponent's batting average against in his last seven starts...the Giants are 5-2 in those seven contests.

WHEN THE GOING GETS TOUGH: Webb has done especially well at limiting damage during high leverage situations in 2020...with RISP, opponents are just 3-for-14 this year...with RISP and two outs, they've gone 0-for-5.

2019 SEASON: Went 2-3 with a 5.22 ERA (23er, 39.2ip) in eight starts for SF last season...earned the win in his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona, tossing 5.0 innings and allowing two runs (one earned) with seven strikeouts...over his final three starts, he was 1-1 with a 3.18 ERA (6er, 17.0ip) and held opposing hitters to a .183 average with 15 strikeouts.

ON-FIELD RULES

DH RULE: National League games will include the use of the designated hitter for the first time in history.

EXTRA-INNINGS: An extra-innings rule will begin each extra inning with a runner on second base. The batter (or a substitute for the batter) who leads off an inning shall continue to be the batter who would lead off the inning in the absence of this extra-innings rule.

EXTRA-INNINGS PART TWO: The runner placed on second base at the start of each half-inning shall be the player (or a substitute for such player) in the batting order immediately preceding that half-inning's leadoff hitter. By way of example, if the number five hitter in the batting order is due to lead off the tenth inning, the number four player in the batting order (or a pinchrunner for such player) shall begin the inning on second base. However, if the player in the batting order immediately preceding that half-inning's leadoff hitter is the pitcher, the runner placed on second base at the start of that half-inning may be the player preceding the pitcher in the batting order. Any runner or batter removed from the game for a substitute shall be ineligible to return to the game, as is the case in all circumstances under the OBR.

FOR THE ERA: For purposes of calculating earned runs, the runner who begins an inning on second base pursuant to this rule shall be deemed to be a runner who has reached second base because of a fielding error, but no error shall be charged to the opposing team or to any player.

THREE-BATTER MINIMUM: The new three-batter minimum rule will require the starting or any relief pitcher to pitch to a minimum of three batters, including the batter then at bat (or any substitute batter), until such batters are put out or reach base, or until the offensive team is put out, unless the substitute pitcher sustains injury or illness.

SUSPENDED GAMES: If weather forces a game to be cut short before it becomes official, it will be contineed where it left off at a later date rather than started from scratch.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE: Prohibitions against unsportsmanlike conduct will be strictly enforced to prevent unnecessary physical contact and support physical distancing between individuals on the playing field. In this respect, players and managers should maintain physical distancing from all umpires and opposing players on the playing field whenever possible. Players or managers who leave their positions to argue with umpires, come within six feet of an umpire or opposing player or manager for the purpose of argument, or engage in altercations on the field are subject to immediate ejection and discipline, including fines and suspensions.

EXPANDED POSTSEASON: MLB announced the 2020 Postseason will expand to 16 teams, beginning with eight best-of-three Wild Card Series preceding the Division Series... the higher seeded team will host all three games, which will cut down on travel....the first round will be best-of-3, followed by best-of-5 and best-of-7 rounds in the LCS & World Series.

PROCEDURES FOR HEALTH & SAFETY

NO SPITTING: Spitting is prohibited (including but not limited to, saliva, sunflower seeds or peanut shells, or tobacco) at all times in Club facilities (including on the field). Chewing gum is permitted.

FOR PITCHERS: Pitchers may carry a small wet rag in their back pocket to be used for moisture in lieu of licking their fingers.

LARGER DUGOUT: Clubs must provide expanded dugout and bullpen space at their ballparks.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING: Players, umpires, and other onfield personnel should practice physical distancing to the extent possible within the limitations of competition and the fundamentals of baseball. Examples of ways in which physical distancing can be incorporated without disrupting the basics of the game include:

- ▶ When the ball is out of play, fielders are encouraged to retreat several steps away from the baserunner.
- If the batter is in the batter's box and the catcher needs to stand to relay signs to the infielders, the catcher can step onto the grass towards the mound to give the signs before assuming his position behind home plate.
- First and Third Base Coaches should remain in or behind the Coach's Box and shall not approach a baserunner, fielder or umpire on-field.
- ▶ Players on opposite teams should not socialize, fraternize, or come within six feet of each other before the game, during warmups, in between innings, or after the game.
- ▶ There will be no pregame exchange of lineup cards. Instead, each Club will input their lineup card into a mobile application provided by MLB.

WEAR A MASK!: All non-playing personnel must wear face coverings at all times in the dugout and bullpen.

GOING THROUGH A LOT OF BASEBALLS: Any baseball that is put in play and touched by multiple players shall be removed and exchanged for a new baseball. After an out, players are strongly discouraged from throwing the ball around the infield.

NEW SAFEY PROTOCOLS: MLB and and the players association (MLBPA)agreed to new safety protocols designed to reduce the risk of additional outbreaks within the game:

- ▶ Players and staff must wear face coverings that cover the mouth and the nose at all times while at the ballpark other than while on the field of play itself. This new mandate includes the dugout and bullpen.
- In order to minimize time spent together indoors, home teams must provide outdoor covered spaces for the visiting team. Home teams must also provide appropriate spaces that allow for social distancing during rain delays.
- ▶ Traveling parties must be reduced to absolutely essential personnel.
- ▶ Players and team personnel must wear face coverings at all times at team hotels other than in each person's individual hotel room.
- A member of a road team, whether player or staff, must inform the team compliance officer if he or she wishes to leave the team hotel for any reason.
- ▶ Home team players and staff members are now prohibited from going to bars, lounges, malls or other places in which larger groups gather.

REVISED PROCEDURES FOR TRANSACTIONS

ROSTERS: MLB rosters were reduced from 30 players to 28 starting yesterday and will remain at that number for the rest of the regular season and postseason.

TAXI SQUAD: A Club is permitted to carry up to five additional Taxi Squad players from its Club Player Pool on all road trips with the Major League team. If the Club elects to carry five additional players, at least one must be a player whose designated position prior to the season is catcher. Players on the Taxi Squad are permitted to workout with the Major League Club but are not permitted to be in uniform and in the dugout during games. Upon the conclusion of each road trip, players on the Taxi Squad will return to the Alternate Training Site.

TRADE DEADLINE: Aug. 31 will be the 2020 Trade Deadline and Sept. 15 will be the 2020 Postseason eligibility deadline.

THE IL: Standard Injured List placements will be for either 10 days or 45 days, with the latter replacing 60. A COVID-19 Related Injured List will allow for placements that will not require a confirmed positive test for COVID-19. A player may be placed on the COVID-19 Related IL based on a positive test for COVID-19, confirmed exposure to COVID-19, or if a player exhibits symptoms requiring self-isolation for further assessment.
