HERE'S THE STORY: Arizona has won 5 consecutive games and is 9-3 in its last 12.

- With a win today, the D-backs will achieve their first undefeated homestand since Aug. 25-31, 2017 (6 games: 3 vs. Giants and Dodgers) [min. 4 games].
- ♦ The D-backs are 7-2 in their last 9 home games vs. A's.
- ◆ Starling Marte has a 7-game hitting streak (.355; 11-for-31) and is batting .396 (19-for-48) in his last 12 games.
- ◆ Eduardo Escobar has reached base safely in 9 of his last 16 plate appearances (5 hits and 4 walks) dating back to his seventh-inning single on Aug. 12 @ Rockies.

YOU ALWAYS REMEMBER YOUR FIRST: Luke Weaver, who is making his second career start vs. A's, earned his first Major League win against Oakland on Aug. 26, 2016 @ Busch Stadium (1 ER in 6.0 IP).

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: Arizona has won 13 of its last 17 games vs. AL opponents and is 18-8 (.692) since 2019.

- ◆ The D-backs .692 interleague winning pct. is the second best in the Majors during that span behind only the Mets (.708; 17-7).
 - BEST INTERLEAGE WIN PCT SINCE 2019: .708 Mets (17-7); .692 - D-backs (18-8); .667 - Rays (16-8); .654 - Cubs (17-9); .621 - Yankees (18-11).

1-RUN WINS: The D-backs are 6-1 in 1-run games, the best winning pct. (.857) in baseball, ahead of the Brewers (.833; 5-1) and Tigers (.800; 4-1).

5.0-INNING NO-HIT DUO: Robbie Ray (Sunday - 5.0 IP) and **Zac Gallen** (Monday - 5.0 IP) became the first D-backs starters with 5.0+ no-hit innings to begin back-to-back games since June 12-13, 2015 @ Giants (Chase Anderson and Allen Webster) [source: Sportradar].

 Surrendered home runs to Nolan Arenado (solo) and Ryan McMahon (3-run).

PART OF THE PLAN: Threw only 3.0 innings on Aug. 12 @ Padres and 3.1 innings in his last start - by design.

- Missed most of the last 4 months of 2019 with right forearm tightness.
- 14 of 18 runs allowed have come after the third inning.
