WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers lost to the A's last night, $10-3$...team is $1-1$ on this 7 -day, 7 -game homestand against OAK (1-1) and LAD (3 G)...club has gone 1-9 in last 10 G after posting a $7-1$ record from 8/7-15...at 11-18 (.379), team has 3rd-lowest win pct. in the A.L. and 4th-lowest in MLB...the 18 losses rank T4th-most in A.L./MLB...the 1118 start matches the club's worst record through 29 G since 2000 (also 11-18 in 2018, 2007-08), as the team last had a worse record at this point in the season in 1985 (9-20)...TEX dropped a season-high 8 straight from 8/16-23, one of the 3 longest slides in MLB in 2020 ( 9 G by BOS, $8 / 10-18$; and DET, 8/11-20)...only other TEX drought of 8+G since start of 2015 was 0-8 span from 7/13-22/19...team had season-best 4-G win streak from $8 / 11-15$, which was longest winning span since a 4-G sweep from 9/5-8/19 at BAL...team had a 10-9 record after win on $8 / 15$ at COL, just 2nd time with a winning record all season (also 1-0 after Opening Day win vs. COL).. team is season-high 7 G under .500 for the 2 nd time in ' 20 (also 10-17 after loss on Sun. at SEA).

IN THE STANDINGS: Club is in 4th place in the A.L. West after owning sole possession of 3rd place for 9 straight days dating back to $8 / 16$...Rangers were last in 4th place-or-lower on $8 / 7$ after $4-8$ start to the season (4th, 5.0 GB )...team is season-high 9.0 GB for the 2 nd time in 3 days following last night's loss, this after climbing to 8.0 GB with win over OAK on Monday...Texas has lost ground in the standings just 5 times in last 10 days despite posting a 1-9 record in that span.

SERIES STUFF: Rangers have lost 3 consecutive series vs. SD (0-2), at SD (0-2), and at SEA (0-3), counting for 3 of the 4 instances in which TEX has lost all games of a series in 2020 (also 0-3 from 8/4-6 at OAK)...club is 3-6-1 overall in series in '20...1st time to lose 3 straight series since going 0-4-0 from 9/13-26/19...current drought was preceded by 3 straight series wins from 8/7-16, 1st time to win 3 in a row since 5/14-22/19.

- TEX is 2-2-1 in home series this season, going 2-1-1 in last 4 series at Globe Life Field entering this homestand.

AT HOME: Texas has gone 1-3 in last 4 home games, but has still won 7 of its last 11 in Arlington...that $7-4$ span comes after a 1-3 start at the new Globe Life Field, as club's 8-7 (.533) home mark ranks T6th in the A.L...the 8 home wins also rank 6th in the A.L...team has a -17 run diff. at home (53-70) and a - 35 mark on the road (54-89).

- Rangers are $6-2$ at home vs. A.L. West clubs, joining OAK (11-2) and HOU (8-2) as division foes with winning home records against West clubs in '20.

THE SWINGIN' A'S: The Rangers are hosting the A's for 7 games in a span of 21 days here at GLF from 8/24-9/13, wrapping up the season series...TEX is 1-4 vs. OAK, losing all 3 G at the Coliseum from 8/4-6 and last night's 10-3 rout...Rangers are 2-11 in last 13 G vs. A's dating to 2019, the wins coming on Monday and $9 / 22 / 19$ at OAK...since the start of 2018, TEX is 13-30 (.302) vs. the A's, 2nd-lowest win pct. against any A.L. opponent in that span (4-10, .286 vs. BOS)...in Arlington, team has lost 5 of 6 and 11 of last 15 dating back to 2018....have not bested the A's in a season series since 2016 (10-9).

SURVIVE THE FIRST: The Rangers snapped a streak of 5 straight games with runs allowed in the 1st inning last night, holding their opposition scoreless in the opening frame for the 1st time since last Wed. at SD...team surrendered a total of 10 runs in 1st innings over that span...Texas' 24 runs allowed in the 1st inning this year are tied with Los Angeles-AL for the most in all of baseball...since the start of 2019, no team in MLB has conceded more 1st-inning runs than the Rangers (146).

THE DIFFERENCE: Texas currently sports the lowest run differential in MLB (-52) after being outscored 77-36 (-41) over its last 10 G ...it is the team's lowest run diff. ever thru 29 G , as the club has been outscored by 7 more runs than its previous low mark thru 29 G (-45, 2008).

TWO-BAGS TREVINO: Matched his career high with 2 doubles last night (also 8/30/19 vs. SEA) in his 1st career start as a DH...his 6 doubles since being recalled from the Alternate Training Site on $8 / 14$ lead the club and are T3rd-most in MLB over that span (8-M. Sano, 7-A. Verdugo, 6-C. Biggio/C Hernandez/J. Trevino)...in just 12 G (38 AB) this year, Trevino has pulled within one double of tying Todd Frazier for the team lead (7), and is tied for the ML lead among catchers (also CHC's Willson Contreras/KC's Salvador Perez).

MORE TREVINO: Since his recall, Trevino leads the club in several offensive categories, including batting average (.353), slugging percentage (.618), hits (12), extra-base hits (7) and total bases (21)...his 0.5 fWAR (FanGraphs.com) is already the highest among Texas batters in 2020, while his 0.4 rWAR (baseball-reference.com) ranks 3rd behind Joey Gallo (0.8) and Isiah Kiner-Falefa (0.7).

SPEAKING OF IKF: The versatile infielder plated a run on a single in the 2nd inning as the Rangers' 8 -hole hitter last night, the 13th RBI Texas has received from a hitter batting in the 8th spot this season...just 4 A.L. clubs have generated more RBI out of the 8th spot in their lineups this season (19-NYY, 18-HOU, 17-DET, 14-OAK), with only DET seeing a larger share of it's RBI production coming from that spot ( $13.71 \%$-DET, $13.13 \%-T E X$ )...Rangers' highest RBI totals by batting order position in '20: 4th (19), 1st (15), 8th (13).

ANTHYING BUT LACKLUSTER: Including last night's 2-hit performance, Nick Solak is leading Texas batters in both hits (27) and multi-hit games (8) this year...he has compiled the 3rd-most hits among A.L. rookies (40-SEA's Kyle Lewis, 29CWS' Luis Robert), and ranks among the league's rooks in on-base percentage (2nd, .354), walks (T2nd, 12), doubles (T3rd, 5) and batting average (4th, .270).

HE'S GOT THE STUFF: Taylor Hearn has logged exactly 2.0 SHO IP in each of his last 2 outings....including last night, Hearn has been scoreless in each of his last 5 relief app (6.2 IP) since allowing 2 R-ER in his season debut on $8 / 10$ vs. SEA, dropping his season ERA from 18.00 to season-low 2.35 ...it is the 2 nd-longest active scoreless streak on staff (7.0-Joely Rodríguez)

LET'S GET SHIFTY: Joey Gallo has faced a shift in 92.8\% of his 112 plate appearances this season...according to Baseball Savant (Statcast), MIN's Max Kepler is the only batter in MLB ( $\min .100 \mathrm{PA}$ ) to face a higher shift rate in 2020 ( $97.6 \%$ )...since the start of 2019, Gallo's .372 wOBA (weighted on-base average) against non-traditional infield alignments is 26 th-highest in all of baseball.

ROSTER MOVES: This afternoon, the Rangers activated RHP Nick Goody from the 10-day IL and optioned RHP lan Gibaut to the Alternate Training Site...Goody posted a 4.50 ERA (3 R-2 ER/4.0 IP) over 7 relief outings for Texas before he was placed on the IL with back spasms on $8 / 12$.

SHORTS: Happy Birthday to Elvis Andrus, who turns 32 today...the Rangers have lost 8 straight games dating back to 2018 against tonight's scheduled Athletics starter Mike Fiers...team's last longer losing streak vs. an individual starting pitcher was 12 straight vs. Bartolo Colon from 8/21/035/12/07...Texas is the only MLB team that has yet to win a game by a margin of 5 -or-more runs in 2020, as every other club has at least 2 such wins.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER
\#39 Kolby Allard, LHP (0-2, 7.82)

TONIGHT: The 23 -year-old left-hander s scheduled to make his 5 th start of the season in tonight's game vs. OAK...after allowing one R-ER over 9.0 IP in his 1 st 2 starts, Allard has allowed 10 R-ER in 3.2 IP spanning his last $2 \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{GS}$, taking a pair of losses and raising season ERA to $7.82 \ldots$...has a 1.82 WHIP figure in ' $20 \ldots$ has averaged 9.95 SO/9, far above his 2019 MLB figure ( $6.55 \mathrm{SO} / 9$ ), but has also averaged 21.5 pitches per inning over 4 starts...will pitch on regular 4 days' rest after taking the loss in the Rangers' 7-4 defeat on Fri. at SEA...made an Opening Day roster for the first time in his career this season, as he was briefly available out of the bullpen before entering the rotation following an injury to RHP Corey Kluber...posted a 0.93 ERA (1 ER/9.2 IP) with $13 \mathrm{SO} / 6 \mathrm{BB}$ in 3 G during Summer Camp intrasquads at Globe Life Field...went 1-1, 7.71 ( 8 R-6 ER/7.0 IP) in $4 \mathrm{G} / 2 \mathrm{GS}$ during Spring Training...was acquired from ATL in trade deadline deal for RHP Chris Martin on 7/30/19...went 4-2, 4.96 in 9 G/GS for TEX in 2019, spending final 2 months in the rotation following the trade... his 4 wins were most by a TEX pitcher in an age-21 or younger season since 1986 (12-Ed Correa, 8 -Mitch Williams)...was consistently rated as one of the top prospects in the ATL organization prior to the trade...owns a career 29-23 record and 3.19 ERA in 86 games/starts over five minor league seasons...a highly-touted amateur pitcher at San Clemente (Calif.) High School, Allard was selected by ATL in the first round (14th overall) of the 2015 June draft...was in same senior class at San Clemente (Calif.) High School as NFL quarterback Sam Darnold...Texas is 2-2 in his starts this season and $8-5$ in his 13 total starts $\mathrm{w} /$ the Rangers since he was acquired from ATL.

LAST START: Took the loss in the Rangers' 7-4 defeat on Fri. at SEA, when he posted the shortest start by a Ranger in '20 ( 0.2 IP, 5 H, 4 R-ER, 2 BB, 1 SO, 0 HR, 38 pitches/24 strikes)...faced 9 batters but was removed due to high pitch count in the series opener...Wes Benjamin posted 4.1 IP in relief, but Texas was unable to rally after falling behind 6-0 through 3 innings.

VS. OAKLAND: The San Clemente native has never faced the A's, the only A.L. West club that he has yet to meet in his brief ML career.

IN ARLINGTON: Took ND in his lone start at Globe Life Field on $8 / 8 \mathrm{vs}$. LAA despite tossing 5.0 SHO IP in Rangers' 2-0 win...aslo pitched here in an exhibition game on $7 / 22$ vs. COL (1.0 IP, 4 R-ER) and in multiple Summer Camp intrasquad contests...went 1-1, 8.66 (17 ER/17.2 IP) in 4 G/GS across the street at Globe Life Park last season...in 2019, opp. batted . 346 in his home starts compared to .234 in his road outings.

FOREVER YOUNG: Allard, who turned 23 years old on Aug. 13, is the youngest pitcher on the Texas roster, with RHP Jonathan Hernández (24) the next youngest...in 2019, his 4 victories marked the most wins by Texas pitcher in an age21 or younger season since 1986, when 20-year-old Edwin Correa (12-14) and 21-year-old Mitch Williams (8-6) both pulled the trick...he also became just the 5th Texas pitcher in club history to make 9-or-more starts in an age-21 or younger season, joining Correa (1986-87), David Clyde (1973-74), Tommy Boggs (1976), and Don Stanhouse (1972).

2020: Allowed one R-ER over 9.0 IP in his 1 st 2 starts, but has permitted 10 R-ER in 3.2 IP spanning his last $2 \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{GS} . .$. has averaged 9.95 SO/9, far above his 2019 MLB figure ( $6.55 \mathrm{SO} / 9$ ), but has also averaged 21.5 pitches per inning over 4 starts...made season debut on 8/2 at SF, taking ND (4.0 IP, 1 R-ER) in Rangers' lone win on the 1st road trip of the year...posted 5.0 SHO IP on 8/8 vs. LAA, 2nd-longest scoreless outing of his career, retiring 10 straight at one point...Mike Trout and Shohei Ohtani were combined 0 -for- 4 w/ 4 K's...took loss on 8/16 at COL (3.0 IP, 6 R-ER), a game which included a tough-luck 2nd inning, in a defeat that began Rangers' season-long 8-G losing streak.

SPRING TRAINING / SUMMER CAMP: Posted a 0.93 ERA (1 ER/9.2 IP) with 13 SO/6 BB in 3 G during Summer Camp intrasquads at Globe Life Field... 13 strikeouts ranked 5th among club leaders (33-Minor, 28-Kluber, 19-Lynn, 15-Gibson)...went 1-1, 7.71 (8 R-6 ER/7.0 IP) in 4 G/2 GS during Spring Training, incl. loss in club's final exhibition game on $7 / 22$ vs. COL ( 1.0 IP, 4 R-ER) in which he surrendered home runs to Ryan McMahon and Drew Butera.

2019: Made his Texas debut in early August and spent the rest of the season in the starting rotation...his 4 wins from 8/9-end of season were tied with Mike Minor for the team lead and ranked T8th in the A.L. overall/T1st among A.L. rookies. won 4 of his 1 st 6 starts, becoming the 1st Ranger starter to win his 1 st 4 decisions in a season since 2017 (4-A.J. Griffin/Cole Hamels)...compiled a 4-game winning streak spanning 5 outings from 8/14-9/5, the 3rd-longest win streak by a Ranger in 2019 (6-Lance Lynn, 5-Adrian Sampson)...went 4-0, 3.78 (14 ER/33.1 IP ) during the streak before going 0-2, 8.25 (11 ER/12.0 IP) in his final 3 starts. allowed just 3 HR in 45.1 IP, ranking 3rd in A.L./7th in MLB with 0.60 home runs allowed per 9 innings from 8/9-end of season (min. 45 IP)...opponents slashed $.281 / .353 / .389 / .742$ overall, .296 (16-54) by LHB and .275 (36-131) by RHB.
