WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers beat the A's last night, $3-2$, snapping a season-long $8-\mathrm{G}$ losing streak...team is $1-0$ on this 7 -day, 7 -game homestand against OAK (1-0) and LAD ( 3 G )...club has 1-8 in last 9 G after going 7-1 from 8/7-15...at 11-17 (.393), team has 5th-lowest win pct. in the A.L. and 6th-lowest in MLB...the 17 losses rank T5th-most in A.L./MLB....the 11-17 start matches fewest wins through 28 G in the past 12 seasons beg. 2009 (also 11-17 in 201718), as club opened 2008 with a 10-18 mark...TEX dropped a season-high 8 straight from $8 / 16-23$, one of the 3 longest slides in MLB in 2020 ( 9 G by BOS, $8 / 10-18$; and DET, $8 / 11$ 20)...only other TEX drought of $8+G$ since start of 2015 was 0-8 span from 7/13-22/19...team had season-best 4-G win streak from 8/11-15, which was longest winning span since a 4-G sweep from 9/5-8/19 at BAL...team had a 10-9 record after win on $8 / 15$ at COL, just 2nd time with a winning record all season (also 1-0 after Opening Day win vs. COL)...team was season-high 7 G under .500 after loss Sun. at SEA.

IN THE STANDINGS: With last night's win over 1st-place Oakland, Texas gained ground in the standings for the 1st time since a win on $8 / 11$ vs. SEA, a drought of 14 days without shaving division deficit...team is in 3rd place, 8.0 GB of OAK after a season-high 9.0-game deficit following loss on Sun. at SEA...club has been in 3rd in each of the last 9 days after spending previous 5 days in 2nd place.

SERIES STUFF: Rangers have lost 3 consecutive series vs SD (0-2), at SD (0-2), and at SEA (0-3), counting for 3 of the 4 instances in which TEX has lost all games of a series in 2020 (also 0-3 from 8/4-6 at OAK)...club is $3-6-1$ overall in series in '20...1st time to lose 3 straight series since going $0-4-0$ from 9/13-26/19...current drought was preceded by 3 straight series wins from 8/7-16, 1st time to win 3 in a row since 5/14-22/19.

- Last night was the Rangers' 4th win in a series opener and club has won each of last 2 series after taking the series opener ( $3-0$ from 8/7-9 vs. LAA; 2-1 from 8/14-16 at COL) - TEX is 2-2-1 in home series this season, going 2-1-1 in las 4 series at Globe Life Field entering this homestand.

AT HOME: Texas has gone 3-2 in last 5 home games and won 7 of last 10 in Arlington...current 7-3 span comes after a 1-3 start at the new Globe Life Field, as club's 8-6 (.571) home mark ranks T6th in the A.L...the 8 home wins rank 6th in the A.L...team has a - 10 run diff. at home ( $50-60$ ) and a -35 mark on the road (54-89),

- Rangers are 6-1 at home vs. A.L. West clubs, joining OAK (11-2) and $\mathrm{HOU}(7-1)$ as division foes with winning home records against West clubs in '20.

THE SWINGIN' A'S: The Rangers are hosting the A's for 7 games in a span of 21 days here at GLF from 8/24-9/13, wrapping up the season series...TEX is 1-3 vs. OAK, losing all 3 G at the Coliseum from 8/4-6...Rangers are 2-10 in last 12 G vs. A's dating to 2019, the wins coming last night and $9 / 22 / 19$ at OAK...since the start of 2018, TEX is 13-29 (.310) vs. the A's, 2nd-lowest win pct. against any A.L. opponent in that span (4-10, . 286 vs. BOS)...in Arlington, team has lost 4 of 5 and 10 of last 14 dating back to 2018.

QUALITY CHECK: Last night was the 3rd time in 2020 that Texas has pinned a loss on an opposing starting pitcher despite that pitcher posting a quality start...other 2 instances: $2-0$ win on $8 / 8$ vs. LAA (Patrick Sandoval) and $6-4$ win on 8/15 at COL (German Marquez)...the 3 instances match the 2nd-most by any MLB team in 2020, as only other clubs to do it 3 -or-more times are MIN (4) and CHC (3).

HOLDING THE RESERVATION: Both teams scored in each of the 1 st 2 innings last night, but there were no runs over the final 7 frames...it marked the 1st Texas victory when scoring in each of the 1st 2 innings - and not scoring for the rest of the game - since 7/8/18 at DET, a 3-0 triumph in which starte Austin Bibens-Dirkx ( 5.1 IP ) earned the win.

COUNTRY BOY CAN SURVIVE: Lance Lynn recorded his eam-high 4th win last night, T3rd-most in the A.L...after his 3rd straight quality start last night, Lynn ranks among A.L leaders in ERA (2nd, 1.59), strikeouts (2nd, 50), opp. BA (2nd, .156), WHIP (3rd, 0.86), opp. OPS (3rd, .510), and opp OBP (3rd, .229)...OAK batters went 2-for-last-17 after Stephen Piscotty's solo HR in the 2nd inning.

- Lynn is the 1st pitcher in Rangers history to open a season with 7 straight starts of allowing 2 runs-or-less, also longest span in 2020...according to bb-reference's Stathead site, the only other MLB pitchers in the modern era (since 1901) to open a season with 7 straight starts of 2 R-or-less and $6+$ SO before Lynn?: NYM's Johan Santana in 2009 (7) and BOS Roger Clemens in 1991 (7).

WINNING FORMULA: Since Rafael Montero's season debut on Aug. 7, 7 of the Rangers' last 8 wins have been finshed with some combination of Jonathan Hernández and or Montero on the mound...the lone exception in that span was Lance Lynn's CG on $8 / 14$ at COL...of those 7 wins in which the bullpen has appeared since $8 / 7$, the finishing duo of Hernández/Montero (in that order) has been used in 4 straight and 5 of last 7 wins overall...the Rangers have yet to lose a game (or even lose a lead) in any contest in which Hernández or Montero has entered with Texas in front.

HAD IT ALL THE WAY: Last night marked just the 2nd time since the start of 2018 for a one-run Texas win to end on a bases-loaded plate appearance for the final out...Matt Chap man flied out with the bases loaded last night to end a 3-2 Rangers win...the only similar ending in the past 3 seasons (beg. 2018) came on $4 / 21 / 19$ vs. HOU...reliever Shawn Keley entered that game after Jose Leclerc had issued a 2 -ou bases-loaded walk in the 9th inning to make it a one-run affair...Kelley fanned HOU catcher Robinson Chirinos for the final out to secure a 6 -pitch, one-out save in the Rangers $11-10$ victory.

YEAH BOY!: Todd Frazier hit a 2-run single in the 1st inning last night and walked twice...there have been 3 multi-RBI hits in the 1st inning by a Ranger this season, and Frazier own 2 of them (also 2-R single on 8/1 at SF)...Nick Solak had the other, a 2-R single on $8 / 11$ vs. SEA.

ON IT EARLY: Texas scored in the 1 st inning last night for the 1st time since $8 / 11 \mathrm{vs}$. SEA, when the Rangers went on to a $4-2$ win...club lost each of the 1 st 4 games this season when scoring in the opening frame, but have now won 2 straight. Rangers' . 547 OPS in the 1st inning ranks 2nd-lowest in MLB (MIL-.482).

OPPO TACO: The Rangers' 1st opposite field HR at Globe Life Field came last night (according to Stathead), the 1st HR of the year for Isiah Kiner-Falefa...although Shin-Soo Choo came close on a pair of occasions, the only previous oppo HR at this facility had come from opponents: COL's Trevor Story (7/26) and SD's Fernando Tatis Jr. (8/17 - grand slam)...the Rangers have 5 opposite field HR on the road in 2020, 2nd-most in MLB to only ATL (6).

SHORTS: With Yadiel Rivera's TEX debut last night, Rangers have used 43 players in '20, T2nd-most in MLB (54-MIA 43 -TEX/KC)...entering tonight, Rangers have won 5 of the last 6 G against left-handed starters at Globe Life Field. Leody Taveras recorded his 1st ML hit last night, 14th player in WAS/TEX franchise history to bat leadoff in his 1st ML start...Texas has allowed first-inning runs in 5 straight and 11 of 28 overall in '20...last night was the Rangers' lone win of the season against a team that is currently .500 -or-better (1-3 vs. OAK, $0-4$ vs. SD)... 20 of Rangers' 28 games have been against teams currently below .500... 3 of Lance Lynn's 4 wins have been one-run TEX victories...Lynn has recorded 3 of the team's last 6 wins...Rangers are only MLB team without a HR from either 3B or DH in '20...TEX has 4-runs-or-less in 7 of the past 8 games.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

TONIGHT: The 32 -year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 6 th start of the season tonight in game 2 of this 4-G set with division-leading Oakland...Rangers have 8 QS in '20: 6-Lynn, 2-Gibson...opponents have slashed .304/.407/.522/.929 in 1st innings, $.276 / .330 / .448 / .778$ in all other frames....will work on regular 4 days' rest after allowing season-high 5 R-ER in Texas' walk-off 8-7 loss to the Padres in San Diego on Thursday...did not factor into the decision of that setback, as it was the 1st and only instance of TEX starter allowing 5 -or-more runs without taking a loss this season...has already faced the A's once in '20, settling for a ND in the Rangers' $6-4$ defeat at Oakland Coliseum on $8 / 5 \ldots$..this will be his 1 st home start since $8 / 10$ vs. SEA after appearing on the road in 2 straight and 3 of his last 4 turns thru the rotation.... has pitched at least 5.0 IP and allowed 3 R-or-less in 3 of his 1 st 5 starts in a Texas uniform...has just 7 K's last 3 G after season-high 9 K's on $8 / 5$ at OAK ...signed a 3 -year contract thru 2022 on 12/6/19 after spending the 1st 10 years of his pro career in the Minnesota organization...tied a career high with 13 wins for the A.L. Central Division champion Twins last season despite being bothered much of the season by an ulcerative colitis condition...won 65 games for the Twins over the last 6 seasons with 10 -or-more victories 5 times in that span and has recorded 6 consecutive years of 25 -or-more starts... is one of 7 A.L. pitchers to post at least 5 10-win seasons from 2014-19...joined Jake Odorizzi, Rick Porcello, and Chris Sale as the only A.L. pitchers with $25+$ starts in each of last 6 seasons....was Minnesota's 2015 pitcher of the year...selected by the Twins in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2009 June draft out of the University of Missouri...Rangers are 1-4 in his starts.

LAST START: Conceded season-high 5 R-ER in Texas' walk-off $8-7$ loss to the Padres in San Diego on Thursday (ND, 5.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R-ER, 3 BB, 3 SO, 90 pitches/51 strikes)...permitted just one run on 3 hits through the first 4.0 innings, but San Diego opened the 5th w/ 1B, FO, 1B, BB to set the table for Eric Hosmer's one-out grand slam, making the Rangers the first club in MLB history to surrender slams in 4 straight G...Gibson exited after the 5th trailing 2-5, but avoided the loss when Danny Santana hit a 3-R 2B in the 7th to level the score at $5-5$... Texas would go on to suffer a 2nd straight walk-off defeat in extras when Jake Cronenworth produced a game-ending RBI single in the 10th.

VS. OAKLAND: Owns a $3-2$ record and 3.92 ERA ( 18 ER/41.1 IP) over 7 career G/GS against the A's, including 6.0 IP/3 R-ER in the Rangers' 6 -4 loss at Oakland Coliseum earlier this month on $8 / 5$ (ND, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R-ER, $2 \mathrm{BB}, 9 \mathrm{SO}, 2 \mathrm{HR}$, 103 pitches/66 strikes)...9 strikeouts and 103 pitches were both season highs... exited leading 4-3 in position to win, but did not factor in the decision after bullpen allowed 3 unanswered runs over the final 3 frames....held A's 4 -for- 22 in that start, but allowed season-high 2 HR (Matt Olson/Ramon Laureano).

AT HOME: Tonight will mark his 3rd home start of the season, 1st since $8 / 10$ vs. SEA (L, 4.1 IP, $9 \mathrm{H}, 4 \mathrm{R}-\mathrm{ER}$ ) after making each of his last 2 starts on the road... has gone 0-2 in 2 GS at Globe Life Field despite his home ERA (3.86) being more than a full run lower than road figure (5.19)...has received just 2 combined runs in support from the Texas offense in his home outings while garnering a 4.67 RSA on the road...opponents have slashed $.341 / .400 / .463 / .863$ vs. Gibson in Arlington compared to $.246 / 316 / .464 / .780$ in 3 away outings, which include a 6.1 -inning start against the Rockies at Coors Field on $8 / 15$.

ALL ABOUT THE ANGLES: According to Baseball Savant (Statcast), opposing batters have averaged an $8.0^{\circ}$ launch angle vs. Gibson in 2020, T10th-lowest among A.L. pitchers (min. 100 BF )...it is easily the lowest average opp. launch angle among Texas starters and well below this year's MLB average of $13.1^{\circ}$.

2020: Opponents have slashed .282/.347/.464/.811...leads TEX starters and ranks 15 th in the A.L. ( $\min$. 20.0 IP ) with a $49.4 \%$ ground ball percentage...his 9 K's on $8 / 5$ at OAK are tied for most by a Ranger in ' 20 (also Lance Lynn on Opening Day, $7 / 24$ vs. COL)...took the loss in his Texas debut on $7 / 28$ vs. ARI (5.0 IP, 3 R-0 ER), the 1st Ranger starter to take a loss when 3+ UER accounted for only runs allowed since Colby Lewis on 10/1/16 vs. TB (6.1 IP, 4 R-0 ER)...also lost in Rangers' $10-2$ defeat on $8 / 10$ vs. SEA ( $4.1 \mathrm{IP}, 9 \mathrm{H}, 4 \mathrm{R}-\mathrm{ER}$ )....faced 6 batters in the 5 th: foulout 3, 1B, BB, 3-R HR, 1B, 1B...the HR was hit by Kyle Lewis.

SPRING TRAINING/SUMMER CAMP: Finished 1-1, 4.50 (5 ER/10.0 IP) in 3 collective Spring Training starts, with the 1 st 2 taking place in Arizona before the original camp was halted...final outing was exhibition on $7 / 21$ vs. COL (L, 5.0 IP, 5 R-ER) - the 1 st ever baseball game at Globe Life Field...opponents went 8 -for- 38 (.211) in those games... posted a 3.00 ERA (6 R-5 ER/15.0 IP) over 3 Summer Camp starts against his teammates, all at GLF.
