HERE'S THE STORY: Arizona has won 6 consecutive games and is 10-3 in its last 13.

- ♦ The D-backs are 8-2 in their last 10 games in AL parks.
- Merrill Kelly brings an 11.2-inning scoreless streak into tonight's game.
- ◆ Starling Marte has an 8-game hitting streak (.382; 13-for-34) and is batting .412 (21-for-51) in his last 13 games.
- ♦ Eduardo Escobar has reached base safely in 10 of his last 19 plate appearances (5 hits and 5 walks) dating back to his seventh-inning single on Aug. 12 @ Rockies.
- ◆ David Peralta is batting .407 (22-for-54) with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers and 13 RBI in his last 14 games.

SPOTLESS AT HOME: The D-backs are coming off their first undefeated homestand (5-0) since Aug. 25-31, 2017 (6 games: 3 vs. Giants and Dodgers) [min. 4 games].

LET'S GO STREAKING!: The D-backs' 6-game winning streak is their longest since Aug. 25-31, 2019 (also: 6).

♦ Arizona's last 7-game winning streak was during the club record 13-game stretch from Aug. 24-Sept. 6, 2017.

VOGT RETURNS TO THE BAY AREA: Stephen Vogt returns to the Bay Area after spending parts of 6 seasons with Oakland (2013-17) and San Francisco (2019).

- Vogt was traded from the Rays to the A's in 2013 for cash considerations, and was named to a pair of AL All-Star Teams (2015-16).
- He signed with the Giants as a Minor League free agent in Feb. 2019 and appeared in 99 games and hit 10 homers with 40 RBI.

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: Arizona has won 14 of its last 18 games vs. AL opponents and is 19-8 (.704) since 2019.

- ◆ The D-backs' .704 interleague winning pct. is the second best in the Majors during that span behind only the Mets (.708; 17-7).
 - BEST INTERLEAGE WIN PCT SINCE 2019: .708 Mets (17-7);
 .704 D-backs (19-8); .667 Rays (16-8); .654 Cubs (17-9);
 .630 Dodgers (17-10).

MAKE SURE YOU STAY TUNED UNTIL THE END: The D-backs lead the Majors with 54 runs after the sixth inning, 3 more than the A's (51).

 Only 5 of the combined 18 runs scored in the 2-game series @ Chase Field came after the sixth inning.

TOUCHING ALL THE BASES

1-RUN WINS: The D-backs are 6-1 in 1-run games, the best winning pct. (.857) in baseball, ahead of the Tigers (.800; 4-1) and Rangers (.750; 3-1).

GOING BATTY: The D-backs are hitting .305 over their last 13 games after batting .194 in their first 11.

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Arizona is batting .384 (38-for-99) with runners in scoring position in its last 8 games and leads all of baseball with a .325 average (68-for-209) overall.

START ME UP: D-backs starters are 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA (4 ER in 28.0 IP) and a .134 opponent average in their last 5 games.

SEPTEMBER IN SPANISH: Yesterday, FOX Sports Arizona announced that they will televise all D-backs games in September in Spanish on FOX Sports Arizona Plus.

- Rays' eighth-round pick in the 2010 draft.

KELLY LATELY: Has gone 7-2 with a 1.97 ERA (13 ER in 59.1 IP) and a 0.98 WHIP in his last 9 starts dating back to 2019.

- Boasts an 11.2-scoreless inning streak.
- Is 2-0 with a 1.32 ERA (2 ER in 13.2 IP) in 2 road starts and 3-0 with a 0.87 ERA (2 ER in 20.2 IP) including his final road start of 2019 (Sept. 20, 2019 @ Padres; 0 ER in 7.0 IP).

LAST START: Won his second straight start on Aug. 14 vs. Padres, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings.

VS. A'S: Will be making his first career start vs. Oakland.

NL RANKINGS: Ranks among NL leaders in fewest walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 1.03), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3rd, 7.33), wins (T-3rd, 3), ERA (4th, 1.71), WHIP (8th, 0.91).

 Led Major League rookies in strikeouts...was the second D-back rookie to lead the Majors in strikeouts (also: Brandon Webb in 2003).
