- ♦ The bears are wearing jerseys from the D-backs Youth Jersey Program, which outfits 121 Little Leagues and 65,000 players and coaches throughout Arizona.
- ◆ For every Chase Big Fly homer in the Teddy Bear section, the D-backs and Chase will add \$1,000 to the Play Ball Fund, which is devoted to youth sports in Arizona.

HERE'S THE STORY: Arizona has won 4 consecutive games and is 8-3 in its last 11.

- With a win tonight, the D-backs will boast a winning record for the first time this season.
- ♦ Arizona has scored 5+ runs in 7 straight games, its longest streak since an 8-game stretch from Aug. 27-Sept. 4, 2017.
- ◆ Zac Gallen looks to extend his NL record by allowing 3 or fewer earned runs in each of his first 19 career games (all starts).
- ◆ Starling Marte has a 6-game hitting streak (.357; 10-for-28) and is batting .400 (18-for-45) in his last 11 games.
- ◆ Eduardo Escobar has reached base safely in 8 of his last 12 plate appearances (4 hits and 4 walks) dating back to his seventh-inning single on Aug. 12 @ Rockies.
- ♦ Ketel Marte is hitting .423 (11-for-26) in his last 6 games.

WELCOME BACK TO CHASE FIELD: The D-backs are hosting the A's for the first time since Aug. 28-30, 2015.

 ◆ Arizona is 7-8 all-time vs. Oakland @ Chase Field, winning 6 of the last 8 matchups.

TOUCHING ALL THE BASES

D-BACKS ACCEPTING SUBMISSIONS FOR \$100,000 SCHOOL CHALLENGE: The Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation is now accepting applications for the \$100,000 School Challenge, presented by University of Phoenix, to benefit schools across the state of Arizona. The program is open to all Arizona public, private, and nonprofit charter schools, Grades K-12, and teachers and administrators are encouraged to "make their best pitch" on why they deserve to receive this important funding by submitting an application online at dbacks. com/schoolchallenge by Sept. 30.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game, the D-backs recalled INF **Kevin Cron** and RHP **Yoan López** from the Alternate Training Site.

♦ Following last night's game, the D-backs optioned RHP **Joel Payamps** and INF **Andy Young** to the Alternate Training Site.

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: Arizona has won 12 of its last 16 games vs. AL opponents and is 17-8 (.680) since 2019.

- ♦ The D-backs .680 interleague winning pct. is the second best in the Majors during that span behind only the Mets (.708; 17-7).
- BEST INTERLEAGE WIN PCT SINCE 2019: .708 Mets (17-7); .680 - D-backs (17-8); .667 - Rays (16-8); .654 - Cubs (17-9); .621 - Yankees (18-11).

GOING BATTY: The D-backs are hitting .305 over their last 11 games after batting .194 in their first 11.

- ♦ Did not factor in the decision in his last start on Aug. 12 @ Rockies (4 ER in 3.1 IP).
- ♦ 14 of 18 runs allowed have come after the third inning.

• Is 2 shy of the MLB record set by Aaron Sele/Red Sox from June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994.

VS. A'S: First career start.

• INTERLEAGUE: In 3 career starts, is 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA (4 ER in 20.0 IP), .176 opp. average and 23 strikeouts.

SINCE BECOMING A D-BACK: In 12 starts since his D-backs debut on Aug. 7, 2019, is 2-3 with a 2.84 ERA (21 ER in 66.2 IP), .231 opp. average and 81 strikeouts (10.94 K/9.0 IP)...team is 8-4.

• In 7 home starts as a D-back (team is 6-1), has a .197 opp. average, 15 walks and 48 strikeouts.

LIMITED FREE PASSES: Did not issue a walk in his last start and has issued 2 walks in his last 3 starts.

RACKING UP K'S: His 11.24 strikeouts per 9.0 innings (72 K in 57.2 IP, 10 GS) since Aug. 19, 2019 is seventh among NL pitchers (min. 10 GS)...teammate Robbie Ray is fourth at 12.30 K/9.0 IP (77 K in 56.1 IP).

SINCE JUNE 20, 2019: His 2.81 ERA since last June 20 is ninth in the Majors (min. 50.0 IP), just behind Mike Clevinger/CLE (2.79) and Patrick Corbin/WSH (2.60).

WITH RUNNERS ON BASE: For his career, has held opponents to a .192 average (29-for-151) with 20 walks and 54 strikeouts. • **RISP IN 2020:** Has held opponents to 2 hits in 19 at-bats (.105) with 2 RBI, 2 walks and 6 strikeouts.

TOP OF THE ORDER IN 2020: Has held Hitters 1-4 to a .220 average (9-for-41).
